A Central Team comprising of Central Nodal Officer, Shri Vikas Anand, IAS, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Panchayati Raj, GoI and Technical Officer, Smt. Ritu Kumari Oraon, Scientist- 'C', Central Ground Water Board are on a three days visit to Andaman & Nicobar Islands for review of Jal Shakti Abhiyan (JSA)- Catch the Rain 2023 Campaign under National Water Mission.

JSA-CTR 2023 with the theme of 'Source Sustainability for Drinking Water' has been launched to promote water conservation and preservation of water sources through Rain Water Harvesting. A&N Islands has participated in the campaign since 2019 and successfully took up many activities promoting rain water harvesting in the Islands under Catch the Rain Campaign.

National Water Mission after evaluating various criteria has identified North and Middle Andaman as water stressed district and issued direction to take up various work under convergence with different Departments to make it a water surplus district. Shri Vikas Anand, IAS, Joint Secretary, MoPR, GoI has been appointed as Central Nodal Officer to monitor and review progress of implementation under JSA CTR-2023.

The team visited North & Middle Andaman on May 22 & 23, 2023 and inspected various sites of Amrit Sarovar, major water supply infrastructure at Diglipur, Mayabunder and Rangat accompanied by Shri Ankit Yadav, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, North and Middle Andaman and other District officials. The team held intensive



interaction with public, Gram Panchayat Officials during inspection and advised them to adopt rain water harvesting and protect water bodies in their areas to ensure water supply is ensured during lean period. He also requested Panchayat to take up rainwater harvesting as community activity. District Administration was advised to use GIS and Remote based technology and plan water conservation structure at potential site to ensure maximum retention of surface

runoff and maximum ground water recharge. The team alongwith the officials visited proposed sites like Khudirampur Dam, Korang Nallah and discussed the plans for



augmentation of water sources with the concerned officials and requested them to expedite the process of various types of clearance and DPR preparation to ensure early start of these project, so that future sustainable water supply in the district can be ensured.

The Central team appreciated the efforts of District Administrators in timely identification of sites for Amrit Sarovar and other sources planned for development for sustainable water

supply in the District. Team was very much impressed with speedy completion of Amrit Sarovar in the district and their proper maintenance.

The team also held a meeting with Officials of APWD and Department of Rural Development at Secretariat Conference Hall. Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, Secretary (APWD) and Ms. Vedhita Reddy, IAS, Secretary (RD) were also present. He expressed happiness over completion of more

Interview of Secretary (Education) broadcast through Akashvani Port Blair

Secretary elucidates on steps taken to impart quality & holistic education to Isles students

Port Blair, May 24

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS has directed all Secretaries of the Departments concerned to give interviews in Akashvani Port Blair and Doordarshan (DD) and highlight the initiatives taken by the Departments involved in public delivery services to improve public delivery system, social infrastructure and social benefit schemes. As per the roster, the interview of Secretary (Education), Shri Yash Chaudhary, IAS was broadcast today through Akashvani Port Blair and the same is being reproduced in Q&A format for the wider reach of the people of A&N Islands.

Interviewer: How many Schools are there in A&N Islands?

Secretary (Education): Education Department is having 414 Schools, out of which, 329 are Govt. Schools under Department of Education, 2 Govt. Aided Schools, 70 Private Schools, 8 Local Body Schools, 2 Kendriya Vidyalayas and 3 Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas.

Interviewer: Is there any shortage of teachers in the Education Department?

Secretary (Education): Education Department is carrying out Recruitment Drive on a war-footing for the posts of Principal, Vice Principal, PGT, GTT, PST and other teaching posts. For the Posts of Principal and Vice Principal, the matter has been sent to UPSC. Similarly, applications for filling up 80 posts of PGT, PET, PSRT, and other posts have already been advertised and applications are being received. The last date for submitting the filled-in application form is May 30, 2023. Similarly, applications will be invited for GTTs and PSTs within the next 15 days. All these are regular posts and the target of the Department is to ensure that with the starting of new academic session after vacation, wherever there are shortages of teachers, it will be ensured that teachers are available in such schools. It will also be ensured during this academic session that there should not be any complaints from parents and elected representatives regarding the shortage of teachers in schools in their respective area. The Department is trying its level best to fill up all the vacant post by June/July this year.

Interviewer: RTE mandates 25% reservation in private schools for children from the Economically Weaker Section. How are you ensuring its compliance?

Secretary (Education): There is a provision for providing 25 percent reservations for EWS students of the society under the

RTE Act. Guidelines have been issued in all the schools in A&N Islands. A meeting has already been conducted with all the private schools and they have been given instructions to follow these guidelines strictly. Similarly, under RTE Act, there are so many other provisions like free and compulsory education, under which, free text books, free supplementary book, uniform, Rs.750 per child, and free stationery are provided to every child aged between 6 to 14 years and this amount is directly deposited in the account of the children besides bus pass for easy access. All these things are mandated under RTE and it is being ensured in all the schools of A&N Islands.

Interviewer: Are you providing 'in-service teachers training' for teachers to cope with the new teaching-learning method?

Secretary (Education): District Institute of Education & Training (DIET) and State Institute of Education (SIE) both these agencies are working under Education Department, through which all the teachers are provided in-service and post-service training. This month, training is underway for PSTs and Head Masters (Primary). Training is focused on learning outcomes and materials are also provided to improve the quality of education in Primary Schools. Apart from this, teachers are also being trained on how to teach students according to New Education Policy and Curriculum Map as per National Assessment Survey conducted by CBSE. From this year, a doubt resolving session for teachers will be organized on the 15th of every month, through which, the teachers working in remote Islands can contact the Resource Person at Port Blair online to clear their doubts. A schedule will be prepared and a Resource Person is assigned in all 9 Educational Zones wherein the teachers

Employers in public & private sectors urged to comply with Employment Exchange Act 1959

Port Blair, May 24

The Employment Exchange (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Act, 1959 and Rules, 1960 made there under are in force in the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands with effect from 1st July, 1978. The Act applies to all establishments in the public sector and those establishments in the private sector where ordinarily 25 or more persons are employed to work for remuneration and the said Act imposes inter alia the following obligations upon the establishments covered under the Act-

The employer in every establishment before filling up any vacancy in any employment in that establishment shall notify that vacancy to the Employment Exchange as may be prescribed;

The employer in every establishment shall furnish such information in the prescribed forms ER-I (quarterly return) and ER-II (once in 06 months) in relation to employment vacancy that have occurred or are about to occur in that establishment to the Employment Exchange as may be prescribed.

As per provision of the above said Act, if any employer fails to notify vacancy arising in his establishment to the Employment Exchange shall be punishable for the first offence with fine which may extend to five hundred rupees and for every subsequent offence with fine which may extend to one thousand rupees.

All the employers in the public sector and concerned employers in the private sector in A &

N Islands have been requested to comply with the provisions of the above said Act and to notify vacancies arising in their establishments to the Employment Exchange, Port Blair for filling up the posts and utilize the services of the Employment Exchange for sponsoring the candidates. Besides, they are also required to notify the vacancy in the local newspaper and national papers as the case may be as per the Apex Court Judgement dated 17/09/1996, failing which, it may lead to contempt of Court. They have also been requested to submit quarterly ER-I and half yearly ER-II returns in the prescribed formats to the Employment Exchange regularly, a press release from Employment Exchange said.

through their respective DEOs can interact with the Resource Persons through VC.

Interviewer: Learning outcomes are important in the education system. What is your say on this?

Secretary (Education): Since last year, focus is being given more on learning outcomes. It is to mention that the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration has stressed on the need for imparting quality education to children besides ensuring better infrastructure. For improving the quality of Education, two types of programs have been devised for the students of classes 1 to 5 and for the students of 6 to 12. For the students of classes 1 to 5, training for teachers is underway and a portal named 'Pahal' has been developed. This portal has been selected from Zonal Level as the 'Best Practice Portal' from A&N Islands. A learning outcome-based survey of all the children of A&N Islands is available in this Portal on the basis of National Assessment Survey. From this year, monthly feedback from all children will be taken on the 25th of every month and it will be reflected in the Portal within 10 days which will be accessible to the Teacher, Head Master, Parents & Students and they can assess their performance. The Chief Secretary will review the performance of the schools on quarterly basis. The end-line survey of the performance of the schools will be conducted in the month of January, 2024 and it will enable the Department to map the entire school's performance. For the students of classes 6 to 12, a monthly curriculum-based test will be conducted and a centralized question paper will be prepared by the Education Department, the result of the test will be declared at the school level and a random check will be done by the Education Department and data will be made available in the portal. This year, the Education Department is focusing more on providing infrastructure such as equipping the schools with proper benches & desks, and the availability of enough teachers in all the schools besides quality education. The Education Department will try to ensure 100% result in the coming years. Extra/revision classes will be organized for the students who are not able to perform better in monthly tests and virtual modules will also be provided to these students.

Interviewer: What do you want to tell to the parents?

Secretary (Education): A mandatory parent's-teachers' meeting is organized in schools, every fourth week of the month. Parents are also members of the School Management Committee and all the monthly test results of the students are also provided to them. They are also requested to give more attention to improving the quality of education of their wards. The response of their child towards studies should be shared with the teachers in schools so that the Education Department and parents can jointly take some remedial measures to help the child in his/her studies. I request the parents to attend the parents-teachers meeting without fail, so that they can inform the teachers and the Principal of the schools about their child's performance at the early stage itself, so that communication gap can be avoided and corrective measure is taken for the child before the final exam.

Interviewer: Hon'ble Prime Minister is giving emphasis on Kaushal Vikas in Schools. How is the Education Department working on this?

Secretary (Education): The Ministry and the Education Department are having guidelines with regard to Vocational Education for students. As per the announcement made by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on vocational Education, the Education Department has started Vocational Education in 88 Schools in A&N Islands in trades like IT, Travel & Tourism, Beauty & Wellness, Security and Agriculture. A practical assessment is also done annually for Class 10th & 12th students by the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) which assess skill development at National Level. More initiatives have been taken up for class 10 & 12 students under Vocational Education. It is expected that Vocational Education will also be introduced for students of Class 6 to 8 by the Ministry this year. As soon as the Ministry approves, it will be introduced in all the Schools in A&N Islands.

Interviewer: The slogan of Samgra Shiksha Abhiyan is 'Sabko Shiksha-Achhi Shikha' under this, what programmes are being implemented in Isles?

Secretary (Education): There are several components in 'Samagra Shiksha', the prime focus of which is providing quality education and improving learning outcomes. Apart from this, creation of Mid-Day Meal Sheds, Teachers Resource Centres, Laboratories, Art Room etc. are the infrastructure development provisions taken up under 'Samagra Shiksha' scheme. Last year, an audit of required infrastructure in schools have been assessed wherein 80 priority works have been identified viz. shortage of classrooms and desks & benches etc., which will be completed by this academic session. Other components such as RO water filter will be completed in all the schools this year and Disability Friendly Schools under which works are progressing well. Provision of electricity and separate toilets for girls and boys are there in all the schools and its upkeep & maintenance is being done through 'Samagra Shiksha' scheme.

Interviewer: Can you elaborate on New National Education Policy?

Secretary (Education): All the Schools in A&N Islands are functioning as per the New Education Policy and all its components are being complied with. The components which have been already complied and maintained includes separate toilets for boys & girls, facilities of ramps, student-teacher ratio etc. Apart from this, there is also provision for creation of Model Schools under NEP. Recently, the Govt. has announced to introduce Pradhan Mantri Shree Yojana in Govt. Model Schools, wherein 100 percent compliance of all the components of NEP will be ensured. To achieve this target, States and UTs have identified 10 Schools and accordingly, A&N UT has also identified 10 Schools that will be of 100 percent compliance of all the components of NEP. The Education Department is geared up and is in the advanced stage to implement all the components under NEP in letter and spirit and Govt. aided & Private schools have also been directed to govern their schools complying with all the components of NEP.

In A&N Islands, education is provided through different mediums such as English, Tamil, Telugu, Bangla etc. The Education Department tries its level best to provide education through the medium as desired/requested by the Parents and Public representatives. The Department has the required teachers to teach the students in different mediums too.

Interviewer: What is the status of establishing Deemed University in these Islands?

Secretary (Education): Education Department is in the advanced stage of establishing Deemed University in A&N Islands as announced by Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi during his visit to A&N Islands in the year 2018. For the autonomy of the 7 constituent colleges functioning in Isles, Deemed University will be established. The Department is committed towards the establishment of Deemed University and all the activities of the colleges like exams will be carried out in a time-bound manner and students will not face any problem once the University is set up.

Interviewer: Do you have any independent transfer policy for teachers?

Secretary (Education): We have been following the annual general transfer policy. This year, as per the direction of the Chief Secretary, the Department has transferred the teachers before the vacation and they have already joined their new place of posting. Henceforth, the Department will ensure that the annual general transfer of the teachers will be done before the summer vacation every year. This will enable the teachers to join their respective schools on time and help the students to start their studies/syllabus on time.

Interviewer: As Secretary (Education) what would you like to say to the parents and students of these Islands?

Secretary (Education): The Education Department is now focusing more on infrastructure and quality education in Schools. The Department requests all the students and parents to cooperate with us. Parents should meet the teachers and provide feedback about the performance of their child. The students should also concentrate on their studies and appear for the monthly tests. The feedback mechanism of all the new initiatives started by the Department has been put in place and parents should provide timely feedback about the improvement in their child and how they can further improve. The parents of remote Islands can contact the DEOs and concerned Principals, if they have any problems regarding their child. As Secretary of Education, I am available in Shiksha Sadan and anyone can meet me during working hours and raise their grievances. Other than that, they can also highlight their problems to the Director, Deputy Director and concerned in-charges in writing and by meeting them. I assure the parents that all their genuine problems will be resolved amicably in a time bound manner.
