14 hrs shutdown of Segment-1 of CANI-Submarine Cable for scheduled migration activities of newly laid alternate land cable

Port Blair, July 23

The general public, business entities and stakeholders of A&N Islands have been informed that due to construction of alternate land cable path, Segment-1 (Chennai - Port Blair link) of CANI Submarine Cable will be affected due to ongoing construction work of an underground Metro Station at the Chennai, Mandaveli junction by CMRL (Chennai Metro Rail Limited).

Accordingly, the CANI Submarine of Cable Segment-1, (Chennai to Port Blair) will be temporary shutdown during the night hours of

29.07.2023 from 2000 hours (8 pm) to 30.07.2023 1000 hours (10 am), approximate downtime of 14 hours. All efforts will be made to minimize the downtime window to the least extent possible. During the period, high speed internet will be affected. To mitigate the impact of this disruption, the Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) have already been advised for making alternate arrangements at their end. BSNL essential services (2G mobile + landline) will be maintained through Satellite medium, a press release from the Secretary (IT) said.

The Common Higher Secondary Level Examination for filling up Group 'C' vacant posts in various Departments of A&N Administration was conducted on 23.07.2023 across the

A&N Islands at 09 Tehsils by the A&N Administration with the help of Staff Selection Commission, New Delhi. In all 21882 candidates had applied online for around 488 vacancies and 18584 candidates

appeared in the examination. The overall attendance rate has been encouraging 84.9%. Despite various constraints, Administration had made elaborate arrangements at the examination centres

located at the far-flung islands to conduct free, fair and transparent examination. To ensure the integrity and sanctity of the examination, the Administration utilized the services of several IAS, IPS, IFS

officers and DANICS officers apart from other officers from the local Administration viz, Education, APWD, Police and Forest Departments. To rule out any possibility of electronic unfair means, the

Administration installed jammers at all the examination centres with the assistance of Bharat Electronic Limited.

the Administration had installed CCTVs in the control rooms of the designated examination centres in all the 56 centres all over the A&N Islands. Moreover, the transportation of examination materials from the strong room to the designated examination centres had been videographed, besides engaging dedicated videographers at all the designated centres to avoid any malpractice.

The Administration has been conducting the recruitment examinations to fill up all the vacancies under A&N Administration. In order to accommodate the candidates, 56 centres across the islands i.e.44 centres were located in South Andaman District while out of the rest, 08 were located in N&M Andaman District and 04 were located in the Nicobar District.

During the examination, suitable arrangements were made for the eligible specially abled candidates belonging to Visually Handicapped (VH) & Cerebral Palsy (CP) category. The Administration tried its best to accommodate them to the extent possible within the frame work of Rules to allow all the eligible candidates to avail the opportunity.

Wei Keng and Wang Chang. The world number three Indian pair notched up a 21-15, 24-22 win over the second-seeded Chinese in a 40-minute duel at the Jinnam stadium in Yeosu. It was Satwik and Chirag's first win over the Chinese pair following two earlier defeats. Satwik and Chirag, who has won the Indonesia Super 1000 and Swiss Open Super 500 titles this year will look to add another feather to their already decorated cap with a win in the Korea Open.

efforts are on to create international level fishing eco system which will include development of big fishing harbor, deep sea going fishing vessels with professional workforce, fish processing units with advanced technology etc. Once the complete fishing ecosystem is ready, we shall be able to export fish to South East Asia as well as International markets and the islanders will also get best price for it.



The Chief Secretary further informed about the good market potential of spices of A&N Islands which have great demand among visitors/tourists. He said A&N Isles' produces best quality of cinnamon and there is need for proper packaging and branding of cinnamon and other spices for its sale not only in mainland but also in International markets. He further stated that the coconut produced in Carnicobar is of high quality. There is need for proper branding of virgin coconut oil for fetching better price. The A&N Administration is in constant touch with Indian Institute of Packaging who have provided some samples of packaging and shared know-how on desiccating & seasoning copra, the Chief Secretary informed.

The Chief Secretary complimented the Officer-in-Charge of NABARD Regional Office, Smt. Archana Singh and her team for their commendable achievements in implementing various funding schemes of NABARD and their proactive roles in supporting the Self Help Groups in A&N Islands.

On this occasion, PACS in A&N Islands along with Master Trainers were felicitated by the Chief Secretary for completing the first phase of computerization under the GoI project and being the only State/UT to achieve 100% FHR in the country. 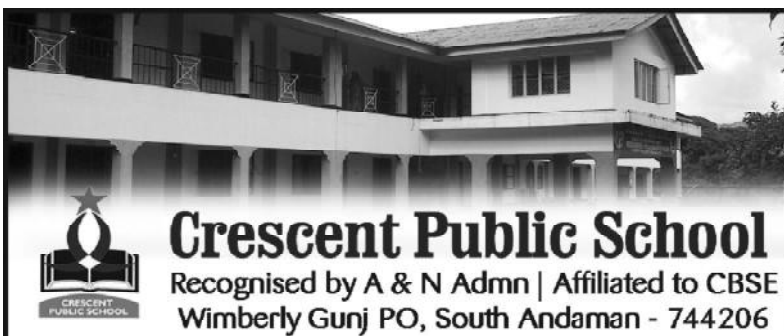
