application will help the farmers in reporting incidence of diseases in finfish, shrimps, and molluscs on their farms with the field level-officers and fish disease experts as and when required. This shall help farmers in getting the scientific advice for efficient management of disease.

Dr. Sanjeev Kumar Balyan highlighted on how the fisheries sector needs to move forward by keeping welfare of fishers, fish farmers and small-scale entrepreneurs at its core. Further, he informed that a collaborative approach to be built with time to formalize the fisheries sector, ensure enhanced contribution in the national economy and larger footprint for wider reach and

Dr L Murugan recognized the critical role of fishers and fish farmers in meeting the growing demand and also recognizes the invaluable contributions of our fishermen and fish farmers who tirelessly work to provide us with a vital source of food and sustenance. He emphasized on sustainable fishing practices that not only increase productivity but also minimize environmental impacts. He also highlighted that before 2014 around 500 startup companies were established whereas at present more than 9 lakh startup companies have been established in Fisheries sector, which holds an immense potential in both marine and inland fisheries in the country.

The program was live streamed on various social media platforms such as YouTube, Twitter, and Facebook. In all around approx. 23,000 stakeholders including fishermen, fish farmers, scholars, scientists, official dignitaries attended the event virtually covered across 33 States/UTs with around 260 locations on National Fish Farmers Day Meet 2023.

National Fish Farmers Day Meet 2023 is an occasion for the entire country to recognize fishers and fish farmers' enormous contributions and commitment to sustainable development of fisheries. National Fish Farmers Day is observed by the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India, and other stakeholders to demonstrate solidarity with all fisher folks, fish farmers and fisheries stakeholders throughout the country and recognize the contributions of fishers and fish farmers to the country's economy and food security. It is an essential forum for recognizing the significant role that fishers and fish farmers play in supplying the growing demand for fish protein, creating job opportunities, and contributing to the country's food security. It demonstrates their commitment and inventiveness in implementing contemporary aquaculture techniques, increasing fish yield, and conserving aquatic resources. Scientific research and technical interventions have fueled significant developments in the fisheries sector throughout the years.

Indian Fisheries Sector made a record Fish production of 162.48 lakh tons during the year 2021-22. The Inland fisheries and Aquaculture Production nearly doubled from 61.36 Lakh tons in 2014-2015 to 121.21 Lakh tons in 2021-2022 with the Average Annual Growth rate of fisheries sector around 9%, fish production around 7% and Inland fisheries and Aquaculture around 9% since 2014-15. The Fisheries Sector Contributes around 1% to National GVA. Since 2014-15, the Department of Fisheries, Government of India through its key Schemes and Programs supported the construction of about 38,992 ha of new aquaculture ponds and renovation of 8,573 ha of farms, construction of 19 brood banks and 1243 hatcheries, construction/ modernization of 107 fishing harbours and fish landing centers at a cost of Rs. 8989 crores, development of 38820 reservoir cages, 14471 Re-circulatory Systems and Biofloc Units, 31925 fish transportation facilitates, 7549 fish retail markets and kiosks, 993 feed mills, 8085 new boats and fishing vessels, motorization of 8379 traditional crafts, 861 cold chain units.

The observance of National Fish Farmers Day will certainly help in raising awareness about the significance of aquaculture and its impact on food security, as fish is one of the healthiest options to mitigate hunger and nutrient deficiency. It will provide a platform to educate the public about the challenges, innovations, and sustainable practices employed by fish farmers. The celebration of National Fish Farmers Day Meet- 2023 will provide a platform for fish farmers to support in transforming the fisheries value chain for overall development of Indian fisheries sector. The observance of the event will further strengthen the development of fisheries sector in a sustainable, responsible, exclusive, and equitable manner.

S/o Late N Raman, R/o Austinabad near Mariamman Temple and District Administration, Nicobar distributed DM recovered 97 gms of methamphetamine from his possession following due procedure under provisions of NDPS Act 1985.

The entire raid took place under the supervision of Shri Sunny Gupta, IPS, SDPO South Andaman. During investigation, the accused R Kasinathan was interrogated and

he revealed that he bought 200 grams of Methamphetamine from one IRBn personnel namely Amrita Malakar for further selling it to the consumers. Subsequently, both were arrested. Further, on technical analysis of CDRs, bank statements and physical interrogation, it was revealed that Amrita Malakar procured 02 packets of Methamphetamine from another IRBn constable Jaidev Hawlader, who had confessed the same and was also arrested in the instant case.

In addition, during interrogation they revealed that the sale of 500 grams of Methamphetamine took place between Amrita Malakar and one Nadeem alias Pawan. In this deal, Karthick @ dada, Julku Mali alias Prakash and Manikandan have facilitated the sale of illegal drugs.

Further, the aforesaid 500 grams of Methamphetamine was sold to one Abdul Umran @ Sonu by Pawan. On interrogating Sonu, he disclosed that Methamphetamine is present at his residence. Immediately, a team was constituted, and a raid was conducted on 07/ 07/23 late night as per the provisions of NDPS Act of 1985 and 28 grams of Meth was recovered from the residence of Sonu.

Based on the above information and sufficient evidences, the involved accused persons namely Abdul Umran @ Sonu, S/o Late Abdul Majid (38) yrs, Pvt Worker Chicken Seller, R/o Round Basti, Kartick Roy @ Dada, S/o Shri Santi Roy (31)yrs, Pvt Worker, R/o Garacharama near Primary School, R Manikandan, S/o Shri Rama Swamy (34) yrs, Pvt Worker, R/o New Pahargaon, Nadeem @ Pawan, S/o Mariyanus Kerketta (29)yrs, Pvt Worker, R/o Namunaghar, Uppar Basti, Julku Malli @Prakash, S/o Late Sona Malli (32)yrs, Pvt Worker, R/o Kamraj Nagar near Ganesh Temple, Moideen Gani, S/o Shri A S Madar (45)yrs, Pvt Worker, Tourist Guide, R/o Dignabad were arrested on 08/07/2023 at PS Pahargaon and subsequently one more accused Babul Sarkar, S/o Late Haran Sarkar (44)yrs, ex-Pradhan of Netaji Nagar Panchayat, Hut Bay, R/o Kalinagar, Hut Bay was arrested on 09/ 07/2023 and further investigation of the instant case is under progress. 
