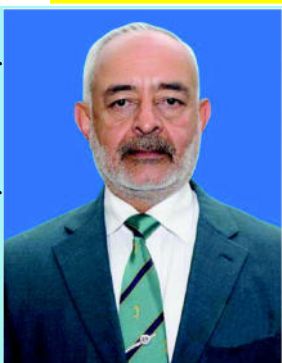

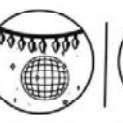

**Know Your Rights with HIV/AIDS**

**ACT 2017**

**KHUL KE JIYA KYA**

**The Human Immunodeficiency Virus and Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (Prevention and Control) Act, 2017 is a progressive act that:**

- provides for safeguarding humanitarian and constitutional rights of individuals diagnosed with HIV/AIDS.
- has come into force from 10<sup>th</sup> September 2018. I.D.No.9772

**Key Provisions of the Act:**

**Disclosure of HIV status:**

The Act ensures that the identity of person living with HIV shall be kept confidential. And no person shall be compelled:

- To disclose their HIV status
- Or give out any other details related to it

(\*except if required by a court order)

**Grievance Redressal:**

The act ensures that atleast one ombudsman will be appointed by every state government to inquire into complaints related to the violation of the Act and the provision of health care services. Similarly,

- Every establishment having 100 or more employees will appoint a Complaint Officer.
- Every healthcare establishment with 20 or more employees will also appoint a Complaint Officer.

**Key Provisions of the Act:**

**Test and Treat with consent-**

The Act ensures that no HIV test, medical treatment, or research will be conducted on a person without their informed consent. It should also be taken into consideration that:

- There should be provision for pre and post HIV test counselling
- No treatment or medical interference can be done without consent

**Zero Discrimination-**

The Act prohibits any discrimination or feeling of hatred against PLHIV. It also prohibits:

- Discrimination in public places like hospitals, offices, schools and colleges
- Discrimination while residing or renting property, promotion or employment

The act also prohibits any kind of violence and physical assault or activities to encourage violence towards people living with HIV.

**Key Provisions of the Act:**

**Precaution at places which have a risk of exposure to HIV-**

Medical institutions are at a higher risk for exposure of HIV as it is a blood borne infection. For this reason, the act ensures to create a secure and safe workplace to prohibit the spread of HIV infection, by ensuring timely:

- Provision of post-exposure prophylaxis
- Training for caution
- Complete information to protect yourself from HIV
