The Central Government has announced that 10 percent reservation will be given to Ex-Agniveers in the BSF recruitment. In a notification issued by the Home Ministry yesterday, the Government has amended the recruitment rules of the

Border Security Force.

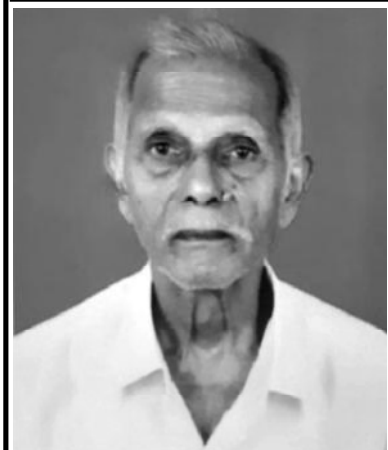
