Interview of Secretary (Health) broadcast through Akashvani Port Blair

Health is a vital aspect of our life and the Health Department is committed to provide the best health care facilities to the Islanders: Secretary (Health)

Port Blair, June 6

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS has directed all Secretaries of the Departments concerned to give interviews in Akashvani Port Blair and Doordarshan (DD) and highlight the initiatives taken by the Departments involved in public delivery services to improve public delivery system, social infrastructure and social benefit schemes. As per the roster, the interview of Secretary (Health), Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS was broadcast yesterday through Akashvani Port Blair and the same is being reproduced in Q&A format for the wider reach of the people of A&N Islands.

Interviewer: How many referral Hospitals, District Hospitals, CHCs, PHCs etc. are there in A&N Islands under Directorate of Health Services?

Secretary (Health): G.B.Pant is the lone Referral Hospital in A&N Islands. Apart from this, the Health Department is having three District Hospitals in each District i.e. G.B. Pant Hospital in South Andaman District, Dr. Rajendra Prasad Hospital at Mayabunder in N&M Andaman District and Bishop John Richardson Hospital in Nicobar District. To support these three District Hospitals, the Department is having 4 Community Health Centres, 22 PHCs and 124 Sub Centres. Health and Wellness Centre (HWC) is very important step of the Ministry of Health under which all the Sub Centres, few PHCs have been developed as HWCs. The basic health facilities which should be available in a Health Institution has been made available in these HWCs. All the HWCs are manned by a Community Health Officer or ANM and they are supported by ASHA workers besides other supporting staff. The recruitment process is underway in Health Department and the staff strength will further improve.

Interviewer: What is being done to fill up the vacancies in Health Department?

Secretary (Health): There are different types of Posts in Health Department viz. Group A, B & C posts. Doctors and Specialists come under Group A post, Supporting Staff and Nursing Officers and others come under Group B posts and in Group C, lower supporting staff viz. ANMs and others. Applications have been invited from eligible candidates by advertising the vacant posts in public domain. The Department hopes that in the next two to three months, all the vacant posts will be filled and the required manpower will be available in all the Islands.

Interviewer: How many Dialysis Units are there in entire Islands?

Secretary (Health): There are 7 Dialysis Units in A&N Islands, one each at G. B. Pant Hospital, Dr. Rajendra Prasad Hospital at Mayabunder and Bishop John Richardson Hospital at Nicobar District. Dialysis Unit is also available in all the three CHCs i.e. Bambooflat, Rangat and Diglipur. Recently, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration inaugurated a Dialysis Unit at PHC Swaraj Dweep and it has the distinction of being the first PHC in the country to have a Dialysis Unit. It's a matter of great pride for A&N Islands that in a small Health Unit like PHC, the facility of dialysis is available for the benefit of the residents of that area.

Interviewer: What about the availability of Blood Bank and other such facilities in A&N Islands?

Secretary (Health): The facility of Blood Bank is available in three places in Port Blair as of now i.e. GB Pant Hospital, INHS Dhnavantri and in private hospital Pillar Health Centre is having this facility. The Department has devised a plan to set up a Blood Bank at Mayabunder and it will be established very soon. The Department urges the blood donors who have different blood groups to come forward in good numbers to donate blood, so that it can be made available to needy people through Blood Bank to save life.

Interviewer: How many Ambulance and Advance Life Support Ambulances are available with the Department?

Secretary (Health): The Health Department at present has 69 Ambulances spread over different areas in A&N Islands. As of now, there is no Advance Life Support Ambulances with the Department. However, the Department will soon purchase

389 foreign satellites launched by India in last nine years: MoS for Atomic Energy & Space

New Delhi, June 6

Minister of State for Atomic Energy and Space, Dr. Jitendra Singh has said that in the last nine years, 389 foreign satellites have been launched by India. In an interview with DD News, Dr. Singh said, India's Space sector is fast gaining a pre-eminent position in the world. He said, the countries which started their Space programmes long before India, today they are seeking India's services and facilities to launch their satellites.

Dr. Singh said, out of 424 foreign satellites launched to date by India, 389 were launched by the Government. He said, apart from the core functioning of Rocket launching, India's Space Applications have become a big source of livelihood opportunities through 130-odd Start-ups after the opening up of the Space Sector in June 2020. Food Safety Department celebrates International Year of Millets Millet Mela organized at Perka village

Car Nicobar, June 6

The International Year of Millets was celebrated by the Food Safety Department at Car Nicobar in coordination with Nicobar District Administration and ICDS. To create awareness on the importance of Millets and to promote its consumption, a Millet Mela was organized at Community Hall, Perka village, Car Nicobar on 4th June, 2023.

Shri Hari Kallikkat, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Nicobar District inaugurated the mela in the presence of Shri Paul, Village Headman, officials of ICDS, Food Business Operators, villagers, and officials of Food Safety Department.

Speaking on the occasion, the Deputy Commissioner, Nicobar District appealed to the gathering to adopt millets in their daily diets and get the required nutrients as well as other health benefits. He requested all the participants to include millets in their



daily diet atleast one time in a day. The chief guest further reiterated the significance of millets in promoting sustainable food system and in ensuring food and nutritional security for all. He requested the food business operators to bring all millet based products to the district for sale.

Smti Sunita Kumari, Child Development Project Officer, ICDS (TP) Nicobar District spoke on the occasion about the initiative. She said, such initiatives shall inspire more people to embrace the use of millets in their diets and contribute to a healthier and more sustainable future.

Earlier, Shri A. Khalid, Food Safety Officer

briefed the gathering about the importance of millets in daily life. Various Millets grains as well as millet based food products were also displayed through the departmental stall. an Advance Life Support Ambulance.

Interviewer: What about Mortuary facility?

Secretary (Health): The Department is having Mortuary facility in almost all the PHCs where dead bodies are stored and if required, Post Mortems are also done. During my tour to different Islands, it was observed that the Mortuary facility is not up to the mark. The Department will take up the renovation/improvement of Mortuary, this year, wherever, it is required. Mortuary vans are not provided by the Health Department. Normally, it is provided by the local Bodies like PBMC.

Interviewer: Kindly elaborate on Intensive Care Units and Radiological Units across the Islands?

Secretary (Health): The Health Department is having four ICUs in G.B. Pant Hospital viz. Medical ICU (11 beds), Surgical ICU (10 beds), Paediatric ICU (2 beds) for Children and for new born Neo-Natal ICU (20 beds). In Radiology Department, the Health Department is having MRI facility, good CT Scan Machine. This year, a new CT Scan Machine will be procured within two to three months' time, the approval for the same has already been given. Apart from this, the Department has Ultrasound Machines, Digital X-Ray, Portable X-Ray and Mammography Machine. Similarly, a basic facility of Radiology is available in all the PHCs and CHCs viz. X-Ray and Ultrasound. At present, there is no facility of CT Scan in Inter-Islands. CT Scan Machine is a highly technical & complex machine and it has its own eco-system which requires the services of a Radiologist. The Administration is on the course of discussion about the necessity/requirements available at this stage for starting this facility in inter-island as Radiologist is a special position and getting a Radiologist in A&N Islands is not an easy task. However, if need arises, the facility of CT Scan will be made available in Inter-Island too.

Interviewer: Can you elaborate on the availability of Laboratory facilities and availability of staff?

Secretary (Health): The facility of Laboratory is available in all the PHCs, CHCs and Health Sub Centres. Complete Blood Count (CBC) Machine, all the Biochemistry Investigations, Hematology, X-Ray, Ultra Sound is available in all places like Diglipur, Mayabunder, Rangat, Nancowry, Car Nicobar and Campbell Bay besides Port Blair.

Interviewer: Can you elaborate on different specializations available here?

Secretary (Health): There are 21 Medical Departments in GB Pant Hospital and these Departments have Professors and Associate Professors rendering their services to the patients. Some Posts of Specialists could not be filled and the Health Department advertises the Posts of Specialists from time to time. Some Specialists join the Department but due to some issues the Department has not been able to fill the posts. However, efforts are still continuing to fill all the posts of Specialists in A&N Islands to provide better health care to general public.

Interviewer: How many Operation Theatres are there across the Islands?

Secretary (Health): There are eight Operation Theatres in GB Pant Hospital, out of which, three are Modular OTs and three OTs are being upgraded. Apart from this, OTs are there in RP Hospital Mayabunder, CHC Diglipur, CHC Rangat and BJR Hospital in Car Nicobar where the services of Surgical Specialist and Anesthetist are available.

Interviewer: What about Paramedic Staff & Nursing Staff in outer Islands ?

Secretary (Health): Paramedic Staff are available in all the outer Islands, though it may not be adequate. However, the recruitment process is being done and very soon, the vacant posts will be filled and there will be no shortage of staff in outer Islands.

Interviewer: All procurements are being done through GeM Portal and is there any difficulty in procuring items in outer Islands?

Secretary (Health): Directions have been received to purchase all the items through GeM portal only and the Department mostly purchases all the items through GeM. It is true that sometimes issues crop up in PHCs to purchase food items as local vendors registered in GeM are not available. To mitigate this issue, the Department ties up with the CHCs where local vendors are available and the issues of PHCs are sorted out. The Department, this year, will make best effort to ensure the engagement of one or two local vendors with the PHCs through GeM, so that such issues do not arise in future.

Interviewer: Considering the fact that many inhabited Islands are far off from Port Blair, how medical evacuations are carried out during emergencies?

Secretary (Health): The Administration has facilities of Helicopters by which medical evacuation is carried out. Besides, help from Navy is also being sought due to the fact that Administration's helicopters cannot fly in the night. Apart from this, demand for purchase of an Air Ambulance is also being received by the people of these Islands. The matter regarding Air Ambulance has also been taken up and the Department hopes that the issue will be resolved very soon.

Interviewer: AASHA workers had done commendable job during pandemic. Is there any proposal to increase their wages?

Secretary (Health): At present, ASHA workers are paid an amount of Rs. 2000 per month besides different types of incentives are also given. The A&N Administration has given an additional grant of Rs. 500 for each ASHA workers in addition to the monthly amount of Rs.2000. This is an additional facility given only in Andaman & Nicobar Islands and not in any part of the country. The demand for providing additional amount to the ASHA workers have been received and the Administration is looking into the matter, which will be resolved very soon. COVID has challenged us not only emotionally, but physically too. Our Health Workers also known as Covid Warriors have done a commendable job and they provided health care to the affected people putting their own life in danger.

Interviewer: How much is the budget allocated during this financial year for improving health care facilities?

Secretary (Health): The Health Department got a budget of Rs. 370 crores this year, out of which, the revenue component is Rs. 337 crores and rest is for procurement of machineries, ambulances and construction of buildings etc.

Interviewer: How many different types of disease eradication Programmes are being implemented by DHS?

Secretary (Health): For the eradication of major diseases prevalent in these Islands, the DHS organizes different programmes. Coordinated effort is being made to eradicate Malaria. It is a matter of pride that, a Certificate of Appreciation has been awarded to A&N Islands by GoI for bringing down the incidence of TB and for implementing the TB Eradication programme successfully. Apart from this, prevention of leprosy, blindness, hearing problems, non-communicable diseases, cancer and improving oral health is being dealt through 'National Health Mission' (NHM). All the Centrally Sponsored Schemes also comes through NHM.

Interviewer: Kindly elaborate on AYUSH and the facilities available under this system of medicine?

Secretary (Health): The policy of GoI is to integrate AYUSH system with Allopathic System of Health care, so that the facility of AYUSH is also available in the same Health Centre. Accordingly, the A&N Administration has taken steps in the same direction. AYUSH dispensaries are co-located wherever the PHCs, CHCs and District Hospitals are functioning. Homeopathy Dispensaries are functioning in two District Hospitals, 4 CHCs and 10 PHCs. Yoga Units are functioning in two District Hospitals, three CHCs and two PHCs. Six exclusive AYUSH Health and Wellness Centres are available to provide AYUSH facilities in a focussed way, which include yoga facilities, homeopathy facilities and AYUSH system of treatment. This year, plan has been prepared to increase the AYUSH system of treatment for Panchakarma, arthritis related disorders. For this, four new Centres will be opened at Port Blair, Swaraj Dweep and Bambooflat, so that AYUSH facilities are further increased. Acknowledging the great demand, AYUSH facilities and infrastructure for AYUSH will also be upgraded in Rangat.

Interviewer: What is being done to provide adequate health care to PVTGs?

Secretary (Health): The A&N Administration is always alert when it comes to Health Care of the PVTGs. Exclusive Tribal Wards are available in PHCs viz. Baratang, Kadamtala, Tushnabad. Their immunization schedule is also followed strictly and it is ensured that kids are immunized as per schedule. For this, I appreciate the effort of the ANMs and ASHA workers as they ensure the immunization of the children working at field level. Apart from this, 100 percent ANC check-up is also ensured. Critical cases are immediately sent to G.B. Pant Hospital or referred to mainland. Many Health Camps have also been organized in Tribal areas. It had come to light that there is iron deficiency among Onge tribes and was resolved by conducting a camp.

Interviewer: Is there any plan to provide in-service training to available Doctors to enhance their skills with the changing scenario in healthcare sector?

Secretary (Health): Doctor's in-service training is of paramount important as technology techniques and knowledge is changing every time in health sector as the day passes. Health Department gives utmost importance on the aspect of in-service training to doctors and others. The training for GDMOs are conducted from time to time at Port Blair besides online training provided by GoI. The training related to developments in different programmes like TB, Malaria, Hospital Management, Emergency Medical Care conducted by GoI are also attended by the doctors from the Islands at mainland, to enhance their level of knowledge. The Health Department encourages the doctors to take up higher studies, so that they can provide better health services to the Islanders.

Interviewer: What would you like to say about ANIIMS?

Secretary (Health): ANIIMS is the lone Medical College of A&N Islands. Every year, 114 students take admission in ANIIMS, which is functioning since 2015 in A&N Islands. Faculties are available in 21 Departments of ANIIMS. Pertaining to physical infrastructure of ANIIMS, work is in progress. The Chief Secretary soon after assuming charge has given more importance on the functioning of ANIIMS and works for infrastructure development are progressing on a faster pace. The GB Pant hospital is currently associated with ANIIMS at present and the passed-out students of ANIIMS comes to GB Pant Hospital for training. We hope that in the coming years, the quality of education and infrastructure will further improve in ANIIMS and it will provide better health care to the Islanders.

Interviewer: Can you elaborate on the projects which are in the pipeline?

Secretary (Health): Our future plan is to increase the capacity of hospitals in outlying areas. 50 percent construction work of the New Wards at RP Hospital in Mayabunder has been completed and within two years time, the project will be completed. Diglipur CHC will be upgraded into a Sub-Divisional Hospital in two to three months' time. The phase-I construction work of the Garacharma District Hospital has been completed. All the facilities available in District Hospital will be made available in this Hospital. Once the second phase is completed, it will have bed capacity for 155 patients with all kinds of facilities viz. basic laboratories, all kinds of test facility, all radiology equipments, services of doctors and specialists, operation theatres etc.

Interviewer: What would you like to share with the people of the Islands?

Secretary (Health): I would like to tell the Islanders that Health is a vital aspect of our life. The way, the Health Department has carried out development works in the Health Sector in recent years is commendable. Earlier, there were complaints regarding shortages of equipment, ambulance, staff, doctors etc. from outer Islands. In last few years, a lot of work has been done including major purchases in the Health Sector which has minimized the grievances of the general public to a great extent. However, our efforts will always be to provide quality health care to the Islanders. We seek the cooperation from the general public and public representatives to collaborate with doctors and lower staff to enable them to provide better health care to the Islanders. I hope that all the health indicators in this UT are among the best in the Country.

In a significant breakthrough, the Aberdeen Police has successfully apprehended two individuals involved in theft and recovered the stolen vehicles. On May 31, 2023, a written complaint was received regarding the theft of a motorcycle with registration number AN01E-1094 (Yamaha Gladiator). The motorcycle was parked near the complainant's house in Prem Nagar on May 29, 2023 and was subsequently stolen. An FIR was registered under Section 379 IPC on May 31, 2023. The investigation was entrusted to SI P.K Jabbar of Aberdeen Police Station.			The Under Graduate Degree Certificates for the Batch 2017-18 of Mahatma Gandhi Govt. College, Mayabunder have been received from Pondicherry University. The students of the said Batch have been advised to collect their Degree Certificates from the Admission & Examination Wing of M G Govt. College, Mayabunder on all working days, a press release from MGGC said.
Following the registration of the FIR, a team was formed and their task was to conduct a thorough search for the accused individuals and the stolen property. The team acted swiftly and successfully apprehended two accused individuals who were residents of Machi Line and Shadipur in Port Blair. They also recovered the stolen vehicle, bearing the registration number AN01E-1094 (Yamaha Gladiator) from Wimberlygunj area.			The investigation of these additional cases is currently underway. On May 24, 2023, a burglary was reported at Marine Hill, leading to the theft of valuable items, including gold ornaments weighing over 435 grams, silver ornaments weighing over 263 grams, and the entire sum of Rs. 70,000 in cash. Additionally, Rs. 17,000 believed to be proceeds from the stolen property were also recovered. The investigation is currently ongoing to gather further evidence.
