Interview of Secretary (Power) broadcast through Akashvani Secretary throws light on short & long term measures to mitigate power crisis in Isles Power scenario will improve after July with the installation of additional 15 MW power generator

Port Blair, May 10

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS has directed all Secretaries of the Departments concerned to give interviews in Akashvani, Port Blair and Doordarshan (DD) to highlight the initiatives taken by the Departments involved in public delivery services to improve public delivery system, social infrastructure and social benefit schemes. As part of this, a roster of interviews of Secretaries of various Departments of A&N Administration has been finalized by Akashvani, Port Blair and Doordarshan. Through the series of interviews, the Secretaries will enlighten the general public about the efforts/initiatives being made by UT Administration in various sectors.

In the first of the series, the interview of Secretary (Power), Shri Pankaj Kumar, IAS was broadcast today on Akashvani, Port Blair and the same is being reproduced in Q&A format for the wider reach of the people of A&N Islands.

Interviewer: What is the current status of power generation and consumption in South Andaman District?

Secy. (Power): The power generation capacity in South Andaman District, especially in Port Blair city and its adjoining areas is presently 38MW. Since the last two weeks, the peak demand of power consumption has risen to 44-45 MW due to rise in temperature leading to more usage of major electric guzzlers/equipments i.e. Air Conditioners and Coolers. At present, there is a shortage of 6-7 MW of power which is being managed by exercising Load Shedding and Demand Side Management. However, no load shedding is being exercised at Shaheed Dweep, Strait Island and Little Andaman in South Andaman District. In Swaraj Dweep, there is a power deficit of 1 MW, especially in the evening hours, which is being tide over through load shedding in Hotels and Resorts and there is no problem for general public there.

Interviewer: What is the status of Power in other two Districts?

Secy. (Power): There are no issues of Power in other two Districts. In North & Middle Andaman District, the peak demand of Power is 10.5 MW, which is being managed by the DG sets of Sitanagar, Panigat, Rangat Bay and Baratang Power Houses where Power is generated in sufficient quantity and no load shedding is exercised in North & Middle

Andaman District. Similarly, the peak demand of Nicobar District is 4.5 MW which is being managed by Electricity Department and there too, there is no load shedding. The load shedding is only in Port Blair as the power consumption is high in Port Blair due to more number of Govt. Establishments, Commercial Establishments, Shops, Hotels etc. It is also seen that weather is another factor which has given rise to increase in consumption of power during peak summer.

Interviewer: What is being done to tide over the present situation?

Secy. (Power): We have taken three measures to tide over the present power scenario. Firstly, we have urged the general public to judiciously use power especially in the evening hours from 5 pm to 11 pm and avoid using major power guzzlers which consumes high power like ACs, motor, geyser, garden lights. Similar instructions were issued to the Govt. Offices, hotels, resorts and shops which are being monitored by the Electricity Department and through this, the Demand Side Management is being taken care of. These are the short term measures. Secondly, the major step taken to tide over the power scenario is the establishment of 15MW power generation which is being carried out through an agreement with a private company. Under this, the Joint Electricity Regulatory Commission (JERC) has approved a 5MW and a hearing has been fixed on

May 16, 2023 at Gurgaon for the establishment of 10MW DG set and it is expected that we will get the approval by May end. By July end, we will get an additional 15 MW power. This will do away with the load shedding.

Interviewer: Why is power cut being experienced apart from the designated load shedding schedule or in between?

Secy. (Power): There are two reasons for this. Firstly, we are exercising load shedding especially in peak hours in the evening. Secondly, tripping is experienced from power generation from solar power plants due to non-availability of 'Battery Energy Storage System' facility. This is being worked out by the Electricity Department to establish Battery Storage to arrest power tripping. Apart from this, normal faults like cable cutting and tree falling also leads to tripping.

Interviewer: Is there any instance of Power theft in Port Blair?

Secy. (Power): We have not received any complaint regarding power theft.

The Department of Fisheries, A&N Administration proposes to implement the components 'Support for Acquisition of Deep Sea Fishing Vessel (FRP/Steel)' for native fishermen of A&N Islands during the year 2023-24 under PMMSY.

The component on assistance for acquisition of deep sea fishing Vessel (FRP/Steel) for native fishermen envisages subsidy @ 40% of the unit cost (120 Lakh) with a ceiling of Rs. 48.00 Lakh for general category and 60% with a ceiling of Rs.72.00 lakh for Schedule Tribe / Women and their Cooperative Societies towards 'Support for Acquisition for Deep Sea Fishing Vessel (FRP/Steel)' for native fishermen.

Applications have been invited from the native fishermen of A&N Islands possessing Mechanized/Motorized Fishing Boat in the prescribed format along with two sets of self contained DPR.

The applicants who have already submitted

the applications for 'Support for Acquisition of Deep Sea Fishing Vessel' have been requested to resubmit the application in the prescribed format along with the self contained DPR (2 Sets).

A 3 days training programme on Freshwater Ornamental Fish Breeding got underway today with its inauguration by Shri G. Sudhakar, IAS, Secretary (Fisheries) at Fisheries Training Centre, Marine Hill.

In his inaugural address, the Secretary (Fisheries) encouraged the participants to take up freshwater ornamental fish breeding as a commercial activity by forming SHGs and societies to reap the benefit extended by the Department through PMMSY. He also expressed happiness in the interest shown by women participants in the training programme.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr. E B Chakurkar, Director, ICAR-CIARI, Garacharma highlighted about the current status of ornamental fish trade in India which is mainly dominated by West Bengal. He called up on



the need for commencement of ornamental fish breeding on commercial scale in the Islands to minimize the import of ornamental fish from mainland for the benefit of the Islanders in terms of income generation

and to avoid infusion of any disease and introduction of invasive species.

In his address, Shri Vikram Singh, Director of Fisheries motivated the participants and requested them to make use of the training for

skill development and to adopt freshwater ornamental fish breeding in a professional way for better earnings. He assured all possible assistance from the Department for taking up the activity as self-employment opportunity.

commercialization lead to increase in Power demand?

Secy. (Power): There are two things. With the increase in population and growth of commercial establishments, the generation of power has not increased. As the population grows, the need of power also increases which leads to load shedding. We are presently managing the difference between the peak hour power demand of 44 MW and generation of 38 MW. By the end of July, 2023, once the 15 MW DG set Power Plant starts power generation, the power scenario will surely improve in Port Blair and its adjoining areas.

Interviewer: What is the status of solar power generation?

Secy. (Power): At present in the entire Islands, 29 MW solar power generation capacity has been installed. We receive sunlight only for 5 to 6 hours and we are getting 9 to 10 percent of solar light which is used in power consumption. Due to non-availability of 'Battery Storage System', we are not able to store solar power in the afternoon, to release that during peak hours. At present, we are directly supplying to the grid as soon as we receive solar power.

Interviewer: Does the Department provide any subsidy to those willing to install solar plants in residential areas and commercial establishments?

Secy. (Power): The Electricity Department implements a scheme through which, the residential consumers can install 3 MW solar Power Plant for which 40 percent subsidy is being provided and this subsidy, is not available for Commercial Establishments. Individuals who wish to avail this subsidy can visit the portal usrp.andaman.gov.in and apply for installing Solar Power Plant. Accordingly, sanction, approval and subsidy will be provided to the beneficiaries through this portal.

Interviewer: What are your long term plans to cope with power deficit?

Secy. (Power): As far as the long term measures are concerned, we are slowly moving towards de-dieselization of power. Dependency on diesel is costly. We are marching towards Renewable Energy and for which, a 50 MW LNG Plant will be established at Hope Town. It is expected that this project will be completed within the next three years. The tender for civil and electric work has been completed and for gas supply, we are in touch with oil companies, so that they participate in tender process. Apart from this, a study was carried out by Expert Group from Ministry of Power and Central Electricity Authority and they have submitted a report on possibility of different power generation means viz. solar energy, wind energy, bio mass energy and modular LNG plant in different Islands. The A&N Administration has started working on the report and Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI), a Govt. of India PSU has been engaged to implement the report. Through these measures, we hope that our dependency on diesel power will reduce and we will move forward towards solar energy.

Apart from this, to optimize use of solar energy, we are going to install 20 MW Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) at the existing NLC Solar Plant and 15 MW Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) Solar Plant at Garacharma, for which, the Japanese Govt. is providing grant. A 15 MW Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) Solar Plant will also be set up in other places. In totality, the Department will be installing Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) of 50 MW. These are the long term plans in which, it is envisioned that we should reduce our dependency on Fossil Fuel (Diesel) so that our Islands are saved from the impact of climate change and the Administration is able to provide power at cheaper rate.

Interviewer: Can you elaborate on the subsidy given on power supply to domestic and commercial consumers?

Secy. (Power): The Electricity per Unit cost is Rs. 41 plus and the consumers are being given electricity at Rs. 2.75 (for power consumption under the slab of 1-100 Unit) and there is a slight increase for the power consumption under the slab of 100 above. Similarly, for commercial consumers, it is Rs. 9.75 for consumption under the slab of 1-200 Units and there is an increase for consumption under the slab of 200 above. So the subsidy is Rs. 39 for domestic/residential consumers and Rs.32 for commercial establishments.

Interviewer: Can you explain about Solar Rooftop Portal?

Secy. (Power): Solar Rooftop Portal facilitates those who wish to install roof top solar panels on their building after sanction. For installing 3KW Solar Power Plant, 40 percent subsidy is being provided and for above 3KW to 10KW, 20 percent subsidy is being provided. This is a Govt. of India scheme and people of A&N Islands can install roof top solar panels on their building. At present, 4MW power is generated through the roof top panels installed in Govt. buildings. Roof top solar panels have been installed in some of the private buildings but the power generation is less. This scheme will be successful only when the general public installs roof top solar panels on their buildings.

Interviewer: What is being done to reduce power consumption in Government establishments?

Secy. (Power): Departments have been instructed to use ACs in 26 degree to reduce power consumption. During peak hours, that is from 5 pm to 11pm, Offices which are not essential have been asked to close. Efforts are also on to install Solar Roof Top panels in remaining Govt. buildings as was done in Raj Niwas, Secretariat and some other buildings, where solar power is generated.

Interviewer: What are the online services provided to consumers?

Secy. (Power): Online facility is available for different services viz. installation of roof top solar panel, for new electric connection, electric bill payment. The name of the portal is vidyut.andaman.gov.in and one can avail these services by logging into the portal.

Interviewer: Do we have an Electricity Regulatory Commission here in these Islands?

Secy. (Power): Gol has formed Joint Electricity Regulatory Commission (JERC) which looks after all the UTs including the State of Goa. The Office is located in Gurgaon.

Interviewer: What are your expectations from the consumers?

Secy. (Power): We request consumers to understand our problem as the power generation capacity is less at present and to cooperate with us. During peak hours, i.e. from 5 pm to 11pm, people have been requested to avoid using major power guzzlers/equipments, which consumes high power like ACs, Motor, Geyser, Garden lights etc. We want to assure the general public that the entire Electricity Department and the Administration is putting its best efforts to improve the power scenario, so that, there should not be any load shedding and load tripping from the next summer onwards.

Interviewer: When can we expect to see change in the current scenario?

Secy. (Power): We can expect to see change in the current power scenario sometime after July, once the 15 MW power generator starts functioning.

4) As far as possible, the two social worker members so selected for a Board shall be from different fields.
5) No person shall be eligible for selection as a member of the Board, if he/she -
(i) has any past record of violation of human rights or child rights;
(ii) has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude, and such conviction has not been reversed or has not been granted full pardon in respect of such offence;
(iii) has been removed or dismissed from service of the Central Government or a State Government or an undertaking or corporation owned or controlled by the Central Government or a State Government;
(iv) has ever indulged in child abuse or employment of child labour or any other violation of human rights or immoral act.
6) The social worker members of the Board shall be paid not less than Rs. 1500/- per sitting, which shall include sitting allowance, travel allowance and any other allowance, as the UT Administration may prescribe.
7) The Board shall sit on all working days for a minimum of six hours commensurate with the working hours of a Magistrate Court, unless the case pendency is less in a particular district and the UT Administration issues an order in this regard.

(1) The term of the social worker member of the Board shall not be more than for a period of three years from the date of appointment.
