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ISRO successfully launches a 642-tonne heavy lift rocket LVM3 carrying Chandrayaan - 3 satellites from Sriharikota

Chandrayaan-3 scripts a new chapter in India's space odyssey: PM

Sriharikota, July 14

ISRO successfully launched a 642-tonne heavy lift rocket LVM3 carrying Chandrayaan-3 satellites from Sriharikota today. India's yet another historical mission to the Moon began today noon after the completion of the three stages. The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has hailed the relentless dedication of India's scientists on the launch of Chandrayaan-3. Sharing a tweet by Indian Space Research Organisation, the Prime Minister tweeted; "Chandrayaan-3 scripts a new chapter in India's space odyssey. It soars high, elevating the dreams and ambitions of every Indian. This momentous achievement is a testament to our scientists' relentless dedication. I salute their spirit and ingenuity!"

Minister of State for Science and Technology, Dr. Jitendra Singh and former Chairpersons of ISRO witnessed the launch from the Control Centre ISRO. Apart from the scientists and their families, hundreds of registered onlookers outside the campus to witness the mission to the moon whistled and clapped even as the rocket took to the skies. More than 200 journalists from all over the country and international media gathered at the venue to witness the launch from the Media Centre ISRO, also joined the



celebration with thunderous applause. All three stages performed exactly in textbook style. The first stage powered by solid fuel followed by liquid fuel and the third and final cryogenic stage

powered by liquid hydrogen and liquid oxygen performed in a perfect automatic launch sequence.

The rocket blasted off exactly at 2.35 hours

and 17 seconds from the second launch pad of the Satish Dhawan Space Centre. ISRO had about 54 lady Engineers and Scientists who worked directly in the Chandrayaan-3 mission. They are Associate and Deputy Project Directors and Project Managers of various systems working at different centres. The common thread that runs between Chandrayaan-2 and Chandrayaan-3 missions is the soft landing of the lander on the lunar soil and the rover doing some chemical experiments. However, there are differences in the lander specifications, payload experiments and others between the two missions. The Mission Director is Shri Mohan Kumar, the Vehicle/Rocket Director is Shri Biju C. Thomas and the Spacecraft Director is Dr. P. Veeramuthuvel.

The propulsion module has a payload to study the precise metric measurements of Earth from the lunar surface. The lander payloads are to measure the thermal conductivity and temperature, and also take the exact data to measure the seismicity around the landing site. A passive laser retro-reflector array from NASA is accommodated for lunar laser ranging studies. The rover will carry two small devices to derive the elemental composition of the landing site. Methamphetamine on 11/07/2023. During his Police Remand, he was put under sustained interrogation and besides technical analysis, details of his close associate were also unearthed. Based on diligent efforts by the dedicated team, it was revealed that S. Bala Murugan, S/o Shri Shanta Kumar, aged 23 years, resident of Bambanallah, Sippighat, is a close associate of the previously apprehended accused, S. Karthick. Both individuals hail from the same locality and have been actively involved in the illegal drug trade.

A thorough interrogation of S. Bala Murugan was carried out at PS CCS and crucial information was uncovered. Upon further investigation and acting on the information provided by S. Bala Murugan, the Police conducted a search operation in the vicinity of his residence in Sippighat area. As a result, 739 grams of Methamphetamine (Commercial Quantity) was seized, which was concealed clandestinely beneath dried arecanut leaves in plantation being managed by S. Bala Murugan's family. The operation was carried out by a team comprising of ASI Mohd. Rafique, Head Constable Sanjay Kujur & Sanjit Madhu, Constable K. Rajendran, N. Thangaraj and Chandran of PS CCS under the supervision of Dy.SP (CID) Shri Piyush Jain.

Consequently, Shri S. Bala Murugan has been arrested under section 22(c)/29 of the NDPS Act for possession of commercial quantity of Methamphetamine.

The seizure of this significant quantity of Methamphetamine highlights the commitment of the Central Crime Station to combat the drug menace that plagues our society. By dismantling this illicit operation, the CCS has delivered a severe blow to the network of drug peddlers. Annual rate of inflation based on all India WPI recorded 4.12%

New Delhi, July 14

The annual rate of inflation based on all India Wholesale Price Index (WPI) is 4.12 percent down for the month of June, 2023.

The decline in the rate of inflation in June, 2023 is primarily due to a fall in prices of mineral oils, food products, basic metals, crude petroleum & natural gas and textiles.

Prices of Food Articles increased by 2.10 percent in June, 2023 as compared to May, 2023. Prices of Non-food Articles are down by 2.40 percent, whereas Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas prices declined by 3.01 percent. Minerals prices declined by 4.32 percent in June, 2023 as compared to May, 2023. (Source: india.gov.in)

PS Kalighat. During investigation, the IO conducted a thorough investigation, recorded statement of prime witnesses and collected all the evidences. He left no stone unturned, walked an extra mile and burnt his midnight oil to finalize the case and submitted the chargesheet before the Hon'ble Court within 42 days. The trial of the case was carried out in fast track and the Officer has taken keen interest in the appearance and pairvi of each and every witness during trial which resulted in the conviction of the case.

After completion of hearing, Hon'ble Additional District & Sessions Judge, Mayabunder sentenced the accused to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life alongwith a fine for an amount of Rs. 20,000/- and in failure, he shall undergo rigorous imprisonment for a further period of 2 months for committing the said gruesome murder.

Thunderstorm with lightning is likely to occur at one or two places over Andaman and Nicobar Islands on July 15. Thunderstorm with lightning and gusty wind (speed 30-40 kmph) is likely to occur at one or two places over A&N Islands.

Meanwhile, due to a squally weather wind speed exceeding 45 kmph is likely to

prevail over Andaman Sea and neighbourhood. Fishermen have been advised not to venture into the sea from July 16 to 18, 2023.

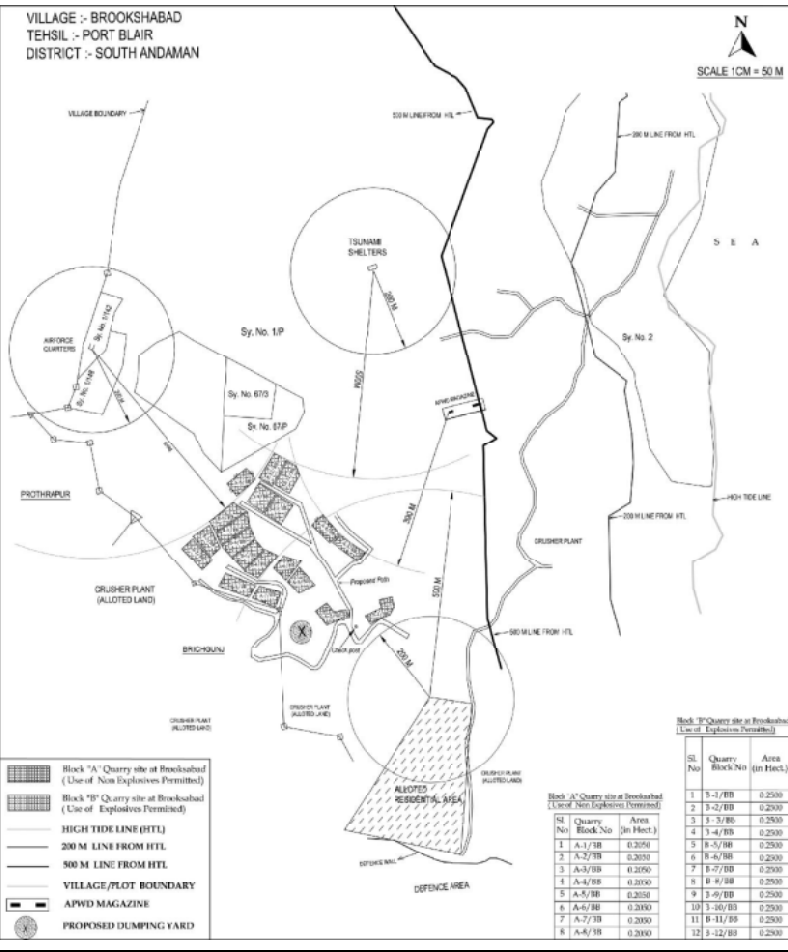

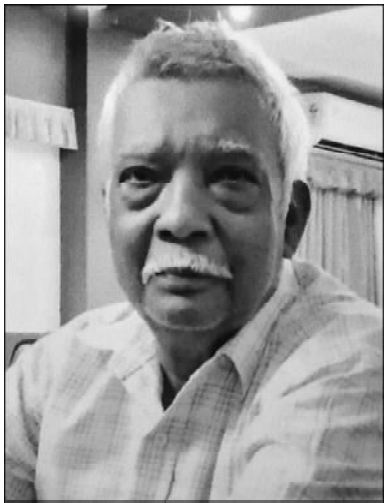
