## Interview of Secretary (Social Welfare) broadcast through Akashvani Port Blair Secretary elaborates on 'Social Security Schemes implemented by Social Welfare Deptt. for diverse sections of society'

Port Blair, May 19

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS has directed all Secretaries of the Departments concerned to give interviews in Akashvani Port Blair and Doordarshan (DD) and highlight the initiatives taken by the Departments involved in public delivery services to improve public delivery system, social infrastructure and social benefit schemes. As per the roster, the interview of Secretary (Social Welfare), Ms Pallavi Sarkar, IAS was broadcast today through Akashvani Port Blair and the same is being reproduced in Q&A format for the wider reach of the people of A&N Islands.



**Interviewer: What are the aims and objectives of Social Welfare Department?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** The main aim of Social Welfare Department is to provide a dignified life to the vulnerable sections of the society i.e. Divyangjan, Senior Citizens, Women, Children, Widow, Destitute Women and Minority Sections by providing them a support system, so that, they feel empowered and lead a dignified life. To achieve this objective, the Department has different schemes and missions. For example, social security pension scheme is being implemented for divyangjan, widows and senior citizens. There are different schemes for destitute and for pregnant and lactating mothers, Supplementary Nutrition Programme (SNP) scheme is being implemented for their benefit.

**Interviewer: Kindly explain about 'Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0 Scheme'?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** Shaksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0 is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme, in which, the fundamental focus is on the nutrition of children, pregnant and lactating mothers, early childhood care and education of children is taken care of. Under Shaksham Anganwadi Scheme, Anganwadis are being modernized with better infrastructure facilities, upgrading and incorporating it with better learning system. Under Poshan 2.0, the nutrition level of the children is being increased, in which, the children belonging to 0-6 age group are provided Poshan wherein hot cooked meals are served to the children in the Anganwadis Centres where they learn, play and at the same time enjoy their meal by observing each other.

**Interviewer: How many Anganwadi Centres are there in the Islands and what are the basic services provided by them?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** There are 720 Anganwadi Kendras in A&N Islands, which provides 6 basic services. First is Supplementary Nutrition under which hot cooked meals are provided. Second is Growth Monitoring, in which weight and height of children are measured in every third week of the month and their growth is checked in the following month, to ascertain their growth level. Apart from this, pre-school education has been taken up through which Poshan and learning are simultaneously provided to children. Immunization of the children are also being carried out from time to time. Health check-ups of pregnant and lactating mothers are conducted. Referral services in coordination with the Health Department are also provided to the children who are found to have ailments like congenital heart disease, cleft lip problem etc. for treatment.

**Interviewer: Can you elaborate on 'Swastha Balak Balika Spardha Abhiyaan'?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** 'Swastha Balak Balika Spardha' is a Healthy Child Competition. Under this scheme, competitions are conducted among children belonging to 6 months to 3 years of age and 3 to 6 years. Under this programme, not only the under-weight and malnourished children but also the health of overweight children are monitored and taken care of. The aim of this programme is to educate mothers on how to provide nutritious and balanced diet to children for their better growth and development. At the end of the competition, those mothers who have maintained their child's health in a better way are provided gifts and certificates as an act of appreciation and motivation. This spardha was started under 'Poshan Abhiyan' and it is organized during Poshan Maah in the month of

September, every year with 'Jan Bhagidari' (people's participation).

**Interviewer: Many Pension benefits are disbursed by Social Welfare Department. Can you elaborate on this?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** The Department provides 4 types of pension viz. Old Age, Widow, Destitute and Divyangjan Pension. 25,861 different beneficiaries are being provided pensions at the rate of Rs.2500 per month. Senior citizens who are above 80 years of age are provided Rs. 3000/- and there are nearly 1300 Senior Citizens under this category. For the other pension schemes like Old Age, Widow and Destitute pensions, the income limit of Rs. 4000 has been fixed for the eligible beneficiaries. But under disability allowance, there are no fixed income criteria. There is a specific application for the distribution of pension and the same can be filled and submitted to the Anganwadi Centres. Beneficiaries can also submit their application online through the e-district portal.

**Interviewer: Kindly elaborate on 'One Stop Centre' and Women Helpline No 181.**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** One Stop Centre comes under 'Mission Shakti', which is being implemented by Ministry. Under this Mission, women in distress, destitute women and those women facing domestic violence can approach One Stop Centre under which two types of services viz. emergency and non-emergency services are provided under one roof. Under emergency service, medical assistance are provided to injured women, who have faced domestic violence. Under non emergency service, legal help, police help and temporary shelter for 5 days are provided to women in need. In A&N Islands, 3 One Stop Centres are functioning, one at Junglighat near AYUSH Hospital in South Andaman, and the other two at Zonal Library Mayabunder in North & Middle Andaman and Perka HQ, Car Nicobar in Nicobar District. Any aggrieved women can approach these 'One Stop Centres', where all kinds of support will be provided by the Social Welfare Department to them. 181 is the Women Helpline Number and women can dial from any part of A&N Islands. This facility is operational 24x7 and staff will provide necessary help. Women can inform any kind of grievances by dialing 181 without any hesitation. In recent times, such calls like suicide tendency were also received. The operator or staff of the Department has been specially trained to handle such calls with utmost care and proper counsellings are also provided to the callers. A total of 957 calls were received during the last financial year.

**Interviewer: How many Old Age Home, Balika Niketan, Home for Divyang etc. are being managed by Social Welfare Department and how much fund is allocated for this purpose and what is the present status?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** The Department is maintaining Old Age Home for senior males at Ferrargunj and one for senior females at Atam Pahad. One Baalika Niketan is at Atam Pahad and one is home for Divyangjan where free clothes, food, shelter, medical assistance and recreational activities are provided to the inmates. Funds are provided to the Department based on the needs and as per the proposals sent to the Ministry.

**Interviewer: Can you throw light on Rashtriya Poshan Mission?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** Rashtriya Poshan Mission has been subsumed under Poshan Abhiyan. Now, it has been brought under Poshan Mission 2.0 which is also known as 'National

## Registration of farmers in e-Samridhi portal for copra procurement underway Interested farmers may contact sub-agent of State Level Supporters of their respective area for registration

Port Blaire, May 19

Copra procurement under Price Support Scheme has been a long pending demand of Island farmers and has now resumed after a lapse of around 10 years. The Cooperative Societies namely ANCOFED, EHL and TDCS are the State Level Supporters (SLSs) to procure Copra from Island farmers and send it to the Central

Nodal Agency- NAFED. ANCOFED procures copra from South Andaman, North & Middle Andaman, Little Andaman and Campbell Bay whereas EHL procures copra from Car Nicobar and TDCS procures from Nancowrie group of Islands. In the first instance, farmers have to be registered in the e-Samridhi portal of NAFED for selling their copra to the Cooperative

Societies. Registration of the farmers in e-Samridhi portal is going on. The farmers who desire to get the benefit of the Price Support Scheme of Copra have been informed to contact the sub-agent of State Level Supporters of their respective area and get the name registered in the e-Samridhi portal, a press release from Agriculture Deptt. said.

Nutrition Mission'. Under this, Block Poshan Coordinators in every block of all the 3 Districts have been appointed and they monitor the health of the children on case to case basis as well as other issues. They take the health data viz. growth of the child, malnourished children etc. in the ICDS functioning under their jurisdiction.

**Interviewer: What benefits are given to adolescent girls by the Department?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** Adolescent girls have been divided into two categories by the Social Welfare Department i.e. girls in the age group of 11-14 years and from 14-18 years. As per the Right to Education Act, this Administration is ensuring free education to girls up to 14 years of age. The school dropout girls between the age group of 11-14 years are identified by the Anganwadi workers and they are again admitted to schools for formal education. Under this, counseling of the parents are done and they are encouraged to send their girl children to school. For girl children in the age group of 14-18 years, Ministry plans to start open schooling for them and also provide vocational trainings.

**Interviewer: What is being done to remove malnutrition among children?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** Growth monitoring of all children attending Anganwadi Centres are done by Anganwadi functionaries and identify children who are stunted, wasting and under weight. This children are individually tracked/monitored and provided proper counseling and additional clinical food supplements. Hot-cooked meals are continuously provided to children in Anganwadis to keep malnutrition at bay. Hot-cooked meals are served to children ensuring all required nutritional values including milk 200 ml according to the weekly menu prepared in Anganwadi Centres. Now, fortified rice is cooked for children having nutritional values such as folic acid and b-12 etc. to fight anemia and malnutrition. Some children are referred to G.B Pant Hospital for further health checkups who are malnourished despite being provided with better nutritious meals in Anganwadis. Apart from milk, the malnourished children are also provided eggs on daily basis. There is a considerable reduction in malnutrition in women and children

**Interviewer: Can you elaborate on the role of each of your grassroot level worker?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** There are 3 types of workers. First is Mukhya Sevika with supporting staff viz. Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers. There are 28 Mukhya Sevikas who are working in field level who concentrates on evaluation and monitoring. Mukhya Sevikas guides the Anganwadi Workers about their duties and responsibilities from time to time. They are the ones who provide on-the-spot solutions to the problems at field level and the Department appreciates their work. Anganwadi Workers are the frontline workers and are known as cutting-edge workers as the success of any scheme depends upon their dedicated effort. They work as mothers for the entire community. They are regularly guiding the mothers of children below the age of 6 years and take care of all the children of a village under the age group of 3 to 6 years admitted in Anganwadi Centres with limited available resources which is appreciable. The role of the Anganwadi helpers is also appreciable as they help the Anganwadi workers in maintaining a hygienic environment, beautification, cooking of food and its distribution to tiny tots in all the Anganwadi Centres.

**Interviewer: Is there any Supplementary Nutrition Programme for pregnant women and lactating mothers?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** Under the Supplementary Nutrition Programme, we provide food to pregnant and lactating mothers and they can have cooked meal at Anganwadi Centres. In addition to this, Village Health Sanitation and Nutrition Day are observed in every village, wherein the ASHA workers and Anganwadi Workers take care of the requirements such as poshan, diet, health checkups (BP and Sugar) for the pregnant and lactating mothers. This comes under a holistic development of the mother and child and all the health checkups are carried out in close coordination with the Health Department. The main work of the Anganwadi Worker is to visit the residence of pregnant and lactating mothers and enquire about their health condition, nutrition and their further requirements. They also conduct different Community Based Events (CBE) like Godh bhara, Annaprashna etc.

**Interviewer: Tell us about the status of Child Care Institutions in A&N Islands?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** In A&N Islands, 11 Child Care Institutions are functioning and they are registered in the Portal of NITI Aayog. Among these, 4 are run by the Govt. and 7 others are run by the NGOs. Altogether, 300 children have taken shelter in these CCI functioning in South Andaman under 'Mission Vatsalaya'. A maintenance grant of Rs.3000 is received per child.

**Interviewer: What is 'Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana'?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** Under 'Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana', pregnant women are provided cash incentives, who are not able to go to work as daily wage earner, MGNREGA worker etc. to enable them to take complete rest. They are provided partial compensation of their daily wage. The Department ensures that proper rest is provided to pregnant women not only during pregnancy, but even after the birth of the first child. Recently, the Department has extended this cash incentive to the second child too, if the child is a girl child. Under this scheme, Rs 5000 is provided in two installments for the child, be it boy or girl. Rs. 3000 is provided in first installment to those women who have conducted their first ante-natal check in 180 days. Rs. 2000 is provided in second installment after the birth of the child. If they report after completing child's immunization, then Rs. 2000 is also given. Now, a latest cash incentive of Rs. 6000 is also in place if, the second child is a girl child. This cash incentive is provided in a single installment after the girl child is born and after completion of the immunization cycle.

**Interviewer: Can you elaborate on the achievements of your Department during the last one decade?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** In the last 10 years i.e. from 2013, many new schemes have been introduced with renewed vision. The Poshan Abhiyan and PMMVY are the two schemes which have big interventions in the Department of Social Welfare. Besides this, Women Helpline Number 181 has been introduced and it is integrated with 'Emergency Response System' with number 112. Apart from this, the Department has enhanced the Social Security Pension Rs. 2500 per month and Rs 3000 for senior citizens above 80 years of age which is the highest paid pension compared to the other parts of India. This was possible due to the effort of A&N Administration. Apart from this, the Department is maintaining Integrated Rehabilitation Centre for Addiction (IRCA) under Directorate of Prohibition in all the three Districts. District Child Protection Units have been activated and Child Marriage Prohibition Officers have been designated. Department has created good number of infrastructure facilities. Under 'Shaksham Anganwadi Scheme', 112 Anganwadis will be modernized. Under Accessible India Campaign, 61 buildings have been made accessible for the easy approach of Divyangjans and 8 buildings will be made accessible. All the Social Security pension schemes have been onboarded in e-district Portal and the beneficiaries are encouraged to avail this benefit through online.

**Interviewer: Do you have any grievance redressal mechanism to sort out**

any issue popping up during delivery of different services?

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** Grievance Redressal is of paramount importance in Directorate of Social Welfare as it deals with day-to-day services and the target group is the vulnerable sections of Society. The grievances of the people is redressed in a time-bound manner. If the beneficiaries have any complaints against Anganwadi Worker, they can immediately contact the Mukhya Sevikas, CDPOs or write directly to the Department. A citizen charter has also been prepared through which people are made aware of the services being provided by the Department. Eligible beneficiaries can approach the Department if, there is any deficiency in delivery of any service mentioned in the Citizen's Charter. Apart from this, complaints can also be lodged at LG's Help Desk and CPGRAMS Portal which is redressed as per case to case basis in a time-bound manner. For the benefit of disabled persons, an exclusive 'Disability Cell' has been established and a Grievance Redressal Officer has been designated to look into the grievances of divyang persons.

**Interviewer: What are your future projects?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** The Department is focused more towards making A&N Islands a malnutrition-free place. Our vision is to work towards achieving zero hunger and zero malnourishment. Sustainable Development Goal (SDG)-2 is for zero hunger while SDG-4 is for quality education. At first, health & nutrition is being covered under malnutrition-free India while in SDG-4 Poshan & Learning will be covered.

**Interviewer: At last what would you like to say to the Islanders?**

**Secretary (Social Welfare):** Social Welfare Department has umpteen number of Schemes for diverse sections of society. The Department requests eligible people to take benefit from these schemes devised by the Govt. of India for their betterment. The Department also requests the mothers to send their children to Anganwadi Centres without fail. Now, the Anganwadi Centres have totally changed with the renewed concept of holistic development of mother and child. These Centres are the first place of formal social communication for the children, where they are provided education through playful method. The Department also urges the pregnant and lactating women to participate in the community-based events organized by the Department at Anganwadi Centres where they get a platform of 'Poshan Panchayat' to discuss every aspect related to their health and other issues. Senior citizens are also requested to approach and apply for the pension schemes without fail and avail the benefits. At present, Life Certificates of the senior citizens are collected by the Anganwadi Workers at their respective areas and they need not come all the way to Port Blair. They can submit their applications at their nearest Anganwadi Centres and their pension will be credited directly into their account.
