Prime Minister calls for out of the box thinking and long term planning to boost tourism in the country

New Delhi, March 3

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today stressed on the need to think out of the box and do long-term planning to give a new height to the tourism sector in the country.

Shri Modi stated this while addressing a post-budget webinar on boosting India's tourism potential. He highlighted the huge scope of tourism in India and listed out coastal, beach, mangrove, Himalayan, adventure, wildlife, eco, heritage,



spiritual, wedding destinations and sports tourism in this direction. He also gave the

example of Ramayan Circuit, Buddha Circuit, Krishna Circuit, Northeast Circuit,

Gandhi Circuit, and pilgrimages of all saints and stressed the need to work together collectively on this.

The Prime Minister informed that several places in India have been identified through the route of competitive spirit and challenge in this year's Union Budget.

Highlighting that tourism has always been part of India's social and cultural civilization, Shri Modi said, if the country

200 crore Aadhaar authentication transactions carried out in January 2023: Ministry

New Delhi, March 3

Ministry of Electronics and IT has said that 200 crore Aadhaar authentication transactions were carried out in January this year. So far, holders have carried out over nine thousand crore authentication transactions, out of which, nearly 200 crores took place in January indicating the growth of digital economy in the country. The Ministry said a majority of the authentications transaction numbers were carried out by using biometric

fingerprint.

The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has already rolled out a new security mechanism for Aadhaar-based fingerprint authentication. It said,

by the end of January, Aadhaar saturation among all age groups has climbed up to 94.65 percent and the saturation level among the adult population is now near universal. (Source: india.gov.in)

Curtailment in water supply due to deficit monsoon; water to be supplied once in 3 days from March 9

Port Blair, March 3

The general public have been informed that due to deficit monsoon during 2022-23, the storage of water at all sources in South Andaman including Dhanikhari Dam has depleted substantially. Keeping in view the situation and the fact that storage of water available needs to be regulated till the arrival of the next South West Monsoon in May/June, 2023, it has become inevitable to impose curtailment in the quantity of

water to the extent of 30%. Consequently, the water supply to all areas falling under the jurisdiction of PHED, APWD and in the jurisdiction of PBMC shall be now made once in 3 days with effect from 09.03.2023 instead of the present schedule on alternate days.

All consumers have been requested to cooperate with the Department in this regard. People have also been requested to save water as much as possible and adopt conservation

Talking about the increasing number of foreign tourists in India, the Prime Minister underlined the need to profile such tourists and create a special strategy to attract them to the country. He insisted on developing 50 such tourist destinations that every tourist from around the globe is bound to visit on his trip to India.	
He also mentioned developing apps for tourist destinations in all languages listed in the United Nations. Shri Modi said all languages should be incorporated while designing the content for tourism and asked to further modernize tourists apps and digital connectivity. He said it should be available in all UN languages and Indian languages.	
Shri Modi also highlighted the basic challenge of the tourism sector and pointed out the lack of professional tourist guides.	
The Prime Minister stressed on promoting school and college trips to the northeast so that more people become aware and start developing infrastructure and facilities for tourists. (Source: india.gov.in)

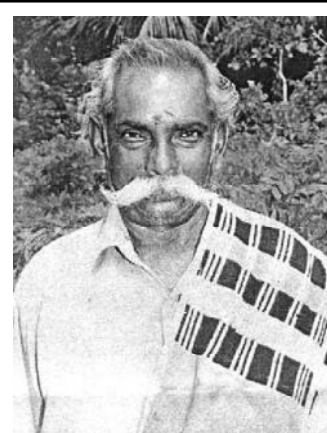
