Vice-President addresses 70th Annual Convocation of Panjab University

Students must script the blueprint of New India @ 2047: Vice-President

“Nothing is more dangerous than to have a brilliant idea parked in your mind. Act on the ideas by unleashing your talent and exploiting your potential”

New Delhi, May 21 (PIB)

The Vice-President, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar called upon the students "to work tirelessly, avail opportunities and script the blueprint for New India at 2047, when the nation celebrates the centenary of its independence". Encouraging students to make opportunities out of challenges, he suggested that "nothing is more dangerous than to have a brilliant idea parked in your mind. Act on the ideas by unleashing your talent and exploiting your potential".

The Vice-President was the chief guest at the 70th Annual Convocation of Panjab University, Chandigarh yesterday. During the ceremony, the Vice-President, who is also the Chancellor of Panjab University, conferred the Honoris Causa (Doctor of Literature) on noted educator and philanthropist, Dr Sudha N. Murty and Honoris Causa (Doctor of Laws) on the former Chief Justice of India and Member of Parliament (Rajya Sabha), Shri Ranjan Gogoi.

Addressing the



gathering, the Vice-President reminded the students about their "responsibility to contribute to the wider good of society, and to work for the greater good of all". "Ensure and inculcate a deep sense of keeping Nation Always First", he said.

Hailing the National Education Policy 2020 as a game changer, the Vice-President said, the policy developed after consultation with all sections, is transforming

education at all levels.

The Vice-President observed that systemic reforms and affirmative governance measures in recent years have paid rich dividends and that India, "the largest functioning democracy, is a favourite global destination of opportunity and investment and bright star in the world economic growth".

Touching upon digital transformation in India, the Vice-President

referred to IMF recognising India's digital development as a "world-class digital public infrastructure", serving as a model for other nations undergoing digital transformation. He also referred to Direct Benefit Transfers through PM Kisan Samman Nidhi, MUDRA scheme, etc as reflective of India's changing governance model which gives no scope for pilferages. In his address,

Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act

Ultrasonography Units should display signboard indicating detection/ revelation of sex of foetus is illegal

11 Govt. Hospitals & 14 Private Hospitals registered under this act in A & N Islands so far

Port Blair, May 21

The Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Regulation and Prevention of Misuse) Act, 1994 (PNDT), as amended in 2003 to the Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act (PC & PNDT Act), is a law to curb the abhorrent practice of sex determination and sex selection.

Pre-natal diagnostic techniques like amniocentesis and ultrasonography

have been used all over the world for the detection of genetic abnormalities. However, in India, they are being misused for the past three decades for the detection of the sex of the unborn child and subsequently for sex-selection - that is to eliminate fetuses selectively, if they are female. "The Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act" not only prohibits determination and disclosure of the sex of

the foetus but also bans advertisements related to pre-conception and pre-natal determination of sex. Under the Act, it is mandatory in all Ultrasonography Units to display a signboard that clearly indicates that detection/revelation of the sex of the foetus is illegal. Further, all ultrasound scanning machines have to be registered and the manufacturers are required to furnish information about the clinics and practitioners to whom

the ultrasound machinery has been supplied.

A medical practitioner who contravenes any of the provisions of this Act may get imprisonment for a term that may extend to three years and with a fine that may extend up to Rs. 10,000 and on any subsequent conviction, he/she may get an imprisonment that may extend to five years and with a fine that may extend to Rs. 50,000. The calls received from 112 at the Women Helpline Number 181 are followed up with the concerned Department/ concerned Officers of the Social Welfare Department and also uploaded on the Dash Board of the Ministry of Women and Child Development. The case is thereafter followed up on a regular basis till its satisfactory closure.
