The CDS was briefed on the role, significance and challenges to India's only operational Joint Services Command. During the briefing, the CINCAN highlighted the Geo-strategic potential of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands and the role played by ANC towards supporting military operations in the area. poachers' movement in the midnight. The team immediately jumped into action and tried to stop the poachers, but they did not stop and tried to escape into dense mangroves. Mobile App developed under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana for quick reporting of Fish Diseases and timely scientific advice to aqua-farmers

New Delhi, July 9 (PIB)

Fish is considered as one of the healthiest source of animal protein and omega 3-fatty acids, and offers immense potential to mitigate malnutrition. Aquaculture is one of the fastest growing food producing sectors, and has immense role to play in meeting the rising demand for protein. Further, the sector provides livelihood and employment to about 3 crore fishers and fish farmers in the country. Foreseeing the immense potential for development in the sector and to bring Blue Revolution, the Government of India has implemented a flagship scheme "Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) with investment of Rs. 20,050 crores, the highest ever investment in Fisheries and Aquaculture Sector in the country.

Diseases are a serious constraint for the growth of aquaculture, and huge economic losses are reported by farmers due to aquatic animal diseases. Early detection is considered to be key to the control of diseases, and can only be achieved through a structured surveillance programme. Recognizing the importance of disease surveillance, an ambitious National Surveillance

Programme for Aquatic Animal Diseases (NSPAAD) was supported by the Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare through National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB), Hyderabad in the year 2013. This programme was initiated in 14 States of a q u a c u l t u r e importance and involved 24 collaborating centres and is being coordinated by ICAR-National Bureau of Fish Genetic Resources. To further strengthen the aquatic animal disease s u r v e i l l a n c e programme in the country, the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of NSPAAD with a total cost of Rs. 33.778 crores for a period of 3 years is supported under PMMSY with pan-India coverage and active involvement of the State Fisheries Department and Marine Products Export D e v e l o p m e n t Authority. The programme was successfully launched by Shri Parshottam Rupala, Union Minister, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Govt of India on February 27,



2023 at ICAR-CIBA, Chennai.

Some of the important highlights of the NSPAAD over the period of 9 years include i) developing a strong network of aquatic animal health laboratories in the country, ii) developing diagnostic capability for detection of World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH)-listed and emerging aquatic animal pathogens, iii) strengthening of passive disease surveillance in the country, iv) providing scientific advice to the farmers for management of disease, v) detection of nine new pathogens for the first time from the country, vi) e s t a b l i s h i n g mechanisms for first-time confirmation of exotic and emerging diseases and sending alerts/advisories to stakeholders following suspicion of a new disease to prevent spread of the disease, vii) successful dispelling of the

speculations regarding occurrence of the Acute Hepatopancreatic Necrosis Disease (AHPND) (now an WOAH-listed d i s e a s e) which has h u g e implications in shrimp

trade, viii) establishing a transparent reporting system and increasing the credibility of the country in terms of reporting of aquatic animal diseases to international organizations, namely World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE) and Network of Aquaculture Centres in Asia-Pacific (NACA).

Under the programme to further strengthen the farmer based reporting a "Report Fish Disease" App has been developed. The App has been launched recently on June 28, 2023 by Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, GoI, Shri Parshottam Rupala. Using the innovative app, the farmers can report disease cases in finfish, shrimps and molluscs on their farms to the field level-officers and fish health experts and get scientific advice for quickly addressing the disease problem on

their farms. The app will be a central platform for connecting fish farmers, field-level officers and fish health experts.

The vision of Digital India Programme conceptualized by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi is to transform India into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy. Development of this kind of apps to understand the disease problem faced by the farmers is an important step towards fulfilling the vision of "Digital India" of our Prime Minister by providing the entire fish farming communities a platform to share their problem. It is envisaged that the "Report Fish Disease" will reach all fish farming communities located in the most remote place of country, so that each disease case in aquatic animals are reported, investigated and timely scientific advice are provided, so that the disease problem faced by the farmers which used to go unnoticed or not reported earlier will reach to the experts and the problem will be addressed within a minimum period of time. Hence, the economic loss which was happening due to disease outbreaks will be reduced to a greater extent, thereby help in increasing fish farmers' income.

Women T20 International: India defeat Bangladesh by 7 wickets in Dhaka



Dhaka, July 9

In Women's cricket, India defeated Bangladesh by seven wickets in the first T20 International match at the Shere Bangla National Stadium in Mirpur, Dhaka today. With this victory, India went 1-0 up in this three-match T20 International series. India reached the target of 115 runs, set by Bangladesh, in 16.2 overs, losing three

wickets. Captain Harmanpreet Kaur steered the Indian innings with an unbeaten 54-run knock, while Smriti Mandhana scored 38 runs.

Earlier, put into bat, Bangladesh managed to post only 114 runs in the stipulated 20 overs. The second match will be played on the 11<sup>th</sup>, and the third and final on the 13<sup>th</sup> of this month.

Ministry of Education releases combined report on Performance Grading Index for Districts (PGI-D) for the year 2020-21 & 2021-22

New Delhi, July 9 (PIB)

The Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSE&L), Ministry of Education today released the Performance Grading Index for Districts (PGI-D) combined report for 2020-21 & 2021-22 which assesses the performance of school education system at the District level by creating an index for comprehensive analysis.

The Indian Education System is one of the largest in the world with about 14.9 lakh schools, 95 lakh teachers, and nearly 26.5 crore students from varied socio-economic backgrounds. DoSE&L devised Performance Grading Index (PGI) for States and released report for the reference years 2017-18 to 2020-21. Based on the success of State PGI, 83-indicator based PGI for District (PGI-D) has been designed to grade the performance of all districts in school education. The data is filled by districts through online portal.

The PGI-D is expected to help the State Education Departments to identify gaps at the district level and improve their performance in a decentralized manner. The indicator-wise PGI score shows the areas where a district needs to improve. PGI-D report for 2018-19 and 2019-20 has been released so far the current one is combined report for 2020-21 & 2021-22.

The PGI-D structure comprises of total weight age of 600 points across 83 indicators, which are grouped under 6 categories viz., Outcomes, Effective Classroom Transaction, Infrastructure Facilities & Student's Entitlements, School Safety & Child Protection, Digital Learning and Governance Process. These categories are further divided into 12 domains, viz., Learning Outcomes and Quality (LO), Access Outcomes (AO), Teacher Availability and Professional

D e v e l o p m e n t Outcomes (TAPDO), Learning Management (LM), Learning Enrichment Activities (LEA), Infrastructure, Facilities, Student Entitlements (IF&SE), School Safety and Child Protection (SS&CP), Digital Learning (DL), Funds convergence and utilization (FCV), Enhancing CRCs Performance (CRCP), Attendance Monitoring Systems (AMS) and School Leadership Development (SLD).

PGI-D grades the districts into ten grades viz., Highest achievable Grade is Daksh, which is for Districts scoring more than 90% of the total points in that category or overall. The lowest grade in PGI-D is called Akanshi-3 which is for scores upto 10% of the total points. Ultimate objective of PGI-D is to help the Districts to priorities areas for intervention in school education and thus improve to reach the highest grade.

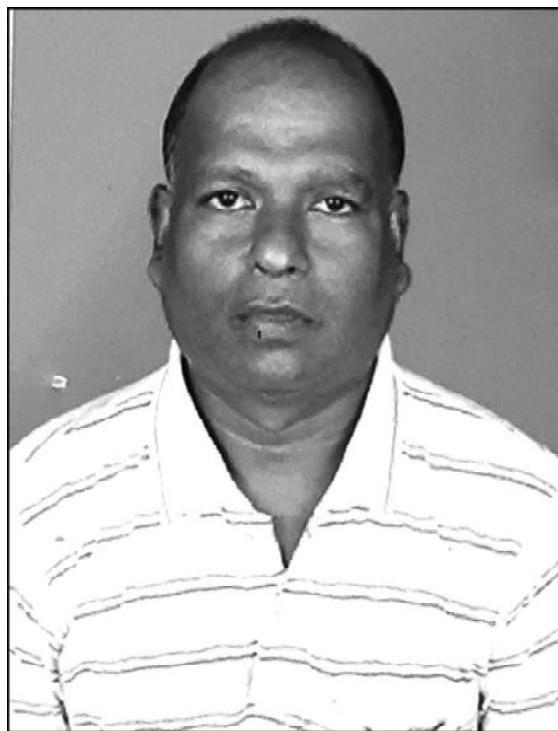

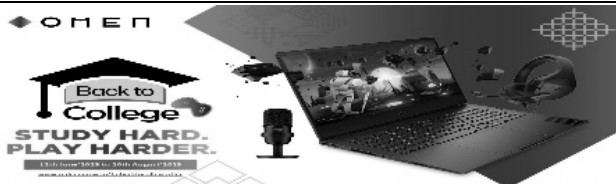
