

Port Blair, June 15 Reduction of childhood mortality to 23 per 1,000 live births by 2025 is one of the prime goals of National Health Policy 2019. Childhood diarrhoeal diseases continue to be a major killer among under-five children in many States. Diarrhoea is considered when the stools have changed from usual pattern with increase in frequency and change in consistency (more water than faecal matter). Almost all the deaths due to diarrhoea can be averted by preventing and treating dehydration by the use of ORS (Oral Rehydration Solution) and administration of Zinc




tablets along with adequate nutritional intake by the child during diarrhoea. Diarrhoea can be prevented by exclusive and continued breastfeeding, timely introduction of appropriate and safe complementary feeding, use of safe drinking water, hand-washing, sanitation and immunization.

ISRO to launch India's moon mission Chandrayaan 3 in second half of July this year

New Delhi, June 15

India's coveted Moon Mission Chandrayaan-3 is scheduled to be launched in July, most likely in the second half of the month. This was disclosed by Union Science and Technology Minister, Dr Jitendra Singh while addressing a media query on the sideline of a function. He said, if things go as planned, the Indian Space Research Organisation will launch its ambitious Chandrayaan-3 Mission which is aimed at demonstrating critical technology to land the Spacecraft on the South Pole of the Moon.

Earlier, Shri Singh had said that Chandrayaan -3 Spacecraft successfully



completed the essential tests that validated its capability to withstand the harsh environment that the Spacecraft would be facing during its launch and the subsequent journey. The Minister said, India's earlier lunar mission, Chandrayan -1 had earned the country a place of pride and supremacy in the world arena by identifying for the first time ever, the presence of water on the surface of the Moon. He added that this input was noted

with great significance even by the world's premier Space agencies like the USA's NASA. The Chandrayaan-3 is a follow up mission to Chandrayaan-2. Living upto the theme of Science of the Moon, the scientific instruments on the lander and the rover in the Chandrayaan will be capable of studying the various aspects of Moon including the Lunar environment and thermo-physio properties. - The Chairperson and Members of the Committee shall be paid sitting allowance @ Rs. 2000/- per sitting, travel allowance and any other allowance, as the UT Administration may prescribe. A maximum of 20 meetings per month can be held by the Committee.
- The Committee shall hold its sittings in the premises of a children's home or at a place in proximity to the children's home or at a suitable premises in any institution run under the Act for children in need of care and protection.
- The Committee shall ensure that no person(s) un-connected with the case remains preset in the room when the session is in progress.
- The Committee shall ensure that only those person(s), in the presence of whom the child feels comfortable, shall be allowed to remain present during the sitting.
- At least one member of the Committee shall always be available or accessible to take cognizance of any matter of emergency and issue necessary directions to the Special Juvenile Police Unit or local police of the district. For this purpose the Chairperson of the Committee shall draw up a monthly duty roster of the Committee members who shall be available and accessible every day, including on Sundays and holidays. The roster shall be circulated in advance to all the police stations, the Chief Judicial Magistrate, the District Judge, the District Magistrate, the Board, the District Child Protection Unit and are the Special Juvenile Police Unit.
- On receiving information about a child or children in need of care and protection, who cannot be produced before the Committee, the Committee shall reach out to the child or children and hold its sitting at a place that is convenient for such child or children.
- While communicating with the child, the Committee members shall use child friendly techniques through their conduct.
- The Committee shall hold its sitting in a child friendly premises which shall not look like a court room in any manner and the sitting arrangement should be such to enable the Committee to interact with the child face to face.
- The Committee shall not sit on a raised platform and there shall be no barriers, such as witness boxes or bars between the Committee and the children.
- The Committee shall have the authority to dispose of cases for the care, protection, treatment, development and rehabilitation of children in need of care and protection, as well as to provide for their basic needs and protection.
- The District Child Protection Unit shall provide a Secretary and other staff that may be required for secretarial support to the Committee for its effective functioning.
- Subject to the provisions of Sub-Section (1) of Section 28 of the JJ Act, the Committee may act, notwithstanding the absence of any member of the Committee, and no order made by the Committee shall be invalid for reason only of the absence of any member during any stage of the proceeding, provided that there shall be at least three members present at the time of final disposal of the case.
- No person shall be appointed for a period of more than three years as a Member of the Committee.
- A member of the Committee shall be eligible for appointment of maximum of two terms, which shall not be continuous.
- The appointment of any member of the Committee shall be terminated by the UT Administration after making an inquiry, if –
 - He/ she has been found guilty of misuse of power vested o him/her under this Act;
 - He/she has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude and such conviction has not been reversed or he/she has not been granted full pardon in respect of such offence;
 - He/she fails to attend the proceedings of the Committee consecutively for three months without any valid reason or he fails to attend less than three-fourths of the sittings in a year.
- The District Magistrate shall be the grievances redressal authority for the Child Welfare Committee and anyone connected with the child, may file a petition before the District Magistrate, who shall consider and pass appropriate orders.
- The powers of the Committee shall be carried out as prescribed in Section 30 of the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act 2015.
