Departments involved in public delivery services to reach out to general public through electronic media

Interviews of Secretaries of concerned Departments to be aired on AIR from May 10 & telecast on DD from May 19

Port Blair, May 6

The Departments involved in public delivery services should reach general public through electronic media in order to create awareness about the efforts/initiatives being made by UT Administration to improve public delivery system, social infrastructure and social benefit schemes. In this regard, a circular has been issued by Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS directing all Secretaries of the Departments concerned to give interviews in All India Radio (AIR) and Doordarshan (DD).

Accordingly, a roster of interview has been finalized by the All India Radio and Doordarshan and will be broadcast from May 10 and telecast from May 19. The Secretaries of the Departments concerned will give interviews in AIR and DD as per the schedule mentioned.

The interview should cover all such aspects of public interest such as:-

WHO: Covid-19 no longer represents a global health emergency

New Delhi, May 6

The World Health Organisation (WHO) has declared that Covid-19 no longer represents a global health emergency. WHO's International Health Regulations Emergency Committee discussed the pandemic at its 15th meeting on Covid-19, and WHO Director-General Dr. Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus concurred that the declaration of public health emergency of international concern should end. The statement is a major step towards ending the pandemic and comes three years after the global health agency first declared its highest level of alert over the virus.

The organization declared the coronavirus outbreak to

be a public health emergency of international concern in January 2020, about six weeks before characterizing it as a pandemic. During a press conference, WHO Chief said, for more than a year the pandemic has been on a downward trend. The virus' death rate had dropped from a peak of more than 1 lakh people per week in January 2021 to just over 3,500 on 24th of April. Dr. Tedros said, at least 7 million people died in the pandemic. He, however, said the true figure was likely closer to 20 million deaths - nearly 3 times the official estimate. He also warned that the virus is evolving and remains a global health threat, but at a lower level of concern. (Source: india.gov.in)

Four week old infant undergoes Laparoscopic Surgery at G.B. Pant Hospital/ANIIMS

Port Blair, May 6

A four week old infant was referred by a local private Pediatrician with complaints of recurrent vomiting after every breast feeding since 2 weeks. The baby was admitted in the Department of Surgery, G.B. Pant Hospital/ANIIMS and was investigated with blood and ultrasound abdomen which showed abnormal thickening of the gastric outlet and no passage of



milk into the rest of the intestine and stasis of intake milk in the stomach and the diagnosis of Idiopathic Hypertrophic Pyloric Stenosis was made. The baby was pre-

operatively prepared by giving IV fluids and nasogastric tube placement and aspiration and was taken up for major Laparoscopic Surgery. A

Precautionary measures for impending Cyclonic weather condition

Port Blair, May 6

Cyclones can be very dangerous and destructive weather phenomena, and it's important to know what to do and what not to do to stay safe during a cyclone. Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to Hydro-meteorological disasters which fall in cyclogenesis zone and significant number of cyclones gets generated every year in the Andaman Sea. Heavy rainfall due to monsoon leads to localized flooding which also occurs frequently in low lying areas. The Director (Disaster Management), A&N Administration urged the General Public of A&N Islands please adhere Do's& Don'ts of Cyclone.

Do's:

➤ Stay informed: Keep up to date with the latest weather forecasts and advisories issued by your local authorities.

➤ Prepare an emergency kit: Have an emergency kit ready that includes non-perishable food, water, batteries, flashlights, a first aid kit, and any medications you or your family members might need.

➤ Secure your property: Secure loose items



around your property, such as outdoor furniture and make sure doors and windows are properly secured.

➤ Stay indoors: If you're in a cyclone-prone area, stay indoors during the storm and avoid going outside until it's safe to do so.

➤ Follow evacuation orders: If you're advised to evacuate, follow the instructions of local authorities and evacuate to a safe location.

➤ Disconnect electrical appliances: Turn off all electrical appliances and disconnect them from power outlets to prevent electrical surges or fires.

Don'ts:

➤ Don't ignore warnings: Don't ignore cyclone warnings or advisories. Take them seriously and prepare accordingly.

➤ Don't wait until the last minute: Don't wait until the last minute to prepare for a cyclone.

Start preparing well in advance of the storm's arrival.

➤ Don't drive through floodwaters: Don't attempt to drive through floodwaters, as even shallow water can be dangerous and cause your vehicle to be swept away.

➤ Don't use candles: Don't use candles for lighting during a cyclone, as they pose a fire hazard.

➤ Don't stay in low-lying areas: Don't stay in low-lying areas, as they're more prone to flooding and storm surges.

➤ Don't rely on mobile phones: Don't rely solely on mobile phones for communication during a cyclone, as power outages and network disruptions can occur. Have a battery-powered radio as a backup.

➤ Be aware, Be Prepared, Be Safe". (Source: Directorate of Disaster Management)
