## Successful PPP model can serve for tackling global challenges in other fields to create environment friendly, affordable, scalable solutions for a sustainable future: Minister

Panaji, July 19 (PIB)

Addressing the Clean Energy Ministerial (CEM -14) 8th Mission Innovation (MI-8) meeting, attended by representatives of over 40 countries in Goa today, Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh called for affordable Clean Energy solutions and said, in order to achieve this goal, strong Public Private Partnership is the need of the hour. He also reiterated Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi's commitment to this cause. The Minister representing India, the host country, said,



Clean Energy International Incubation Centre known as CEIIC set up in 2018, has incubated 45 StartUps and they have already filed 35 patents. He informed that 10 StartUps have commercialized their products and a few StartUps have raised more than Rs. 20 crore funds, while 20 of these startups are now commercially available in the market.

recalled that the Clean Energy International Incubation Centre known as CEIIC is a first of its kind International Incubation Centre jointly established by DBT/BIRAC, Tata Trust & Tata Power in 2018 under Mission Innovation multilateral program. He said, this reflects strong Public Private Partnership commitment from Govt. of India for

promoting clean energy solutions.

The Minister said, the incubator supports a wide spectrum of clean energy innovations, focusing aligned with MI objectives. The Incubator provides access to advanced labs and equipment, pool of experts & mentors, and live Test beds with opportunity to conduct Pilots. It also offers opportunities to network with key ecosystem actors, access Seed fund support and Scale-up Investments, he added.

Dr Jitendra Singh also announced that CEIIC incubated StartUp 'Takachar' was named the GBP1 million Earth shot prize winner for its technology innovation.

Port Blair, July 19 and following the Adoption Resource Information and Guidance System (CARINGS), portal.

Children are the supreme asset & the most precious treasure of every nation. India has the largest child population in the world. Although the Constitution of India guarantees several rights to the children, but still there are children who are neglected and abandoned by their parents, who are vulnerable to child abuse, trafficking, forced labour etc. at a very tender age. Adoption is the suitable resort for their secured life.

As per the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection for children) Act, the State Government shall recognise one or more institutions in each district as a Specialised Adoption Agency (SAA). It must be a registered Child Care Institution run for housing orphan, abandoned and surrendered children who are placed by the order of Child Welfare Committee for the purpose of adoption. SAA is mandated to furnish report regarding all cases of a d m i s s i o n s , restorations, transfers, death and adoption of children and also to submit the status of every orphan, abandoned and surrendered child to the Child Welfare Committee, District Child Protection Welfare at Room No 308, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.

Through the process of adoption, an individual/couple assumes parental rights of a child, who is not biologically his/ her kid, and the child so becomes the legitimate child of his adoptive parents. It is now mandatory to register online on CARINGS to adopt a child. One can adopt a child only through submission of online application available at [www.cara.nic.in](http://www.cara.nic.in)

Indian Shuttler Satwiksairaj Rankireddy sets Guinness world record for fastest badminton shot

New Delhi, July19 Indian Shuttler S a t w i k s a i r a j Rankireddy has set the Guinness world record for the fastest shot by a male player in badminton, recording a mindboggling 565 kilometres per hour with his smash during the game. Satwik, who along with his partner Chirag Shetty won the Indonesia Open recently, broke a decade-long record set in May 2013 by Malaysian Tan Boon Heong, who had produced a speed of 493 kilometres per hour with his smash. Malaysia's Tan Pearly set the Guinness world record for the fastest female badminton hits with a remarkable speed of 438 kilometres per hour. The world record attempts were achieved on the 14th of April this year and were verified by official judges from the Guinness world records based on the speed measurement results from that day. Satwik's smash was conducted in a c o n t r o l l e d environment at the Yonex factory gymnasium at Soka, Saitama in Japan.



India defeats Bangladesh by 108 runs in second women's ODI

Dhaka, July 19 In women's cricket, India defeated Bangladesh by 108 runs in the second ODI, being played at S h e r - e - B a n g l a National Cricket Stadium in Mirpur, Dhaka. Chasing a victory target of 229 runs, the hosts were bundled out for 120 runs in 35.1 overs.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Clause (xviii) of Section 96 (2) read with sub-section 41 of section 2 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988), the following draft rules, further to amend the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Motor Vehicles Rules, 2006, which the Andaman & Nicobar Administration proposes to make, is hereby published as required under sub-section (1) of section 212 of the said Act for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration after the expiry of a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette together with any objections or suggestions that may be received in respect thereto by the stipulated period.

DRAFT RULE

1. Short Title and Commencement

i. These rules may be called the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Motor Vehicles Amendment Rules, 2023.

ii. They shall come into force on the date of their final publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Amendment in Rule 70 (5):

Sub-Rule (5) of Rule 70 of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Motor Vehicles Rules, 2006 shall be substituted as below:-

"(5) No motor cab, other than a metered taxi and metered autorickshaw, shall be painted in a colour or colours prescribed for motor cabs in this rule and no metered taxi and metered autorickshaw shall be permitted to ply if it does not conform to the provisions of this sub-rule, namely:-

a. (i) colour of the body of all metered taxi shall be painted in white colour.

(ii) In right-hand side and left-hand side, a horizontal strip line of mystic purple colour having 06 inches thickness running from front wheel arch to rear side body and at the end of the strip, there shall be three square dots of mystic purple colour of size 06 inches x 06 inches with a gap of 02 inches in between the square dots.

(iii) The word "TAXI" shall be written at the centre in the mystic purple strips of both right-hand side and left-hand side in bold capital letters having font height of 04 inches."

(iv) The roof of the metered taxi shall be fitted with Rooftop Illuminated Taxi Sign having dimensions 13.78 inches X 3.94 inches X 3.74 inches (L X B X H) respectively.

b . colour of hood of all metered autorickshaw shall be painted in cream yellow and rest of the body in black;

c. the permit number in addition to the registration mark, shall be painted on the cab in white in a red circle, the size of number being 5 centimeters in height and 4 centimeters in breadth at four different places;

(i) on left hand top portion of the windscreen readable from inside;

(ii) on the rear boot against black background;

(iii) on the left front door against black background;

(iv) on the right front door against black background,"






