PM addresses G20 Development Ministers' Meeting

Digitalization has brought about a revolutionary change where technology is being used as a tool to empower people, make data accessible and ensure inclusivity

New Delhi, June 12 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed the G20 Development Ministers' Meeting today via video message. Highlighting the significance of Kashi, the Prime Minister said that it has been the center of knowledge, discussion, debate, culture, and spirituality for centuries while it also has the essence of India's diverse heritage serving as a convergence point for people from all parts of the country. Shri Modi expressed delight that the G20 Development agenda has reached Kashi as well.

"Development is a core issue for the Global South", the Prime Minister remarked as he pointed out that the countries of the Global South were severely impacted by the disruptions created due to the global Covid pandemic while geo-political tensions were responsible for food, fuel, and fertilizer crises. In such circumstances, the Prime Minister continued, the decisions you make are significant for humanity as a



whole. Shri Modi emphasized that it is the collective responsibility of the people to not let the Sustainable Development Goals fall behind. He further added that the Global South must send a strong message to the world

investment in fulfilling the SDGs and also finding solutions to address the debt risks faced by many countries. The Prime Minister remarked that multilateral financial institutions should be reformed to expand the eligibility criteria to ensure that finance is accessible to those in need. In India, the Prime Minister continued, we have made efforts to improve people's lives in more than a hundred Aspirational Districts which were pockets of under-development. He underscored that these Aspirational Districts have now emerged as the catalysts of growth in the country as he urged the G20 Development Ministers to study this model of development. "It may be relevant as you work towards accelerating Agenda 2030", he added.

Highlighting the issue of the growing data divide, the Prime Minister said that high-quality data is critical for meaningful policy-making, efficient resource allocation, and effective public

Novak Djokovic reaches record 23 grand slam titles after French Open final win

Paris, June 12

In Tennis, Serbian Novak Djokovic created history by becoming the first man to reach the coveted 23 grand slam title mark with his straight sets win over Casper Ruud in the men's singles final of the French Open 2023 in Paris. This was the Serb's 3<sup>rd</sup> title on Parisian clay as he goes past rival Rafael Nadal as the man with the most number of major honours in the history of the game.

The World No. 3 ranked Serb breezed past his opponent 7-6, 6-3, 7-5 to claim his third French Open title and 23<sup>rd</sup> grand slam title overall. With this victory, the three-time French Open winner will reclaim the No. 1 spot from Carlos Alcaraz in the ATP Rankings. He surpassed



Rafael Nadal as the oldest Roland Garros champion at the age of 36 years and 20 days and with this victory, he became the first man to win all four Grand Slam events at least three times.

FIH Pro League 2023: India beat Argentina 2-1 in final match at Eindhoven in Netherlands

Eindhoven, June 12

In Hockey, India beat Argentina 2-1 in its final FIH Pro League 2022-23 match in Eindhoven, the Netherlands, yesterday. Akashdeep Singh and Sukhjeet Singh scored goals for India while Lucas Toscani netted the only goal for Argentina.

With this victory, India consolidated their position atop the FIH Pro League standings with 30 points from 16 matches. Argentina are fifth with 13 points from 14 matches. India now holds a four-point advantage over second-placed Great Britain in the FIH Pro League

2022-23 standings but the European team has four games to go. The Indian men's hockey team finished in fourth place in their debut FIH Pro League campaign back in 2020-21. Their best finish in the competition, third, came in the 2021-22 season.


