## PM addresses nation in Mann Ki Baat programme Calls upon people to adopt yoga in their lives and make it a part of their daily routine

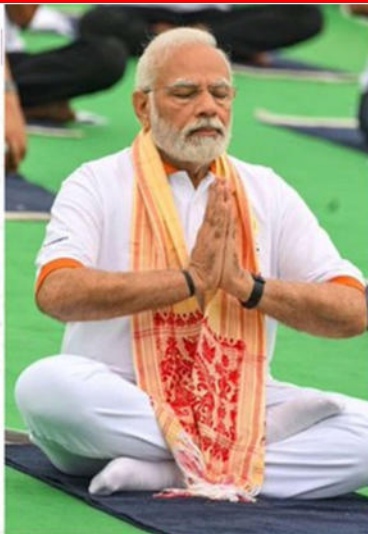
New Delhi, June 18

He said the 21<sup>st</sup> of June is a great opportunity to take this resolution for people who are not connected with Yog. The Prime Minister said, the country is making collective efforts to conserve water through campaigns like 'Catch the Rain'.

Last month in 'Mann Ki Baat', Shri Modi discussed start-ups associated with water conservation. Today, he mentioned Tulsiram Yadav of the Banda district of Uttar Pradesh. Tulsiram Yadav is the Pradhan of Luktara Gram Panchayat. In order to overcome the hardships regarding water in Banda and Bundelkhand regions, Tulsiram has

built more than 40 ponds in the area, along with the people of the village. As a result of his hard work, the groundwater level in his village is improving. Shri Modi said that similarly in the Hapur district of Uttar Pradesh, people have collectively revived an extinct river. There used to be a river named Neem in the area a long time

ago. People decided to revive this natural heritage and on account of the collective efforts of the people, the Neem river has started flowing again. Shri Modi said, the point of origin of the river is also being developed as an Amrit Sarovar.

not only water sources but life's myriad hues and emotions are also associated with them. He noted that the canal work of Nilwande Dam is being completed in Maharashtra. He added that the water was released in the canal during testing a few days ago. Shri Modi said, the pictures that came up during this time made him really emotional. He remarked that the people of the village were rejoicing as if it were the Holi-Diwali festival.

The Prime Minister spoke about Japan's Miyawaki technique for creating forests. He said that the Miyawaki method is a very good way to make an area green again. Miyawaki forests spread rapidly and become biodiversity spots in two to three decades. Shri Modi observed that this is now spreading very fast in different parts of India as well. He praised Raafi Ramnath, a teacher from Kerala, for changing the scenario of the area with this technique. Raafi Ramnath grew a mini forest with the Miyawaki technique and named it - 'Vidyavanam'. In the tiny space in this Vidyavanam, over 450 trees of 115 varieties were planted. His students also help him with their maintenance. School children from the neighbourhood and common citizens throng in hordes to view this beautiful place.

Prime Minister said Miyawaki forests can be easily grown anywhere, even in cities. He had inaugurated a Miyawaki forest in Kevadia, Ekta Nagar in Gujarat recently. In Kutch as well, in memory of the people who died in the 2001 earthquake, a Smriti-Van has been built in the Miyawaki style. Shri Modi added that its success in a place like Kutch shows how effective this technology is, even in the toughest of natural environments. Similarly, saplings have been planted in Ambaji and Pavagadh by the Miyawaki method. Miyawaki Garden is also being created in Aliganj, Lucknow. In the last four years, work has been done on more than 60 such forests in Mumbai and its surrounding areas. It is being used extensively in many countries like Singapore, Paris, Australia, and Malaysia. The Prime Minister urged the countrymen, especially those living in cities, to make an effort to learn about the Miyawaki method.

Shri Modi emphasised that India has resolved to create a TB-free India by 2025. He said, the goal is lofty and to eliminate tuberculosis from the root, Nikshay Mitras have taken the lead. A large number of varied social organisations have become Nikshay Mitras in the country. The Prime Minister said that thousands of people in villages and panchayats have come forward themselves and adopted TB patients. He noted that public participation is the biggest strength of this campaign and it is due to this participation that today, more than ten lakh TB patients in the country have been adopted. Shri Modi said, this is a noble deed on the part of close to 85 thousand Nikshay Mitras. He expressed happiness that many sarpanches of the country, even the village heads, have taken the initiative to not spare any effort to uproot TB from their villages. The Prime Minister mentioned Dikar Singh Mewari, a Nikshay friend of a village in Nainital, who has adopted six TB patients. Gyan Singh, head of a village panchayat of Kinnaur and a Nikshay Mitra, is also engaged in providing necessary help to TB patients in his block.

Prime Minister also cited the example of the people of Baramulla district of Jammu and Kashmir for starting dairy farming. There was a shortage of milk for a long time in the district. Shri Modi said the people of Baramulla took this challenge as an opportunity. He mentioned Ishrat Nabi who started Mir Sisters Dairy Farm. About 150 litres of milk is being sold every day from their dairy farm. Prime Minister also mentioned Wasim Anayat from Sopore. Wasim has more than two dozen animals and he sells more than two hundred litres of milk every day. Shri Modi also made note of the dairy farming done by Abid Hussain whose work is also progressing a lot. He said 5.5 lakh litres of milk is being produced daily in Baramulla due to the hard work of the people. He said entire Baramulla is turning into the symbol of a new white revolution. During the last two-and-a-half - three years, more than 500 dairy units have come up there. Prime Minister said the dairy industry of Baramulla is a testimony to the fact that every part of the country is full of possibilities.

Shri Modi also remembered Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj today and said the Sea-forts built by him still stand proudly in the middle of the sea. He said the beginning of this month itself marks the completion of 350 years of the coronation of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. This occasion is being celebrated as a big festival and grand programs related to it were organized in Raigad Fort in Maharashtra. Shri Modi said, it is the duty of all to know about the management skills of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj on this occasion and learn from him. The Prime Minister expressed delight that much good news came in for India this month from the sports world. He said, the Indian team has raised the glory of the Tricolour by winning the Women's Junior Asia Cup for the first time. Indian Men's Hockey Team has also won the Junior Asia Cup. With this, the team also became the team with the most wins in the history of this tournament. India's junior team also did wonders in the Junior Shooting World Cup and secured the first position in this tournament. Out of the total gold medals in this tournament, 20 percent has come in India's account alone. The Asian Under Twenty Athletics Championship was also held this month and India remained in the top three in the medal tally among 45 countries. Shri Modi exuded pride that for the first time, India is making her presence felt in Sports. In the long jump, Shrishankar Murali won a bronze for the country in Paris Diamond League. This is India's first medal in this competition. One such similar success has been registered by India's Under Seventeen Women Wrestling Team in Kyrgyzstan. Shri Modi congratulated all the athletes of the country, their parents, and coaches for their efforts.

He said that the hard work of sportspersons is behind the success of India in international events. He added that today, sports are being organized with new enthusiasm in different States of the country. He made note of the Khelo India University Games which were organized in Uttar Pradesh recently. He said, the nation's youth have broken eleven records in these games. Punjab University, Amritsar's Guru Nanak Dev University and Karnataka's Jain University have occupied the first three places in the medal tally.

Shri Modi also mentioned the interesting events held by the Raj Bhavans of the country. He said Raj Bhavans in the country are now being identified with social and development work. He added that Raj Bhavans are becoming the flag bearers of the TB-Free India campaign and the campaign related to Organic farming. He said that the enthusiasm with which different Raj Bhavans celebrated their foundation days is an initiative that empowers the spirit of Ek Bharat-Shreshtha Bharat. (Source: india.gov.in)

**Indian archer Abhishek Verma clinch gold medal in men's compound individual final at Archery World Cup Stage 3**

Medellin, June 18

Indian archer Abhishek Verma clinched gold medal in the men's compound individual final at the Archery World Cup Stage 3 in Medellin, Colombia. With this medal, Abhishek became the third Indian compound archer to book a spot in the 2023 Archery World Cup Final which will be played on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> of September in Hermosillo,

Mexico. The 33-year-old Abhishek defeated James Lutz of USA 148-146 yesterday, adding the second gold to the Indian medal tally.

En route to the gold in this tournament, Abhishek also beat world number one and top seed Mike Schloesser on Thursday. Abhishek is multiple World Cup gold medalist including the compound team gold and an individual



silver in the 2014 Incheon Asian Games. The Indian contingent, which has won two gold and three bronze medals so far.

Intensified Diarrhoea Control Fortnight (IDCF) consists of a set of activities to be implemented in an intensified manner during IDCF 2023 for prevention and control of deaths due to dehydration from diarrhoea. Prevention of Diarrhoea



Wash both the hands with soap before preparing food, feeding the child, after defecation and after cleaning child's faeces.



Ensure that the drinking water is clean and stored in a safe and covered container.



Ensure that the child's surroundings are hygienic and wash hands of your children frequently.



Always use the toilet and do not practice open defecation. Practice safe disposal of child's faeces.

Treatment of Diarrhoea



Dissolve and mix one packet of ORS in 1 litre of potable water.



Immediately give ORS to the child as soon as Diarrhoea begins and after each episode of Diarrhoea.



Mix zinc tablet in one tablespoon of water or mother's milk and give it to the child once a day for 14 days.



Continue feeding, including breastfeeding during and after the episode of Diarrhoea.

Contact the nearest health facility or ASHA, if needed.

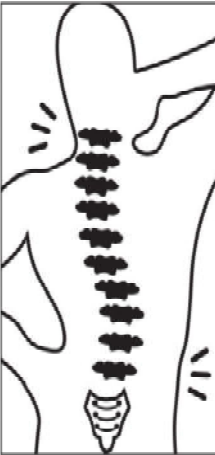
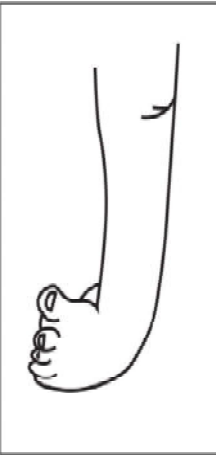

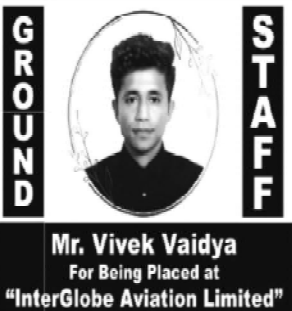
