Chief Secretary inaugurates newly set up Dialysis Unit at PHC Swaraj Dweep

"We must be relentless in our efforts, only then we will be able to provide the best services to the people": CS

PHC Swaraj Dweep -first PHC in the country to have Dialysis Unit

Port Blair, May 11

In its constant endeavour of providing better healthcare facilities to the people of these Islands, the Andaman & Nicobar Administration has fulfilled yet another long pending demand of the residents of Swaraj Dweep by establishing a Dialysis Unit at Primary Health Centre, Swaraj Dweep. The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS virtually inaugurated the newly set up Dialysis Unit at PHC Swaraj Dweep at a function held in the conference hall of Secretariat today. The Commissioner-



cum- Secretary (Health), Shri Nikhil Kumar, IAS, Secretary (Health), Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, MD, NHM, Dr. Anil Agarwal, Director, Health Services, Dr. Munni Singhania were present on the occasion. They were joined by the Doctors and health staff from PHC Swaraj Dweep through virtual mode. With this, PHC Swaraj Dweep has become the first PHC in the country to have a Dialysis Unit.

Speaking on the occasion, the Chief Secretary congratulated the Health team for setting a record by setting up a Dialysis Unit in PHC Swaraj Dweep, which is the first of its kind in any of the PHC in the entire country. This, he said, shows the relentless efforts of the Administration to provide medical services to the people of the Islands and to bring the standards of services more and more, so that people do not have to undergo any kind of difficulty in getting the required



services. He remarked that in extreme situations and especially during inclement weather, it becomes extremely difficult for a poor patient to manage and get all these services and unlike mainland, there is no option here but to create these services in isolated Islands. He commended the standard and cleanliness being maintained in the Units which are upto the desired level and all the patients who are getting these services are getting at the same level and standard just like any other places in mainland. The Chief Secretary also expressed happiness that some of the tourists visiting the Islands are also making use of the health facility available here. He desired that in the coming days, more and more sectors in all remote locations and patients in outlying areas should be provided with the required health facility and the Health Department would gradually be

Meeting to resolve water crisis in Port Blair city area held PBMC to procure 15 HP Pumps & 15 rolls of Hose Pipe for pumping of water from various sources to mobile tankers

Port Blair, May 11

A meeting was held in the chamber of Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS yesterday in connection with water crisis in Port Blair city area. Consequent to this meeting, another

meeting was held among Secretary, Councillors and Officials of PBMC in the Conference Hall of Secretariat.

During the meeting, it was decided to procure 15 HP Pumps and 15 rolls of Hose Pipe for pumping of water from

various sources to the mobile tankers. Apart from this, 12 water tankers with various capacities will also be deployed in all Wards on alternate days on hire basis. It was also decided by the Ward Councillors that PBMC shall provide one water

tanker in each Ward on alternate days till the water scarcity issue is resolved. It was also decided to dig bore wells at Treatment Plant areas as well as identified places in all other Wards to resolve the issue, a press release from PBMC said.

Port Blair, May 11

Growing up in an atmosphere with love and care is the right of every child. In this regard, the adoption process is an appropriate program that helps in rehabilitation of the orphan, abandoned and destitute children. State Adoption Resource Agency (SARA) under Directorate of Social Welfare is functioning in these Islands as a unit to coordinate, monitor and develop the work of adoption program, disseminating information and awareness on adoption process.

The adoption registration is done

through 'Child Adoption Resource Information and Guidance System' (CARINGS) which is a centralized software containing database of children and registration of parents. Parents can also adopt through relative adoption or children of spouse from earlier marriage as step-parents adoption. The adoption program thus helps to provide a permanent family arrangement to these

children by providing biological caregivers.

The parents willing to adopt can register themselves by logging in as PAPs (Prospective Adoptive Parents) through <https://carings.nic.in> on CARINGS 3.2 version. Documents such as family photographs, birth certificate, income, address proof, bank statement, and medical fitness certificate along with marriage/divorce certificate have to be

uploaded on the portal.

Taking the custody of any minor without following the legal procedure & by violating the adoptions laws is illegal adoption, which is a punishable offence as per Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act 2015 with imprisonment upto three years or fine of Rs. 1 Lakh or with both. It is vital that the adoption process is safeguarded by robust and

Formation of Cyclone over Southeast Bay of Bengal Heavy rain likely to occur in Isles; fishermen advised not to venture into sea till May 14

Port Blair, May 11

As per Metrological Department's weather report, heavy rain (07-11 cm) is likely to occur at one or two places over Andaman Islands and thunderstorm with lightning and gusty wind (wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph) is also likely to occur at one or two places over A&N Islands on May 12. Meanwhile, due

to the formation of Cyclone over Southeast Bay of Bengal and very likely intensification of the system, fishermen of Andaman & Nicobar coasts have been advised not to venture into the sea till May 14.

Local Cautionary Signal III has been kept hoisted at Port Blair port. For further enquiries/ information, one may

DSS postpones schedule sailing of DSS vessels in Inter Island sector in view of cyclonic weather

In view of cyclonic storm 'Mocha', the Directorate of Shipping Services keeping in view the safety of passenger and vessels has postponed the schedule sailing of DSS vessels in the Inter Island sector. Accordingly, the schedule sailing of MV Campbell Bay for Campbell Bay via Nancowry on 12.05.2023 at 1000 hrs from Haddo Wharf and return to Port Blair on 14.05.2023 at 0900 hrs from Campbell Bay via Nancowry & Little Andaman has been postponed. Now, the vessel MV Campbell Bay will sail for Campbell Bay via Nancowry on 14.05.2023 at 1000 hrs from Haddo Wharf and

will sail for Port Blair on 16.05.2023 (Tue) at 0900 Hrs from Campbell Bay via Nancowry & Little Andaman, subject to the weather conditions. The schedule sailing of MV Bharat Seema for Nancowry via Little Andaman, Car Nicobar, Chowra, Teressa & Katchal on 12.05.2023 at 0700 hrs from Haddo Wharf and return to Port Blair on 15.05.2023 at 0500 hrs from Nancowry via same route, has been postponed. Now, the vessel MV Bharat Seema will sail for Nancowry via Little Andaman, Car Nicobar, Chowra, Teressa & Katchal on 14.05.2023 at 0700 hrs from Haddo Wharf and will sail for Port Blair on 17.05.2023 at 0500 hrs

from Nancowry via same route, subject to the weather conditions. Similarly, operation of Foreshore Sector and Harbour/Vehicle ferry services at Port Blair and out stations may also get disrupted/suspended in short notice depending upon the weather condition. Therefore, the passengers and tourists have been advised to plan their journey suitably to avoid any inconvenience. totally self reliant. This, he said, should be the goal of the Department.

The Chief Secretary further remarked that with the roll out of e-sanjeevani services in Isles, doctors serving in remote locations can always contact the experts in Port Blair and avail the services and uplift the standard of services provided to the patients. He also encouraged the health team to continue with the same zeal and enthusiasm in providing services to the people and be relentless in their efforts, and only then, they will be able to provide the best services to the people, he said. He also congratulated the residents of Swaraj Dweep for this new facility. He also urged the patients suffering from Diabetes and Hypertension, the two most common causes of Chronic Kidney Disease, to get themselves screened at regular interval in order to detect the development of Chronic Kidney Disease at the earliest and delay its progression to end stage Kidney Disease requiring dialysis.

Dr. Shiv Shankar, Medical Specialist, GBPH through a power point presentation briefed about the newly set up Dialysis Unit at PHC Swaraj Dweep. With the setting up of this facility there, patients requiring dialysis can avail the service at their convenience, he said. Presently, six patients from Swaraj Dweep are in need of dialysis and they had to come to Port Blair for the same causing inconvenience to them especially during inclement weather.

The unit has two machines and will be managed by one Medical Officer trained in Dialysis and one Dialysis technician under the supervision of a physician trained in Dialysis through Telemedicine. This will bring great relief to six patients of Chronic Kidney Disease who had to travel by boat from Swaraj Dweep twice or thrice a week to undergo Dialysis at G.B. Pant Hospital, Port Blair. It will also provide an opportunity to tourists suffering from Chronic Kidney Disease and are on regular maintenance haemodialysis to undergo Dialysis during their stay at Swaraj Dweep, which has become one of the most sought after tourist destinations in the country. Last year, six tourists availed this facility at G.B. Pant Hospital, Port Blair. The unit will be registered under PMNDP (Pradhan Mantri National Dialysis Programme) and will provide Dialysis free of cost to all patients as being practiced in other Dialysis units in these Islands. Under the PMNDP, the Andaman & Nicobar Islands have Dialysis Units in all three District Hospitals in Port Blair, Mayabunder and Car Nicobar as well as in three Community Health Centres in Diglipur, Rangat and Bambooflat, providing free of cost Dialysis facility to 209 patients suffering from Chronic Kidney Disease. With this, the number of Dialysis Machines set up in these Islands has gone upto 36.

Earlier, Secretary (Health), Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS welcomed the Chief Secretary and others present on the occasion.

Incident Response Teams activated in N&M Andaman District to respond to cyclonic storm

Mayabunder, May 11

As per Bulletin issued by the India Meteorological Department, Govt. of India, a well marked deep depression has been formed over Southeast Bay of Bengal and is likely to intensify into a cyclonic storm by May 12, 2023. In view of this, due preparedness for mitigating the impact of the cyclonic storm is necessary. Accordingly, the Incident Response (IR) Teams notified under Disaster Management Act, for various levels in the District have been activated to respond to the situation, vide an order dated 11/05/2023 issued by the Deputy Commissioner, North & Middle Andaman, District.

The Chairperson/ Deputy Commissioner, North & Middle Andaman District Disaster Management Authority u/s 34 of Disaster Management Act, has ordered that Incident Commanders of all IR teams may give directions for the release & use of resources available with any Department or local authority in respective jurisdictions; control & restrict vehicular traffic to, from and within the vulnerable or affected area; control & restrict entry of any person into, his movement within and departure from, a vulnerable or affected area; evacuate people from vulnerable areas & shift them to identified Relief Shelter; provide shelter, food, drinking

water, essential provisions, health care & service; get the identified dangerous trees posing hazard to life and/or property, cut or pruned; recommend to any Department or local authority to take such measures as are necessary in its opinion; requisition any resources, services, premises or vehicles for the purpose of prompt response, rescue operations, rehabilitation or reconstruction; procure exclusive or preferential use of amenities from any authority or person; remove debris, conduct search and carry out rescue operation; take any other such step as may be required or warranted to be taken as per the need of the situation.

The Order added that whoever, without reasonable cause obstructs any Officer in the discharge of his functions or refuses to comply with any directions given, shall be liable for punishment for a term which may extend to one year (or two years if such act results in loss of lives or imminent danger thereof) or with fine or with both.

Any refusal or withdrawal from the duties, imposed upon any Govt. Official shall be liable for punishment with imprisonment which may extend to one year or with fine, u/s 56 of the Disaster Management Act. Due to paucity of time, the order is being issued ex-parte and shall be in operation, till its withdrawal.

Road from Murugan Temple Jn. to Rama Krishna Mission to be closed for vehicular movements from May 12

The District Magistrate, South Andaman District has notified for the information of all concerned that the road from Murugan Temple Junction to Rama Krishna Mission road will be closed for all the vehicular movements for seven days w.e.f. 12.05.2023 to 18.05.2023. Hence, all the vehicles will be diverted through Shadipur during the above said period, a notification issued by DMSA said.

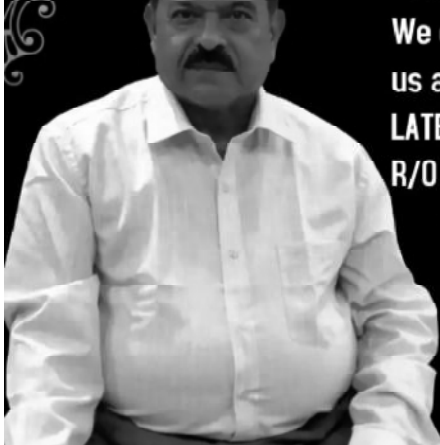
