





Commissioner-cum-Secretary (APWD) briefs media on water...

The Commissioner said, shortage in rainfall during the North West Monsoon has resulted in poor inflow to various reservoirs as compared to previous years which had better North West Rains which are a major source of water for the Islands and helps in tiding over the dry summer months, which was very less. Usually Dhanikhari Dam, the major source of water for Port Blair area, gets filled up (66 mtr height) and overflows in the Month of July each year but last year there was not a single instance of dam overflow and the peak levels were attained very late in October-November, he added.

He mentioned that previously, in the good monsoon years, the Dam level is maintained between 65-66 mtr till February. However, during current year, the level of water in the dam decreased below 64 mtr in January itself. Similarly, in other 7 small reservoirs viz. Jawahar Sarovar, Nayagaon Diggi, Chakkargaon Diggi, Dilthaman Diggi, Dollygunj Diggi and Gandhi Park, also the water level has been less than the average water level by 1.5-2.0 Mts in the last 5 years.

Besides the poor monsoons and particularly North-west monsoons last year, this year, the Commissioner said, the Islands are experiencing unexpectedly prolonged summer. Normally the rains set in the Islands towards the mid-end of April and during 2022, pre-monsoon rain started in the month of April itself, but this year, the Islands are yet to receive any rains. The earliest prediction of IMD indicates arrival of monsoon by 15<sup>th</sup> of May, 2023. Due to this twin impact of reduced monsoon rains and late arrival of monsoons, most of the smaller sources like streams, check weirs and ponds have dried out and there is considerable reduction in the water levels in the sources of PBMC area. He said, at present, the water supply in PBMC area and adjoining areas is now totally dependent upon Dhanikhari Dam and Rutland Water Supply Project.

Speaking about the Rutland Water Supply Project, the Commissioner said, this project was completed during Feb. 2022 and is supplying about 6.6 MLD of water, which is being pumped into Dhanikhari Dam daily. This has been a major boost to the water supply to PBMC area and will continue to provide uninterrupted water for the residents of Port Blair. He said, the total water demand in PBMC area is about 32 MLD, which was catered through regular supply on alternative day till 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 with the help of Rutland feeder and other available reserves from various secondary sources such as Jawahar Sarovar, Nayagaon Diggi, Chakkargaon Diggi, Dilthaman Diggi and Gandhi Park. However, to avoid any hardship to public in case of any delay in arrival of monsoon, it was decided to impose 30% curtailment w.e.f 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2023, he said adding that since then, the same level of curtailed supply is being maintained.

The Commissioner informed that the Administration, along with PBMC has been taking persistent and insistent steps over the last 3-4 years, to ensure that the water supply to PBMC areas is augmented and all available water sources are tapped to their optimum potential.

Briefing about some of the water supply augmentation works undertaken during the last 3-4 year to improve water supply in Port Blair and adjoining area, he said, the Rutland Project, submarine pipeline to Pongibalu, was completed and this has increased the water availability by about 6.6MLD. Similarly, 18 Rainwater harvesting tanks @ 1.25 Lakhs Ltrs capacity in non-residential building at Port Blair (2.25 ML) were constructed in 2022. He further said that 6 overhead tanks @ 4.50 Lakhs Ltrs capacity (2.7ML) were constructed in 2021 and Lalmitti check weir height was raised by 1 mtr at Beodnabad (4ML) in 2021 besides cleaning and rejuvenation of all water bodies & check weirs.

This year also, the Administration, APWD and PBMC officials have been very pro-active and alive to the emerging situation and has taken a number of steps to ensure that water availability to the citizens of Port Blair is ensured, he said. Almost all the available and potential sources of raw water in the PBMC area has been inspected and where ever feasible works are underway to ensure all available sources are harnessed. Some of the inspected sites are Flatbay, Bachhra Pahar, Humpherygunj -Chouldari Pipe Line, Sippighat Sweet Water Lake, Karpuyaswamy Nallah, Teylerabad Diggi (Reconnection), Lalmitti, Joda Nallah, Chakkargaon (Desilting) and Jawahar Sarovar (Desilting), he said.

The Commissioner further stated that, to prevent any eventuality in case of unexpected delay in monsoon, the A&N Administration has already taken several steps which include transportation of water from Hutbay by ship(0.30 MLD); transportation of water from Rutland eastern side source by water barge (0.60) MLD; supply from Teylarabad Dam by pumping (2.0MLD); Supply from Joda Nallah through tankers (0.20MLD); rehabilitation of Bore well in Brookshabad and Beodnabad by installation of submersible pump (0.20 MLD); de-silting of Jawahar Sarovar Chakkargaon Diggi, Lalmitti check weir; water supply by connecting borewell from Brichgunj to APWD Treatment Plant; daily inspection of Wards to check leakages of pipes, valves, overflow of storage tanks, installation of booster pumps by individuals by a combined teams of Revenue and Water Sections (8 Nos) of PBMC; surveillance has been intensified and public have been requested to mandatorily install float valves ; standby water supply is being provided through tankers in PBMC area etc.

The Commissioner also informed about various other initiatives taken to ensure long term availability of water. The projects sanctioned/in progress include Bachhraphar Water Supply Scheme in Chouldari-2.2 MLD consultancy tender under process; Karupysamy Water Supply Scheme in Telyrabad (2.2 MLD) tender is due on 1<sup>st</sup> week of May, 2023; Humpherygunj-Chouldari Pipeline-7 km and additional pipeline from Lamba Line to Dairy Farm Junction (3 km). The proposed work (Estimate under process) are augmentation of Rutland Water Supply Scheme by adding 5 more source (6.00 MLD); development of Joda Nallah Scheme including laying of pipeline from Joda Nallah to Brichgunj (2.7 km); laying of pipeline from Brookshabad pond to Corbyn's Cove Treatment Plant (1.7 km); development of abandoned quarry at Brookshabad, Brichgunj and Teylarabad as Water Reservoir.

The Commissioner said, Administration has also taken steps to strengthen the distribution network and integration of water supply infrastructure within the city. As part of this, PBMC has taken up revival of more than 200 wells in Municipal area. He appealed to the citizens to use these water sources to meet secondary demand of water like washing, cleaning, gardening and other non-potable purposes.

Concluding his briefing, the Commissioner appealed to the general public to extend cooperation to the Administration in current scenario and use drinking water judiciously. He said, "Together we can prevail over this situation and the Administration assures that it will take every possible step in its reach and means to ensure that water supply is maintained".

UIDAI allows residents to verify email/mobile number seeded with Aadhaar

New Delhi, May 2 (PIB)

Keeping user benefits in mind, Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has allowed the residents to verify their mobile numbers and email IDs seeded with their Aadhaar. It had come to the notice of the UIDAI that in some instances, residents were not aware/sure about that which of their mobile numbers is seeded to their Aadhaar. Hence residents were worried that Aadhaar OTP might be going to some other mobile number. Now, with this facility, the residents can check these quite easily.

The facility can be availed under 'Verify email/mobile Number' feature on the official website ( <https://myaadhaar.uidai.gov.in/> ) or through mAadhaar App. It has been developed for the residents to verify that their own email/mobile number is seeded with respective Aadhaar.

This feature gives confirmation to resident that email/mobile number under his/her knowledge is only seeded to respective Aadhaar. It also notifies the resident in case a particular mobile number is not linked, and informs resident to take necessary steps to update the mobile number, if they wish so.

In case mobile number is already verified residents will see a message like, 'the mobile number you have entered is already verified with our records', displayed on their screen.

In case a resident does not remember the mobile number, she/he has given during enrolment she/he can check the last three digits of the mobile on Verify Aadhaar feature on Myaadhaar portal or mAadhaar App. If a resident wants to link email/mobile number with Aadhaar or want to update her/his email/mobile number, she/he may visit a nearest Aadhaar centre.
