Union Health Ministry notifies new rules for anti-tobacco warnings on OTT platforms

Every publisher of online-curated content displaying tobacco products or their use shall display anti-tobacco warning

New Delhi, May 31

Union Health Ministry has notified new rules for anti-tobacco warnings on OTT platforms. The notification mandates OTT platforms to carry anti-tobacco warning messages. Every publisher of online-curated content displaying tobacco products or their use shall display anti-tobacco health spots, of minimum thirty seconds duration each at the beginning and

middle of the programme. Strict action will be taken if the publisher of online content fails to comply with the new rules. An Inter-Ministerial Committee consisting of representatives from Health Ministry, Information and Broadcasting Ministry and Electronics and IT Ministry shall take action suo motu or on a complaint.

The notification came on the occasion

of World No Tobacco Day being observed today. This year, the theme of the day is 'We Need Food, Not Tobacco'. According to the World Health Organisation, the 2023 global campaign aims to raise awareness about alternative crop production and marketing opportunities for tobacco farmers and encourage them to grow sustainable, nutritious crops. Interview of Secretary (Civil Aviation) broadcast through Akashvani Port Blair

Secretary throws light on major projects under RCS-UDAN Scheme to bolster Civil Aviation sector of Isles

Port Blair, May 31

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS has directed all Secretaries of the Departments concerned to give interviews in Akashvani Port Blair and Doordarshan (DD) and highlight the initiatives taken by the Departments involved in public delivery services to improve public delivery system, social infrastructure and social benefit schemes. As per the roster, the interview of Secretary (Civil Aviation), Shri Vishwendra was broadcast today through Akashvani Port Blair and the same is being reproduced in Q&A format for the wider reach of the people of A&N Islands.



Interviewer: What is the major role of Civil Aviation Department in these Islands? Kindly tell us about the functioning of the Civil Aviation Department and Civil Aviation Ministry?

Secretary (Civil Aviation): Ministry of Civil Aviation frames policies at pan India basis and implements various schemes in different States & UTs. There are three regulatory bodies under Civil Aviation Ministry such as Airport Authority of India, DGCA to regulate Airlines and Security aspects are being looked after by the Bureau of Civil Aviation. The Civil Aviation Department at State level implements various schemes of the Ministry. The implementation of RCS -UDAN Scheme (Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik) wherein the aspects of connecting small Airports is dealt by the Civil Aviation Department of the UT Administration. Apart from this, for individual specific needs, the Administration in association with the Pawan Hans Helicopters Limited provide Helicopter services for inter-island connectivity. The main aim of this service is for medical evacuation, helping people during emergency and transporting Islanders.

Interviewer: How many Aircraft & Pawan Hans Helicopters are available with the Civil Aviation Department?

Secretary (Civil Aviation): Aircrafts are generally operated by airline operators. As of now, the A & N Administration has no personal aircraft. However, one Dornier Aircraft of the Defence operates in Inter-Island sector for the help of the Islanders from Port Blair to Campbell Bay, once in a week. Apart from this, the Department is having 4 Dauphin-N3 Helicopters which are functional at present. These helicopters connect different Islands as per its scheduled flight for transporting Islanders and medical evacuees. The Pawan Hans Ltd. has a schedule for carrying out servicing/repairing of helicopters, the contract of operation/maintenance is with them. Minor repairs of the Helicopters are done by them at Port Blair itself while for major repairs, it is shifted to Chennai or Mumbai.

Interviewer: How many Helipads are there and how many are being put to use?

Secretary (Civil Aviation): There are 19 Helipads in A&N Islands. Out of the 19 Helipads, 11 are frequently used by the Civil Aviation Department. The Administration has prepared a plan for further expansion of Helipads. The new helipads

will be categorized as 'Emergency Helipads'. These Helipads will be constructed in those Islands, where population is there and connectivity is not available. Estimates for development of two Helipads, one each at Smith Island and Hanspuri have already been prepared. Apart from this, the identified areas where Helipads are being constructed include Afra Bay, Maccachua, Pilomilo and Tillangchong. Our vision is to provide connectivity to all the inhabited Islands, so that during any emergency or disaster, the A&N Administration is able to reach out to the residents of that area for any help.

Interviewer: Do you provide any subsidy in fares to local inhabitants for availing Heli services?

Secretary (Civil Aviation): The Islanders as well as the families of Govt. Servants are being provided 90 percent subsidies in fares and they have to pay only 10%. The second category is the Govt. Servants on duty and they are provided 75 percent subsidy, the decision for the same was taken by the Lt. Governor in the year 2003. Similarly for non islander families of Govt. Servants serving in A&N Islands, 90% subsidy is provided for inter-island movement.

Interviewer: What is the status of Regional Connectivity Scheme -UDAN Scheme, how beneficial it is for improving inter-island connectivity?

Secretary (Civil Aviation): The Regional Connectivity Scheme -UDAN scheme is a boon for the A&N Islands under the leadership of the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Minister of Civil Aviation and Ministry of Civil Aviation. Under this scheme, the Department plans to broadly start two types of operations on ground. Under this scheme, the plan is to operate Fixed Wing Aircraft from Port Blair- Shibpur (Diglipur) and from Port Blair- Car Nicobar- Campbell Bay. Under this, the Passenger Terminal at Shibpur Airbase has already been completed and has been handed over to the AAI. The agreement between the A&N Administration and AAI is under process and it is expected that Fixed Wing Aircraft Service of 19 Seater planes will start soon. The GoI has identified the operator named 'Big Charter'. Passenger Terminals are under construction at Car Nicobar and Campbell Bay and by June end it is expected that Passenger Terminal at Car Nicobar will be ready and Big Charter is the

ISRO to launch Chandrayaan-3 in July this year: Chairman ISRO

Sriharikota, May 31

The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) Chairman, Shri S. Somanath has said that Chandrayaan-3 will be launched in July this year. He was speaking after the successful launch of the second-generation navigation satellite NSV-01 from Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota. He said, the target is to launch Chandrayaan-3 in July in the time slot based on orbital parameters, and the ISRO is working



towards that end.

Chandrayaan-3 is a follow-on mission to Chandrayaan-2 to demonstrate end-to-end capability in safe landing and roving on the moon. It consists of an

indigenous lander module, a propulsion module and a rover. The lander and the rover will have scientific payloads to carry out experiments on the lunar surface. (Source: india.gov.in)

As part of Digital India Initiative, the UIDAI has urged the residents to get benefit of free document update facility on myAadhaar

portal. The free service is available till 14th June, 2023.

The UIDAI also encourages residents to upload Proof of Identity (PoI) and Proof of Address (PoA) documents to revalidate their demographic details, especially if Aadhaar was issued 10 years back and never got updated. This will help in improving ease of living, better service delivery and enhancing

authentication success rate.

Residents of Andaman & Nicobar Islands can login to <https://myaadhaar.uidai.gov.in/> using their Aadhaar Number and update their Aadhaar Card free of cost. If unable to do so, they may visit nearest Aadhaar Centre for document update by paying a fee of Rs. 50/-, a press release from Deptt. of CS&CA said.

Operator in this sector too, the agreement for which is under process. The Sector connecting Car Nicobar to Campbell Bay has been provided to SpiceJet Group. The Passenger Terminal at Campbell Bay Airstrip is expected to be completed by March, 2024 which will pave the way for aircraft operation to Campbell Bay. The Fixed Wing Aircraft Operation comes under the segment of the RCS-UDAN scheme.

The second segment is operation of Seaplane. Under this, Port Blair-Swaraj Dweep will be covered first. The requisite environment clearance is under final stages for taking up the construction of Water Aerodromes. The Environment clearance for Water Aerodromes at Shaheed Dweep and Long Island have already been granted during a meeting held on May 10 and the land side development will be done by APWD besides design finalization, estimate preparation work completion are the other aspects being looked into by APWD. The sea-side development work has already been awarded to ALHW for which it has completed the tendering process and work will start soon. Once completed, these projects will improve the connectivity in different Islands and with the availability of multiple options, the reliability and comfort in inter-island connectivity will increase.

Interviewer: Kindly explain what is Water Aerodromes and will it be successful in A&N Islands taking into account the weather condition?

Secretary (Civil Aviation): Water Aerodrome facilitates landing of Amphibian Aircrafts. There is no issue in the landing of Amphibious Aircrafts in water. The location of these Aerodromes is selected in bay areas which are protected. For example, the sea side area of Swaraj Dweep Aerodrome is situated at Lakam Bay area in between the Jetty and Lighthouse area and sea is very calm in this area. In the marked water strip, a floating water platform of 9x49 mtrs is placed where passengers alight from the aircraft and take a boat to the existing jetty and disembark.

Interviewer: Can you elaborate on infrastructure development and modernization plan?

Secretary (Civil Aviation): Govt. of India has already approved the project for complete fleet upgradation of Helicopters. The present Dauphin N3 Helicopters will be replaced and world's latest helicopters will be inducted through PHL. This two year project costs Rs. 415 crores. Safety & swiftness of passengers and flying capacity in difficult weather conditions are the three prominent features of these new helicopters. The new air conditioned helicopters having good carrying capacity will provide comfortable journey to the islanders and it will also improve the Inter-Island connectivity at large.

Interviewer: All our airports belong to Ministry of Defence can you comment on this?

Secretary (Civil Aviation): The UT Administration and ANC under the guidance of Lt. Governor have better and effective co-ordination. Under the RCS-UDAN scheme, the Shippur Airstrip is a defence base where the passenger terminals has been built by Administration to materialize UDAN scheme. Car Nicobar and Campbell Bay is also a defence base where Passenger Terminals are being built by Administration. The new Integrated Terminal at Port Blair is also being built by GoI. Our effort is to provide maximum benefit to the Islanders.

Interviewer: The A&N Administration is carrying out recruitment drives in various Departments. Is there any recruitment being conducted by Civil Aviation Department?

Secretary (Civil Aviation): Staff of Civil Aviation are mostly outsourced from various Departments of A&N Administration. Since the work involves electronic related work, as of now, no recruitment is being done.

Interviewer: In the 80s, we had our own 'Andaman Nicobar Flying Training Institute'. Do you have any plan to start such institute in the future for the benefit of the youth of our Islands?

Secretary (Civil Aviation): Flying Institute or Institutes related to aircraft flying needs better flying instructors with better equipment and best safety infrastructures. As per the present status, the Department has to create robust infrastructures which will take time.

Interviewer: With the coming up of this new Airport Terminal, do you think there will be more employment opportunities in this sector?

Secretary (Civil Aviation): We cannot isolate the new Veer Savarkar International Airport Terminal Building with the A&N Islands' economy. Along with the development of the New Integrated Terminal Building (NITB), re-surfacing of the Run way is also underway which will pave way for night landing of aircrafts by December. The capacity of the number of flights arriving in Isles will increase. At present, we have 5 Parking Bays for parking of flights and after inauguration of the NITB, the number of Parking Bays will go up to 8. The number of increased flight traffic will increase the inflow of tourists. This will multiply the economy and it will also increase the prospects for job. The employment in Aviation Sector is of highly specialized and highly skilled in nature considering the safety angle which is of paramount importance and only best suited candidates should get into this field as it involves safety of people.

Interviewer: What would you like to tell people about the future of Civil Aviation sector in our Islands?

Secretary (Civil Aviation): As the Secretary of Civil Aviation Department, I would like to convey to the Islanders that Civil Aviation Department is committed towards the implementation of the projects devised by the GoI which comes under RCS-UDAN Scheme such as fleet modernization, sea plane operations etc. With better & effective co-ordination of A&N Administration and ANC, all the projects will be completed in time and it will be successful.

Due to anticipated strong Southwest monsoon current, wind speed is likely to prevail between 40-50 kmph over South Andaman Sea. Fishermen have been advised not to venture into South

Andaman Sea till June 3. AB PM-JAY achieves milestone of 5 crore hospital admissions amounting to Rs 61,501 crore

Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY) achieved a milestone of 5 crore hospital admissions amounting to 61 thousand 501 crore rupees. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare in a statement today said that till date, over 23 crore beneficiaries have been verified and issued Ayushman Cards for availing free treatment in PM-JAY empaneled hospital network consisting of 28 thousand 351 hospitals, including



12 thousand 824 private hospitals across the country. It added that the flagship scheme being implemented by the National Health Authority provides health cover of 5 lakhs rupees per family per year for secondary and

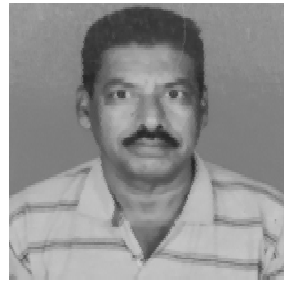

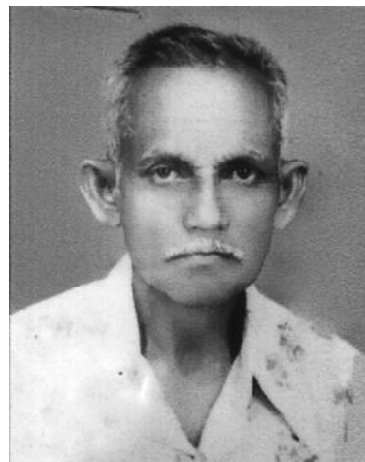
