## Nicobar District initiates Awareness Campaigns to empower women by saturating SHG formation in each village

### 6 new SHGs formed during the first week of campaign

Car Nicobar, May 3

The District Administration, Nicobar is conducting a 5 week long village level SHG awareness camps with a vision to financially and socially empower women by organizing them in SHGs and enhancing their income by engaging them in various commercial activities. This will in turn provide better quality of life to households.

The SHG awareness campaign which started from April 24

Vice President praised NCERT and Indian Council of Historical Research (ICHR) for highlighting the contribution of unsung heroes of the North East, in our history and freedom struggle.

Commending the Government's focus on improving physical, social and digital infrastructure in the region, Shri Dhankhar said that the North-East is emerging as the land of opportunities. Mentioning various projects e.g. Bogibeel rain-cum road bridge, 375 road projects, rise of airport network from 9 to 17 and setting up of 190 new educational institutions in North Eastern region, he highlighted that new avenues and vistas are now available to youth to unleash their energy. Describing India's growth story as 'unstoppable', the Vice President expressed confidence that by the end of decade, we'll be the world's third largest economy. N&M Andaman District Police takes action against  
sale of illegal Ganja & liquor

Mayabunder, May 3

Continuing its crackdown on the illicit ganja, illicit liquor, handia, & illegal sale of IMFL, the District Police of North & Middle Andaman with the help of local informers conducts regular raids and searches in jungles. During the month of March-2023, the teams of various Police Stations, headed by SHOs and Sub-Inspectors conducted raids & massive jungle search operation. In these search operations, around 900 litres of Lehan & 33 litres of illicit liquor was destroyed and also 126 Nos. IMFL bottles of different quantities have been seized. Under Excise Regulation 18 cases were registered 18 accused



were arrested. All the History Sheeters are regularly being checked by the beat staff, making it hard for them to be involved in any illegal activity and fresh history sheet of bootleggers are under surveillance.

District Police has been able to arrest 4 persons in 3 different cases of NDPS Act involved in illicit ganja trade and seized 5,500 Kgs of illicit Ganja from

them.

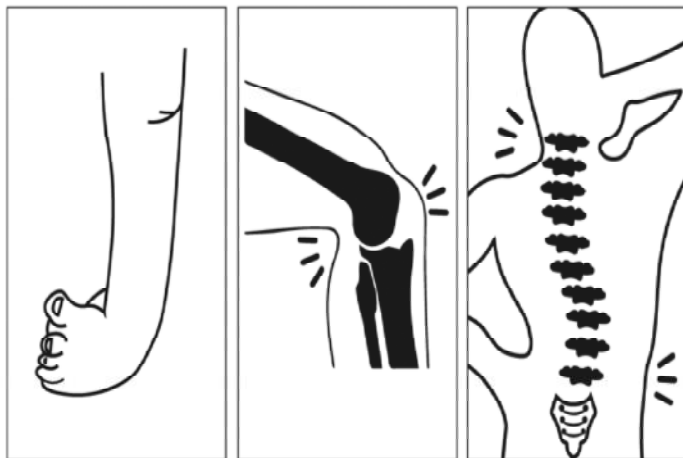

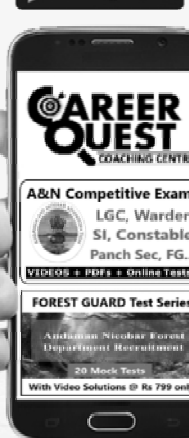
