The National Immunization Day (NID) for administering Polio drops to children in the age group of 0-5 years will be held tomorrow (Mar. 3) in A&N Islands. The Health Department has made all arrangements to ensure that every children in the age group of 0-5 years is administered two drops of bivalent Oral Polio Vaccine (OPV) at Booths followed by house to house visits by the staffs in the next two days to search and vaccinate the missed out / unimmunised children. The goal is to ensure that no child will ever again suffer from polio.

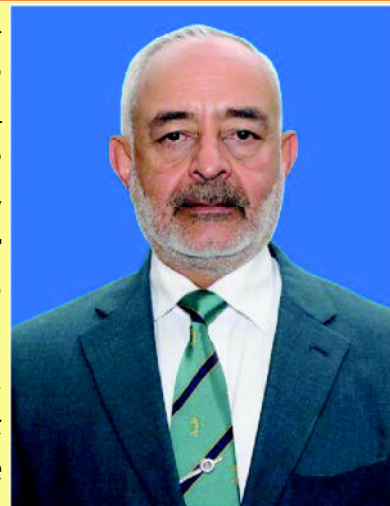

Marine pollution response seminar and mock drill conducted by Indian Coast Guard

Port Blair, Mar. 2

Indian Coast Guard component at ANC, conducted an IMO Level-I course for various stakeholders responsible for Pollution Response Operation in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The course was conducted by Coast Guard Pollution Response Team (A & N) from Feb. 26 to Mar. 1, 2024 at Port Blair. The Indian Coast Guard (ICG), being the central coordinating agency for combating oil pollution in the maritime zones of India, conducts the course in line with the guidelines of OPRC convention 1992 to which India is a signatory. Accordingly, the IMO level courses are structured and conducted by the Indian Coast Guard to provide effective training to all stakeholders for coordinated response operations against any marine oil spills. The training was



inaugurated by DIG PB Mandal, TM, COMDIS-14. The participants consisted of 5 Officers and 20 Subordinate Officers/Personnel from Indian Coast Guard along with 4 Personnel from various stakeholders such as Port Management Board (PMB), Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL), and Fisheries Department. During the IMO Level-I Course, the participants actively engaged in immersive practical training sessions, complemented by a comprehensive mock drill conducted at

sea off NSCB Island on 29th Feb., 24, wherein ICG ships demonstrated pollution response mechanism and CG Dornier and Chetak Helicopter Ex-CGAE(PBR) displayed aerial Oil Spill Dispersant (OSD) application. The course curriculum provided the participants an insight into the various aspects of pollution response. On completion of the course, all participants were awarded with IMO level-I training Certification, a press release from ICG said.

the crippling effects of polio in the entire world.

This year, it is estimated that around 21778 children will receive vaccine during the round in 534 booths across these Islands. A booth in the airport, Seaport and other transit points has also been set up. All tourists and people living in forest areas will also be covered under this program. The target is to cover 100% of eligible children. General public have been requested to bring their children to the booth for polio drops on 3rd March, 2024.

Polio is a highly infectious disease caused by a virus. It invades the nervous system and can cause total paralysis in a matter of hours. It can strike at any stage but affects mainly children under three. Polio is mainly passed through person-to-person (i.e., Feco-Oral) contact, and infects persons who do not have immunity against the disease. There is no cure for polio, but the disease can be prevented by immunisation with polio vaccine. Oral Polio Vaccine (OPV) was developed in 1961 by Dr. Albert Sabin. OPV is a highly effective, safe and inexpensive vaccine and has been used in all countries of the world to achieve polio eradication, a press release from DHS said.





1. (1) To answer the claim and as the day fixed for your appearance in appointed for the final disposal of the suit, you must be prepared to produce on that day all the witness upon whose evidence and all the documents upon which you intend to reply, in support of your defence.

(2) To state whether you contest or do not contest, the claim either in whole or in part and if you contest to receive directions of the Court as the date on which your written statement is to be filed the witness or witnesses upon whose evidence you intend to rely in support of your defence are to be produced, the documents upon which you intend to rely are to be filed also the date of trial and other matters take notice that in the event of your admitting the claim either in whole or in part the Court will erthwith pass judgement in accordance with such admission, or in the event of the claim not being contested the suit shall be decided at once.

(3) To answer the claim and you are directed to produce on that day all the documents upon which you intend to rely in support of your defence.




