A&N Police takes proactive stance against drug consumption & other illegal activities in public areas

Citizens urged to remain vigilant and report any suspicious activities, including drug-related incidents to Police

A team comprising of members from Narcotics Cell, Central Crime Station and Police Station Aberdeen under the supervision of Shri Vinay Mathur, Dy.SP (Narcotics) today conducted a targeted operation aimed at addressing the issue of drug consumption and other illegal activities being reported in public places within the city.

Engaging in drug consumption in public areas not only possess risks to the individuals involved but also creates an environment of fear and discomfort for the law-abiding residents and visitors of the city. Recognizing the importance of addressing this issue, A&N Police deployed a specialized team to focus on identifying and apprehending

individuals involved in drug-related activities in public spaces.

During the operation, officers actively patrolled areas suspected for drug consumption.
