She expressed confidence that the cadets would imbibe the spirit of this motto and live upto the expectations the nation has from them.

The President said that the great role played by the brave warriors of the Indian Air Force in defending the country in the wars with the hostile neighbour in 1948, 1965 and 1971 is written in golden letters.
