PM inaugurates New Integrated Terminal Building of Veer Savarkar International Airport via video conferencing

New Terminal Building will increase Ease of Travel, Ease of Doing Business and Connectivity: PM

Andaman is becoming a living and breathing example of the maha-mantra of development and heritage going hand in hand



handling capacity of Veer Savarkar International Airport is being fulfilled. The Prime Minister also expressed his desire to be present on the occasion as he could experience the joyous environment and happy faces of the citizens. "Those who wished to visit Andaman also demanded a larger capacity airport", he added.

Further, speaking on the growing desire for expansion of the airport facilities at Port Blair, the Prime Minister informed that till now, the existing terminal had the capacity to handle 4000 tourists and the new terminal has taken this number to 11,000 and 10 planes can be parked at any given time on the airport now. More flights and tourists will bring more jobs to the area, he said. Port Blair's new terminal building will increase Ease of Travel, Ease of Doing Business and Connectivity, the Prime Minister added.

"The scope of development has been limited to big cities for a long time in India", the Prime Minister said, as he highlighted that the Adivasi and Island regions of the country were devoid of development for a long time. He said that in the last 9 years, the present Government has not only rectified the mistakes of the Governments of the past with utmost sensitivity but also come up with a new system. "A new model of development of inclusion has come up in India. The model is of 'Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas'", the Prime Minister said. He explained that this model of development is very comprehensive and includes the development of every region and every section of society, and every aspect of life such as education, health and connectivity.

The Prime Minister said, that in the last 9 years, a new story of development has been written in Andaman. In the 9 years of the previous Government, Andaman and Nicobar

received a budget of Rs 23,000 crores, whereas in the last nine years of the present Government, a budget of about Rs 48,000 crores was allocated for Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Similarly, during the 9 years of the previous Government 28,000 households were connected with piped water, this number in the last 9 years is 50,000. Today, the Prime Minister continued, everyone in Andaman and Nicobar has a bank account and the facility of One Nation One Ration Card. The current Government is also responsible for the setting up of Medical College in Port Blair whereas, earlier, there was no Medical College in the Union Territory. Earlier, the internet was solely dependent on satellites, now, he said, the present Government took the initiative of laying the undersea optical fiber of hundreds of kilometres.

The Prime Minister said, that this expansion of facilities is giving momentum to tourism in A&N Islands. Mobile connectivity, health infrastructure, airport facilities and roads promote the arrival of tourists. That is why, said Shri Modi, tourist footfall has doubled as compared to 2014. Adventure tourism is also thriving and the numbers will rise manifold in the coming years.

"Andaman is becoming a living and breathing example of the maha-mantra of development and heritage going hand in hand", the Prime Minister remarked. The Prime Minister noted that even though the Tiranga was hoisted in Andaman, way before it was hoisted in the Red Fort, one could only find signs of slavery on the Island. He expressed gratitude for getting the opportunity to hoist the National Flag at the exact same spot where Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose once hoisted the Tiranga. The Prime Minister highlighted that it was the present



Government that renamed Ross Island as Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Dweep, Havelock Island as Swaraj Dweep and Neil Island as Shaheed Dweep. He also touched upon naming the 21 Islands after the Param Vir Chakra awardees. "Development of Andaman and Nicobar Islands has become a source of inspiration for the youth of the country", he added.

The Prime Minister said that India would have scaled new heights in the last 75 years of Independence as there is no doubt about the capabilities of the Indians. However, the

Prime Minister emphasized, corruption and dynastic politics always did injustice to the strengths of the common citizens. He criticised the politics of casteism and corruption. Shri Modi underlined the strength of the youth of India in the fields of defence and startup and lamented how no justice was done for this strength of the youth.

Concluding the address, the Prime Minister emphasized the need to dedicate ourselves to the development of the country. The Prime Minister said that there are many examples of Islands and small coastal countries that have made unprecedented progress in the world today. He highlighted that even though the path of progress is filled with challenges, development arrives with all kinds of solutions. The Prime Minister expressed confidence that the development work being done in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands will further strengthen the entire region.

Speaking on the occasion, Union Civil Aviation Minister, Shri Jyotiraditya M. Scindia described the occasion as a historic one. The Minister said, A&N Islands is among the most beautiful gems of our country and it has witnessed significant events in the history of India's Independence. He further stated that Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose unfurled the Indian Tri-color on Dec. 30, 1943 and declared these Islands free from the British occupation. He said, it is on this soil, Veer Savarkar spent 10 years in the infamous Cellular Jail. He said, to honor the valiant effort of our soldiers, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi named 21 unnamed Islands in the names of Param Veer Chakra Awardees.

Informing about the infrastructure facilities upgraded in the Country, the Minister stated that the Civil Aviation Sector has developed manifold under the able leadership of the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi. He said, in the last 9 years, the number of Airports have increased from 74 to 148. Similarly, the number of domestic flyers which were only 6 crores in the year 2013-14 has increased to 14.5 crores. He said, earlier the number of aircraft fleet was 400 only and in last 9 years, it has increased to 700. The number of Greenfield Airports have also expanded to 14 in the last 9 years. He stated that the infrastructure development under the able leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Modi

is continuing and efforts are on to increase the number of airports from 148 to 200 in the coming 3 to 4 years. He said, the target of the Govt. is to increase the fleet of Aircrafts from 700 to 1500-1700. He said, the UDAN scheme devised by the Prime Minister has enabled 1.5 crore poor people to travel by flight.

Informing about the newly built integrated terminal, the Minister said that earlier the existing terminal building was constructed covering an area of 7,500 sqmtrs only, however, the new terminal has come up in an area of 40,000 sqmtrs. The passenger handling capacity will also be increased from 300 to 1200 per hour. Veer Savarkar International Airport represents the incredible biodiversity of flora and fauna. Designed in the shape of an oyster, this airport doesn't need an internal source of light during the daytime. In terms of sustainability, this airport has double insulating system, LED lighting, Rainwater catchment, and Solar Water Plant, the Minister added.

The Minister further said apart from Veer Savarkar International Airport, 3 additional airports in Shibpur, Car Nicobar and Campbell Bay, as well as 4 Water Aerodromes in Shaheed Dweep, Swaraj Dweep, Long Island and Port Blair, will be established by the Govt. of India with an investment of Rs. 150 crores. Under the leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, we are dedicated to the Sewa, Sushashan and Garib Kalyan. In the coming time, this airport will be the gateway to employment, education, and investment, the Minister added.

Earlier, welcoming the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, Union Civil Aviation Minister, Shri Jyotiraditya M. Scindia, Union Minister of State for Road, Transport and Highways and Civil Aviation, General (Retd.) VK Singh and all other dignitaries present, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Lt Governor, A&N Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency said that the historic inauguration of the new terminal of Veer Savarkar International Airport by the Prime Minister is an important initiative in realizing the dream of "Developed India" and a moment of immense pride for the Islanders. The Lt Governor said that GDP per capita, parameters of Human Development Index, per capita income etc. are essential parameters for a developed country, which is not possible without infrastructure development.

With almost zero investment in infrastructure for the first 7 decades of independence, these Islands were identified by the name of 'Kalapani'. However, in the last 5-6 years, under the guidance of Prime Minister and mainly through the visionary projects of IDA, investment in infrastructure development of over Rs 95,000 crore shows the rapid transformation of the Islands towards a developed India, the Lt Governor added.

The Lt Governor mentioned that these Islands are located about 1300 km from the East Coast of India but less than 100 km from Myanmar and Indonesia and are very close to other countries of South-East Asia. In view of

the strategic location of these Islands, connectivity infrastructure in aviation sector is most important. Under this, the projects proposed by A&N Administration are being completed rapidly, the Lt Governor said adding that with an investment of about 710 crores, the New Integrated Terminal Building (NITB) will be a Force-Multiplier in the direction of Investment, Tourism, Hospitality and Services sector besides providing employment, Socio-Economic development and thereby making the country a Global Connecting hub.

Mentioning that adequate investment in the public sector in a developed country is necessary to attract private investment, the Lt Governor said that seaplane operators have been selected to operate service from Port Blair to Swaraj Dweep, Shaheed Dweep and Long Island under RCS-UDAN scheme with an investment of about 60 crores. The Lt Governor further stated that operators have also been selected for early commencement of fixed-wing services from Port Blair to Shibpur, Car Nicobar and Campbell Bay. Administration's proposal for fleet up-gradation with new 12-seater, large capacity Sikorsky helicopters has also received financial approval from SFC, the Lt Governor said.

The Lt Governor informed that for making the infrastructure of a developed country future-ready, the final site selection and LIDAR survey of New Greenfield Airports of Port Blair and GNI have been completed. The Lt Governor further stated that about 800 km from North-South Axis of these Islands, four airports are available, at an average distance of 230 km each. On completion of runway extension at Great Nicobar Island and Shibpur Airports, these four dual-use strategic airports with three km-plus runway each will be capable of operating larger aircraft and will be a game-changer in the geo-political aspect of the country.

The Lt Governor stated that as per the requirement of post-industrial economy of a

developed country, special care has been taken for a balanced investment in the projects pertaining to Aviation Sector, for which the Islanders are grateful to the Prime Minister and the Civil Aviation Minister for their full support and guidance.

Concluding his address, the Lt Governor assured that he along with the A&N Administration and all Islanders are fully dedicated in making the dream of 'Developed India', a reality.

The inaugural function was attended by Union Minister of Civil Aviation and Steel, GoI, Shri Jyotiraditya M. Scindia & Minister of State for Road Transport and Highways and Civil Aviation, General (Retd.) Vijay Kumar Singh, Lt Governor, A&N Islands and Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Member of Parliament, Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma, Secretary, Civil Aviation Ministry, Shri Rajiv Bansal, Chairman, AAI, Shri AK Pathak, senior officers from Defence & Civil Administration.

Earlier, the Union Minister of Civil Aviation and Steel, GoI, Shri Jyotiraditya M. Port Blair, July 18

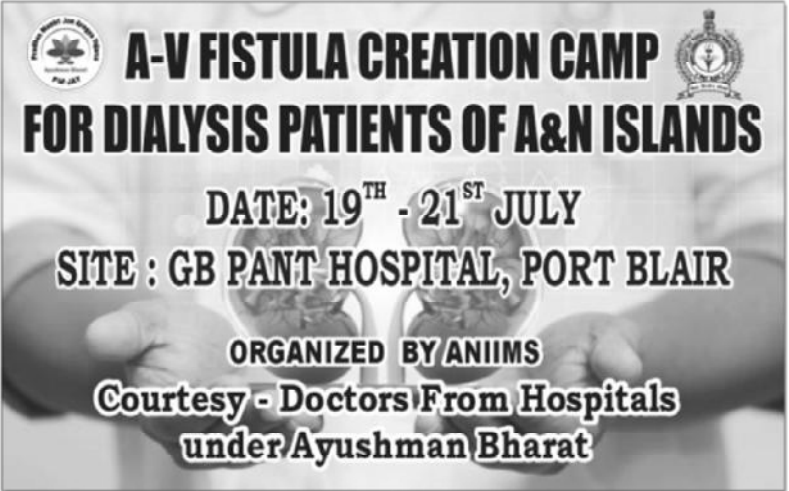

Successful operation by PS Humfrygunj leads to seizure of Cannabis plants weighing 1.645 kg; culprit arrested in Guptapara

Port Blair, July 18

The vigilant and dedicated team from PS Humfrygunj carried out a commendable operation on July 15, 2023, resulting in the confiscation of three cannabis plants weighing a total of 1.645 kgs. The successful raid, conducted under the leadership of SI Gaurav Banerjee and the supervision of SDPO Bambooflat, Shri Arshdeep Singh Panwar, led to the arrest of an individual involved in cultivating cannabis on his land in Guptapara. Acting on reliable

intelligence, the police team took swift action against the cultivation of illegal substances and promptly executed the raid on the property of the suspect, Suresh Barman. The diligent efforts of the Police personnel enabled them to recover the cannabis plants hidden within a plastic container on the accused's land.

The accused, Suresh Barman, has been booked under the provisions of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985, ensuring that those responsible for such illicit

activities face the full force of the law. The Police Department remains committed to curbing the menace of drug cultivation and trafficking in the region with the resolve to maintain law and order and protect the citizens from the perils of illegal substances.

Glimpses of New Integrated Terminal Building of Veer Savarkar International Airport

Enhancing connectivity infrastructure has been a major focus of the Government. The inauguration of the New Integrated Terminal Building, built at a cost of around Rs 710 crores, will play a key role in boosting connectivity of the Island UT. With a total built-up area of around 40,800 sqm., the new terminal building will be capable of handling about 50 lakh passengers annually. An Apron suitable for two Boeing-767-400 and two Airbus-321 types of aircraft has also been constructed at Port Blair Airport at a cost of Rs 80 Crores, making the airport now suitable for parking ten aircraft at a time. Inspired by nature, the architectural design of the airport terminal resembles a shell-shaped structure depicting the sea and Islands. The new airport terminal building has a number of sustainability features like Double Insulated Roofing System to reduce heat gain, skylights to provide maximum inlet of abundant natural sunlight during day time to reduce artificial light usage inside the building, LED lighting, and low heat gain glazing. Rainwater catchment in an underground water tank, an on-site sewage treatment plant with 100% of treated wastewater reused for landscaping and a 500 KW solar power plant are some other features of the terminal building to ensure a minimal negative impact on the Islands' environment.

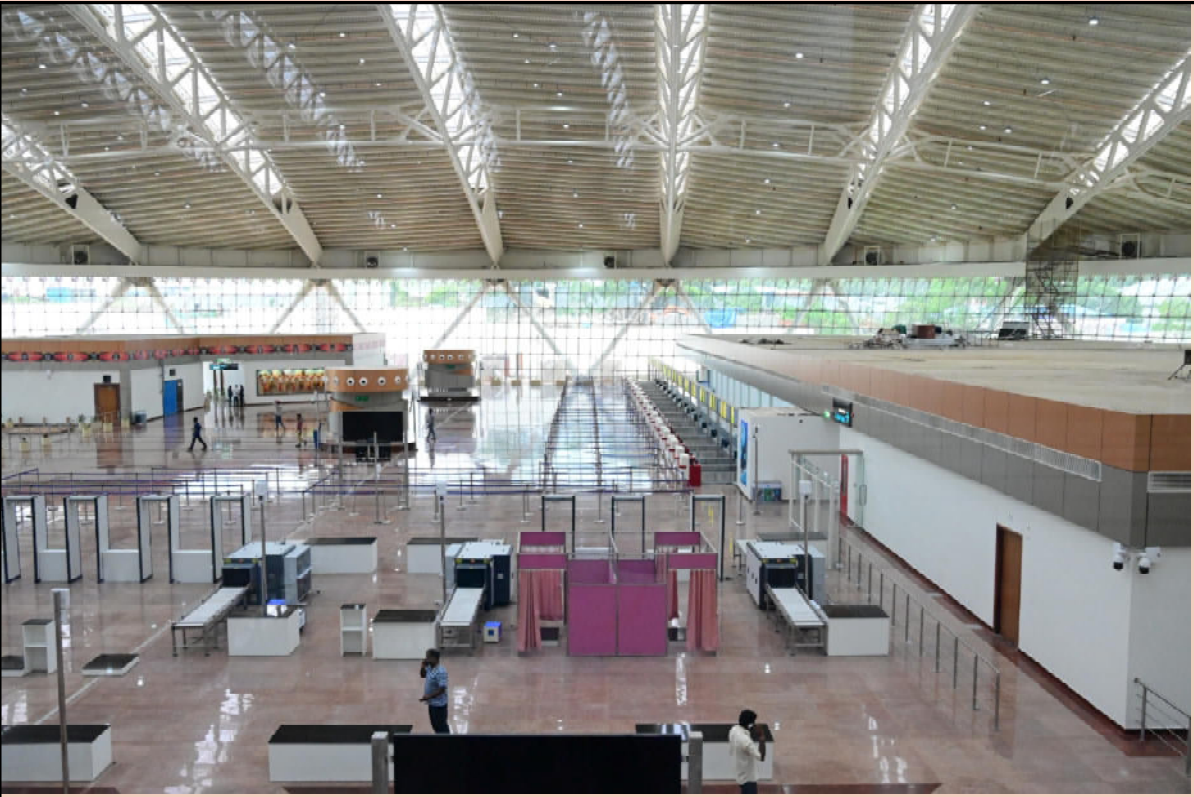

In supersession of all previous appointment orders of Booth Level Officers(BLOs) and BLO-Supervisors under Section 13B(2) of Representation of People Act, 1950, the following officials attached to various departments functioning under A & N Administration are hereby appointed as Booth Level Officer and BLO-Supervisor for the Part(s)/Polling Station(s) mentioned against their name with immediate effect.

The BLOs shall attend to the Electoral Roll related duties in the polling area as indicated against their name. They would be considered as on deputation to the Election Commission of India for this purpose and would be subject to the disciplinary control of the Election Commission of India under Section 32 of Representation of People Act, 1950. BLOs & BLO-Supervisors shall not proceed on leave without obtaining permission and making over his election related charge. Even in case of their transfer, they should ensure to hand over all election related papers, records and registers to their successor within the prescribed time.

The Booth Level Officers shall be required to carry out door-to-door verification of electors in their respective polling area which they have been assigned. They shall be provided with a copy of the latest Photo Electoral Rolls pertaining to their polling area and shall make necessary correction and updation of the electoral data as prescribed. The BLOs are backbone of democracy and their objective shall be to prepare an error-free Electoral Roll and to achieve cent percent enrolment of eligible.

During the course of Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls, ordered by the Election Commission of India, the BLOs shall be required to be present in their respective jurisdiction. Duties and Responsibilities of BLO is annexed herewith as **ANNEXURE-I**.

The work of each BLOs shall be supervised by BLO-Supervisors appointed herewith. The BLO-Supervisor shall maintain check on the quality of work done by the Booth Level Officers and closely monitor their functioning. They shall work as a link between Booth Level Officers and Electoral Registration Officer/Assistant Electoral Registration Officers. They shall also be deemed to be on deputation to the Election Commission and therefore will be under the disciplinary control of the Election Commission of India under the provisions of Section 13CC of the Representation of the People Act, 1950.

All the BLOs are also hereby directed to carry out collection/updation of Aadhaar data from the electors for linking and authentication of entries in electoral roll during house to house verification on **21.07.2023 (Friday) to 21.08.2023 (Monday)** 9.00AM to 5.00PM of Special Summary Revision, 2024.

All the Heads of Department/Officer are requested to spare the services of the staff under their control during the Summary Revision period as mentioned below in the Pre-Revision and Revision Activities:-

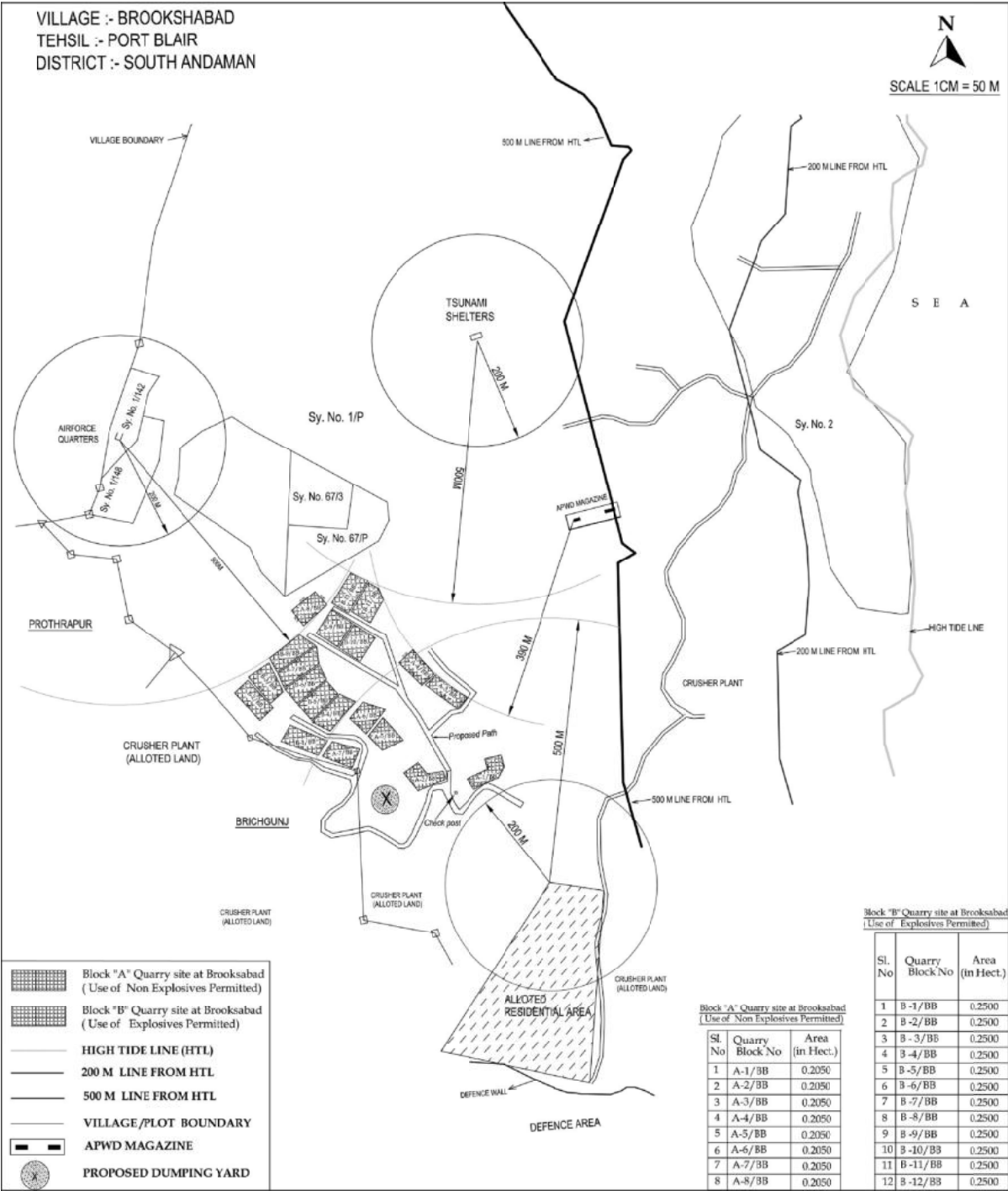

 - No sub-lease/sublet or any types of agreement of the quarry shall be permitted.
 - No bid which is below the minimum reserve price fixed for the quarry area shall be accepted.

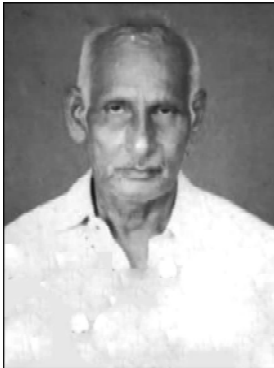
