## President interacts with the members of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups

### Urges the members of PVTGs to give utmost importance to education

New Delhi, June 13 (PIB)

The President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu interacted with the members of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) at Rashtrapati Bhavan yesterday. She also witnessed cultural performances which included Mal Pahariya of Bihar, Siddi of Gujarat, Irula of Kerala, Sahariya of Rajasthan, Baiga Pardhauni of Madhya Pradesh and Budigali of Odisha, on the occasion.

Addressing the gathering, the President said that she was happy to meet the members of all 75 PVTGs together. She welcomed them at Rashtrapati Bhavan. She noted that many of them have come out from their villages for the first time. She said that each one of them is a representative of their community. She urged



them to share their experiences with their community-members and inform them about the welfare schemes of the Government.

The President urged the members of PVTGs to give utmost importance to education. She said that for the students of PVTG community, special provision of seats has been made in Eklavya Model Residential

Schools. Apart from this, seats are also reserved for them in the National Fellowship and Overseas Scholarship Scheme. She also urged women of PVTG to take advantage of various schemes, including Tribal Women Empowerment Scheme. The President said that under the Tribal Sub-Plan, 41 Ministries and Departments of the Government of India

share part of their budget for the welfare of tribal communities, including PVTGs. She was happy to note that 'Pradhan Mantri PVTG Development Mission' has been launched by the Government for the development of PVTGs.

The President said that the campaign announced in the current budget to eradicate Sickle Cell

## Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation chairs meeting with Ministers of Disaster Management of the States/UTs

### Union Home Minister announces three major schemes worth more than Rs. 8000 crore for disaster management in the country

New Delhi, June 13 (PIB)

Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah chaired a meeting with Ministers of Disaster Management of the States/Union Territories, at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi, today. Along with Chief Ministers of States/Ministers, Lieutenant Governors / Administrators of Union Territories, senior officers from Disaster Management Department of State Government/Union Territories, Member, (NDMA), Director General, (NDRF), Director General (FS, CD and HG), Executive Director, (NIDM) and senior officials of Ministry of Home Affairs were present in the meeting.

Under the vision @ 2047 of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, the main objective of the meeting was to further strengthen the disaster risk reduction system in the country to make India disaster resilient and to discuss various issues related to disaster management with the Administration of States and Union Territories. In his address, Shri Amit Shah announced three major schemes of over Rs. 8,000 crore regarding the disaster management in the country:

- 1) Rs. 5,000 crore project to expand and modernize fire services across the States.
- 2) Rs. 2,500-crore project to reduce the risk of urban flooding in the seven most populous metros - Mumbai, Chennai, Kolkata, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Ahmedabad and Pune.
- 3) Rs. 825 Crore National Landslide Risk Mitigation Project for Landslide Mitigation in



17 States and Union Territories.

He said that it should be our endeavour that not a single person's life lost due to disaster, and under the leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, all the States have made efforts towards achieving this goal in the last 5 years.

Union Home Minister said that the discussions during the meeting are essential for formulating and revising policies at the national level. He said that the Centre and the States have achieved many milestones in the last nine years, but we cannot be complacent. He said that the nature of the disasters has changed and their frequency and intensity have also increased, and for this reason we have to sharpen and broaden our preparedness to deal with them. He said that many new disasters are being encountered at various places, and we have to be prepared for them.

Shri Amit Shah said that post 2004, after extensive discussion on disaster management at the national level, a collective responsibility and response mechanism was developed at the Centre and State level. He said that during the Covid-19

## Fisheries Deptt. distributing freshwater fish seeds of Indian Major Carps to farmers

### Interested farmers urged to visit the Farm at Nayagoan

Port Blair, June 13

The seasonal freshwater fish seed production through induced breeding successfully commenced in Freshwater Fish Seed Farm, Nayagoan of Department of Fisheries. The Departmental Fish Seed Farm is operating with sufficient Breeder/ Nursery ponds/Circular hatchery for systematic selection, breeding and seed production of Indian Major Carps including Catla, Rohu and Mrigal to cater the demand of freshwater fish seed, thereby promoting Freshwater Aquaculture activities in A&N Islands.



The breeding season starts from the month of June and closes by October every year. During this period, fresh water fish seed of various stages (Spawn, Fry and Fingerlings) is produced and supplied to the fish farmers at nominal rates for further stocking in



their ponds. To begin with the seed production activity during the ongoing season, first sets of Catla fish was administered hormonal injection on 09/06/2023 and approximately 85 Liters of fertilized egg was

Handicrafts Service Center, Port Blair has invited applications from the eligible Master Craftsperson who have completed the age of 60 years on or before 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2023 for the year 2022-23 for financial support in indigent circumstances @ Rs.8,000/- per month. Master craftsperson who is the recipient of Shilp Guru Award, National Award, Merit Certificate or State Award in Handicrafts

will be eligible for being considered for financial assistance. The annual income of the artisans should not exceed to Rs. 1,00,000/-. An income certificate for the financial year 2022-23 issued by the Office of District Magistrate/ Revenue Department/ Tehsildar/ Collector/ Circle Officer of the concerned State is necessary as a proof of income. The applicant should not be a recipient of similar financial assistance from any

Over 57,000 migrant workers registered for special one nation one Anganwadi programme across the country

New Delhi, June 13  
More than 57,000 migrant workers have registered for the special one nation one Anganwadi programme across the country. Under the programme, if people relocate to another State, they can avail of the benefits given to children under six years and pregnant women and lactating mothers. According to sources, the Ministry of Women and Child Development said that this is possible through coordination between the Centre and the State Governments by using the Poshan Tracker App on mobile phones. The Poshan Tracker m a n a g e m e n t application provides a 360-degree view of the activities of the Anganwadi Centre, service deliveries of Anganwadi Workers and complete beneficiary management for pregnant women, lactating mothers and children under six. The Anganwadi workers are being provided smartphones procured through Government e-Market for efficient service delivery. A total of 8.66 lakh such phones have been procured by all States and UTs. pandemic period, the Centre and the States, under the leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, successfully tackled the worst pandemic of the century. At that difficult time, the Central Government, the States and the public set an excellent example to the world of fighting together on every front. Shri Shah said that under the leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, the Government has provided more than 220 crore free Corona vaccines, arranged food for crores of poor people, brought back lakhs of labourers to their hometowns and made arrangements to address their concerns through DBT.  
Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation said that till a few years back, our approach towards disaster was reactionary and relief-centric. He said that during the last 9 years, under the leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, with collective hard work and dedication we have implemented on ground a new approach of early warning system, prevention, mitigation and preparedness-based disaster management. He said that the Modi Government has set a target of preparing around one lakh youth volunteers in 350 high-risk disaster prone districts, and we are getting very good results during disasters. Shri Shah said that under the leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, the Centre has made proactive efforts to help the States during the last four years by sending IMCT teams 73 times within a time frame of just 10 days. He said that comparing the 9 years from 2005-06 to 2013-14 with 2014-15 to 2022-23, the fund of Rs. 35,858 crore allocated to SDRF has now almost tripled to Rs. 1,04,704 crore. In addition, the release of funds from NDRF has increased by nearly three times from Rs. 25,000 crores to Rs. 77,000 crores. He said that due to proactive approach, Centre and States have increased budgetary provision in the areas of disaster risk reduction and post-disaster relief and rehabilitation. He said that in the year 2021, the National Disaster Mitigation Fund was constituted under the Central Government with Rs. 16,700 crore and under SDME Rs. 32,000 crore has been kept for mitigation activities. Shri Amit Shah said that the India Disaster Resource Network has been catalogued across the nation and over one lakh new records have been entered in it. Provision has also been made to implement Common Alerting Protocol through SMS at a cost of Rs. 354 crore. Steps like Disaster Management Information System Portal, 112 Emergency Response Support System are useful and multi-pronged initiatives. He said that Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has initiated the tradition of awarding the Subhash Chandra Bose Aapda Prabandhan Puraskar to the individuals and organizations who have contributed in the field of disaster management. Shri Shah said that it has given huge encouragement to the individuals and organizations working in this field.  
He asked all the States to adopt the Model Fire Bill and bring a uniform law across the States. During the meeting, topics related to disaster preparedness, mitigation, response, safety of nuclear power plants, early warning and dissemination systems, utilization of mitigation funds, setting up and strengthening of State Disaster Response Forces (SDRFs), State Disaster Management Authorities (SDMAs), District Disaster Management Authorities and encouraging volunteering by the community in disaster preparedness, response and mitigation were discussed.  
The Ministers and representatives of State Governments and Union Territories shared valuable inputs on the issues raised during the meeting. They also shared the best practices being followed by their respective States and views on the future challenges in disaster management.  
During the meeting, it was taken into cognizance that the Centre and the States together have achieved many milestones in the last nine years. It was re-emphasised in the meeting that team effort with seamless execution would result in minimum loss of lives, property and livelihood.
