Interview of Secretary (PBMC) broadcast through Akashvani

Secretary elaborates on 'Citizen Centric Services provided by PBMC'

Port Blair, May 17

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS has directed all Secretaries of the Departments concerned to give interviews in Akashvani Port Blair and Doordarshan (DD) and highlight the initiatives taken by the Departments involved in public delivery services to improve public delivery system, social infrastructure and social benefit schemes. As per the roster, the interview of Secretary (PBMC), Shri Balwan Singh Jaglan, IAS was broadcast today through Akashvani Port Blair and the same is being reproduced in Q&A format for the wider reach of the people of A&N Islands.

Interviewer: Can you elaborate on the current status of water availability to city dwellers?

Secretary (PBMC): The population is continuously increasing and with this, the city's expansion is also taking place. As per the current water supply schedule, our daily requirement is 28 MLD and we are supplying 14 MLD. The main source of drinking water distribution in Port Blair is from Dhanikhari Dam & Rutland. The water level at Dhanikhari Dam is at its lowest in the last 6-10 years and to draw water from this level, motor has to be used to pump water from it. Similarly, the water from Rutland Project has also reduced and 4 MLD water is received from Rutland Project. Because of this, there is shortage of water and the A&N Administration is taking every possible step to mitigate the water crisis.

Interviewer: Do you have any concrete solution to this recurring water problem, year after year?

Secretary (PBMC): Water crisis has been a problem especially during peak summer and to mitigate this, the Administration is taking various viable steps. Both short term and long-term measures are being planned by the A&N Administration to mitigate drinking water scarcity, especially in city areas. As a short-term plan, to augment water supply, PBMC is drawing water from the tube wells and wells which are being distributed to the public after treatment. Natural water sources are also being tapped like Joda Nallah from where PBMC is currently drawing 1 lakh litre of water on a daily basis and there are plans to further increase it to 2 lakh litres. This water is also being taken to Bird Line treatment Plant and after treatment; it is supplied to general public. Apart from this, raw water is also being distributed to the general public after proper cleaning of wells.

The Administration is alert to the situation and has come out with Long-Term Plan to address the water issue. In this regard, the Chief Secretary held a meeting with the Forest Department, Revenue Department and Planners and it was decided to create a Water Storage Facility at feasible sites. Along with this, Amrit Sarovar Scheme is also being implemented in Port Blair and its adjoining areas on a faster mode wherein ponds are being created through dredging. PBMC has created 3-4 Amrit Sarovars and it has also plans to establish 41 bore wells covering 24 Wards. These bore wells will be used only when there is an emergency or there is an acute shortage of water.

Interviewer: With the present scenario, how much thrust is being given to Rainwater Harvesting?

Secretary (PBMC): Rain Water Harvesting (RHW) is such a solution where every household can save water for their own domestic use. RHW can be done through two/three methods. First is through construction of water re-charging wells, through

which, rainwater recharges the groundwater, which can later be drawn through bore well or well. The second method is the recycling of rainwater. This recycled water can be used for non-drinking purposes and piped water supplied through PBMC can be used for drinking. In the building bye-laws, there is a provision under clause 4.8, which makes it mandatory to create RWH in every building or structure. Further, for its effective enforcement, any person who submits the application for building plan approval has to submit an FDR. PBMC retains the FDR with it, till a proper RWH structure is created by following all the norms specified under the building bye-laws. It is hoped that all the upcoming new building will have a proper RWH structure and in old buildings, it will be created by taking up some modifications, which will not only help us in saving water during the rainy season but also help in increasing the groundwater level.

Interviewer: A lot of water sources like wells, ponds are being rejuvenated, how much of these sources are being utilized?

Secretary (PBMC): We have tankers through which we transport water from the wells and supply to people when there is shortage of water. When it is normal season, we don't need to use well water as we receive sufficient water from Dhanikhari Dam and Rutland and we are able to supply enough quantity to the people. Those who have constructed personal bore wells/wells, they are using the water for non drinking purpose.

Interviewer: Is there any plan to set up de-salination plant?

Secretary (PBMC): The plan for setting up de-salination plant is with APWD and they are working on it. There is a plan to set up 1 MLD Plant.

Interviewer: What would you like to say about bore well drilling, is it environmentally safe?

Secretary (PBMC): PBMC doesn't use bore well water during normal water supply. It is being used during emergency only and the quality of water is also being tested prior to its distribution.

Interviewer: Water meter is likely to be installed in both domestic and commercial connections. What is the status?

Secretary (PBMC): Installation of a water meter is part of the PBMC scheme. The present flat rate of water supplied by PBMC doesn't encourage water conservation. Installation of the water meter will help the consumers to know about how much water has been used. The consumers are aware and vigilant and they will cooperate with the PBMC in the installation of water meter. By installing the water meter, the city dwellers will conserve water and use it as per their requirements/needs. The process

Union Health Minister releases Annual Capacity Building Plan for Ministry of Health & Family Welfare

Capacity Building Plans act as the 'Highway' for focused output by a competent workforce: Health Minister

New Delhi, May 17 (PIB)

Recalling and reiterating the inspiration provided by Hon. Prime Minister as he launched Mission Karmayogi to enhance and sharpen the capacities of civil servants who man various Government organisations, Dr. Mandaviya stated that "India is not short of potential but the need is to harness that towards achieving desired outcomes". for installation of the water meter is in progress and an estimate has been prepared. After the approval of the Finance and Taxation Advisory Committee of the PBMC, the installation work of the water meter will begin.

Interviewer: We would like to know about the smart City project. How much is the grant allocated and how much has been spent on different projects?

Secretary (PBMC): Port Blair Smart City Project comprises of 19 projects costing Rs.722.9 cr., out of which, 7 projects have been completed at a cost of Rs.39.65 crores. Work is under progress for 6 projects costing Rs. 382 crores which are in different stages of construction. Apart from this, some other projects have also been entrusted to PBMC and APWD as deposit work costing Rs. 217-18 crores under SCP, the works of which are at different stages of construction. It is hoped that these projects will be completed soon and the general public will be benefitted out of it.

Interviewer: What is being done to develop Marine Esplanade? What is the status?

Secretary (PBMC): Marine Esplanade is a concept to develop the vast Coast Line at Port Blair comprised of components such as the development of a walkway, the establishment of a Food complex, creating parking space, recreational space, sitting area etc. Many works have been completed and the project is in its advanced stage. This project is expected to be completed soon which will benefit the Islanders as well as the visiting tourists. This will boost tourism and increase business opportunities for the local people as food courts will also be developed.

Interviewer: What is the current status of the installation of CCTV cameras across the city?

Secretary (PBMC): CCTV is also a part of the Smart City Project. This project is in its advanced stages of implementation and it is expected to be completed by Dec. 2023. These cameras will help us in aspects such as monitoring, security and safety and remedial measures can be taken, if any incidents take place. It will also help us in traffic management .

Interviewer: What is the status of solid waste management including e-waste and medical waste?

Secretary (PBMC): A&N Islands is doing better in Solid Waste Management as compared to mainland. Solid Liquid Resource Management Centre is functioning in every Ward. PBMC collects wastes through door-to-door collection and wastes are segregated at the source level. Segregation is also done at Solid Liquid Resource Management Centre functioning in different Wards and wastes are divided into different categories. Plastic wastes are used in road construction and some wastes are sent to mainland for its recycling. After proper segregation, very less wastes are left for dumping ground which decreases the space utilized for waste and helps in maintaining a hygienic environment in the city.

Interviewer: How many citizen-centric services are being provided by PBMC?

Secretary (PBMC): PBMC provides 27 citizen-centric services to city dwellers through its website pbmc.gov.in. Apart from this, PBMC has developed an e-nagarsewa application to provide other services and an OBPS application that enables people to apply for building plan sanction. Similarly, for the benefit of city dwellers, PBMC is developing an Integrated Application, in which all the services will be available. This application is developed in association with NIC. Once rolled out, this application will enable city dwellers to get the required services from the PBMC through their mobile phones.

Interviewer: We would like to know about different schemes implemented by PBMC and its current status?

Secretary (PBMC): The important projects of the PBMC is Urban Livelihood Mission, PM SVANidhi, PM Awas Yojana and Amrut Yojana. These projects are under different stages of implementation and the officers and staff are working with dedication for the success of these schemes/projects and PBMC is getting support from everyone including the Chairperson and the Councillors. PBMC is committed to the successful implementation of these projects/schemes, so that its benefits reaches the city dwellers.

Interviewer: What is the status of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan?

Secretary (PBMC): Port Blair has improved a lot as far as the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan is concerned. Port Blair City comes among the top 100 Cities in India. PBMC is maintaining roads and other places spic and span with the cooperation of city dwellers. Swachh Bharat Abhiyan is totally successful in A&N Islands and there is also scope for further improvement. PBMC is committed to bring improvement in its functioning. We should set a benchmark and move forward to achieve the benchmark.

Interviewer: Can you elaborate on the 'Green Connect' initiative of PBMC?

Secretary (PBMC): Administration and the PBMC are making best efforts to develop Port Blair as a one-day destination. For this, Gandhi Park, the City Forest area and Joggers Park is available in Port Blair. All these three areas are unique in nature. At Gandhi Park ,there exist water bodies, boating facilities, children's park, a food court, exhibition hall, while the City Forest Area has provision for nature walks and it will be connected with Joggers Park, which have the 360-degree view of the Port Blair area including Airport, Sea, and Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Dweep. This will be planned in such a way that the Islanders as well as tourists spend the whole day visiting these places by planning a family get-together or family outing and this is the motto behind this project. In six to seven months, it is expected to see this project taking off.

Interviewer: What is being done to solve the parking of vehicles in the city area?

Secretary (PBMC): There is parking problem in Port Blair city area. Taking note of it, PBMC has developed 40 parking places in city area, out of which, 4 parking lots are run by PBMC through which revenue is also generated. More parking lots will be identified by PBMC and it will be used to minimize the traffic congestion in city roads and people will be encouraged to park their vehicles in the designated parking lots so that citizens/ commuters as well as tourists do not face any inconvenience while using city road/space.

Interviewer: Is there any proposal to construct flyovers/underpass to decongest traffic?

Secretary (PBMC): A section dedicated to public related works will look into this and it is too early to comment on it.

Interviewer: What is being done to ensure the safety and security of sanitary workers?

Secretary (PBMC): PBMC is committed to the welfare and safety of its Safai Karamcharis. Raincoats, gloves and other required items are given to our Safai Karamcharis. Apart from timely medical check-up of the Safai Karamcharis are done at Health Institutions available in their vicinity. These Safai Karamcharis have also been enrolled in all the GoI schemes such as PM Bima Yojana, PM Suraksha Bima Yojana etc. so they also get the benefit of these social security schemes.

Interviewer: At last, what would you like to say to the residents of Port Blair City?

Secretary (PBMC): Port Blair is a beautiful place. PBMC requests the citizens to help PBMC in maintaining the beauty of Port Blair city. There is always scope for further improvement for which the citizens should also shoulder their responsibility in keeping Port Blair city Clean, Green and Swachh.

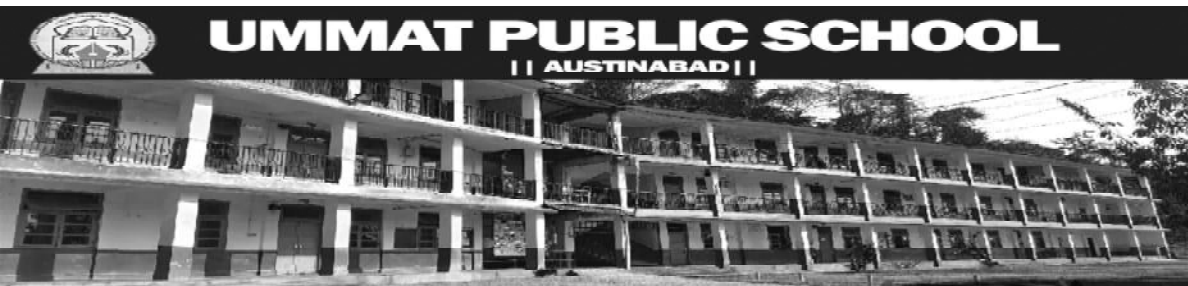

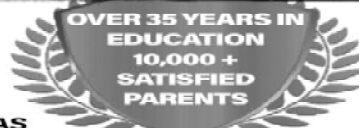
