Installation of grid connected rooftop solar power plants USRP portal, 'usrp.andaman.gov.in' developed by Electricity Department for submission of applications

Under the National Solar Mission, the Government of India has set a target of installing of 40 GW Grid connected solar rooftop systems (GCRTS) in the country. MNRE, Government of India, in collaboration with the Electricity Department, A&N Administration has introduced 40% subsidy for the installation of grid connected rooftop solar power plants for residential consumers in the A&N Islands. The achievement till date in the A&N Islands is 4.15 MW in the government buildings, 30 KW in the residential buildings and 55 KW in the commercial buildings under South Andaman, which have already been installed and

synchronized with the Electricity Department Grid.

Presently, Electricity Department is in the process of empanelling the vendors for design, supply, erection, testing, installation and commissioning, including warranty, comprehensive operation & maintenance for 5 years of grid connected rooftop PV Plant with hybrid inverter, Net Meter and battery storage system. For easy application process, a state USRP portal, 'usrp.andaman.gov.in' has been developed by Electricity Department for submission of applications. In addition to this Ministry of New & Renewable Energy has also designed and launched a National Portal,

www.solarrooftop.gov.in which facilitates the consumers with simplified procedure for installation of rooftop solar power plants through any vendor empanelled in the national portal. The portal enables online tracking of the entire process starting from registering the applications to release of subsidy in residential consumers (beneficiaries) bank account.

Disaster Management issues advisory on Forest Fire Safety measures



Port Blair, March 4

The A&N Islands are covered with 81% of tropical rain forests of its total geographical area and it is a rich heritage of Biodiversity having various eco-systems like marine, terrestrial, coastal, mangroves etc.

Extended summer season may cause forest fire as dry leaves are susceptible and works as good fuel. In past, few forest fires have caused damage to forest, wildlife and environment etc. In view of this, Dr. Nitin Shakya, Director (Disaster Management), A&N Administration has requested the residents of rural areas surrounding forest to follow the advisory on Do's and Don'ts of Forest Fire and to safeguard the eco-system of this Territory.

Know your forest fire risk. Be aware of weather updates, emergency instructions of evacuation orders. Teach all household members the technique of stop, drop and roll methods in case catches fire. Create a safety zone by removing vegetation/articles that easily catch fire. Consult with local fire & forest department about making home fire-resistant.

Keep evacuation checklist and emergency Kit (including a flashlight, mobile phone, batteries, cash, water bottle, dry fruits/snacks, first aid supplies etc.) ready before the fire season sets in. Breathe closest to the ground preferably through moist cloth to avoid inhaling smoke.

Immediately contact and report an unattended forest fire to local fire & Forest Department/Authority. During any fire activity, keep a shovel, water and fire extinguisher nearby to keep fires in check in dry seasons.

Never leave a fire unattended without completely extinguishing, checking and re-checking the ashes near vegetation. Do not leave/throw cigarettes, matches, and other smoking materials from moving vehicles near forest area without completely extinguishing it. Do not leave behind flammables during outdoor camping in forests areas. Avoid any open burning in windy conditions in forest area.
