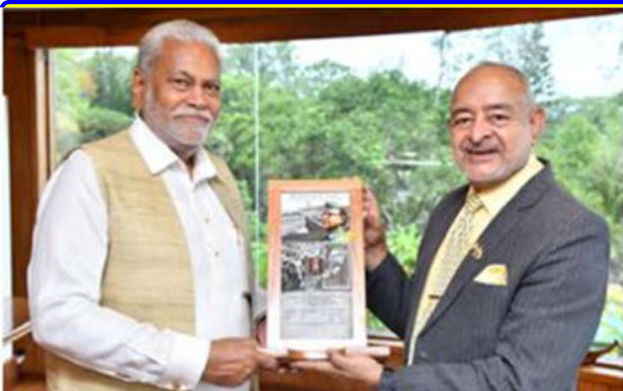

## Interview of Secretary (IT) broadcast through Akashvani Port Blair

## Secretary elaborates on major achievements of IT Sector in enabling ease of access to services by citizens

Port Blair, May 30

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS has directed all Secretaries of the Departments concerned to give interviews in Akashvani Port Blair and Doordarshan (DD) and highlight the initiatives taken by the Departments involved in public delivery services to improve public delivery system, social infrastructure and social benefit schemes. As per the roster, the interview of Secretary (IT), Shri Pankaj Kumar, IAS was broadcast yesterday through Akashvani Port Blair and the same is being reproduced in Q&A format for the wider reach of the people of A&N Islands.



**Interviewer:** Can you elaborate on the duties and responsibilities of Department of IT?

**Secretary (IT):** Internet connectivity is of utmost importance for any e-governance and Digital India programme and the IT Department facilitates all the programme of GoI in A&N Islands. Different types of clearances such as forest and land allotment is done, so that connectivity is increased. As part of our internal role, the IT Department supports different Departments of A & N Administration for preparing digital application & online applications, for which it has appointed programmers for preparing digital application and online application. The GoI's e-governance project such as State Wide Area Network, State Data Centre, E-district projects, Mission Mode Project are implemented by IT Department in the Islands. Apart from this, all e-governance policies of GoI is being formulated and implemented by IT Department which includes 'RoW Policies' and 'Call before you dig' App which was launched by the Hon'ble PM.

**Interviewer:** Undersea cable for improving connectivity was inaugurated in the year 2020. How is the performance?

**Secretary (IT):** Good improvement was seen in connectivity soon after the laying of CANI undersea cable project in A&N Islands in the year 2020. The total tele-density in India is 92 percent while in A&N Islands, it is 178 percent. Before the laying of CANI, the bandwidth was 4.1 GBPS which was through satellite and it increased to 200 GBPS after laying of Under Sea Cable. It means that the Telecom Service Providers can hire upto 200 GBPS and they have so far purchased 60 GBPS and they include BSNL, Airtel and Reliance Jio. As the population increases and as per the requirement of people, the Telecom Service Providers can hire more GBPS. The number of wired connections was 13584 which have increased upto 33581. The number of mobile connections was 4.76 lakh and it is 6.8 lakh at present. The speed of internet, which was 1MBPS has now increased upto 300 MBPS. The connectivity has improved after CANI project. However, there are still shortcomings as some Islands like Katchal, Teressa, Chowra, Little Nicobar, Rutland, Strait Island which are not connected with CANI project. Apart from this, approximately 200 villages are still there which are not connected for which two types of

works have been undertaken. First is the project by GoI, that is 124 Base Transmission Station (BTS) which the GoI has allotted to Reliance Jio. These 124 BTS will be installed at National Highways and also in uncovered villages. The second project approved by the GoI is conversion of 2G-3G towers of BSNL into 4G towers which will cover those areas where connectivity is not available. This project is also known as 4G saturation project. Both these projects are underway at present. Apart from this, an in-principle approval has been received by the GoI for Redundancy project under which Sea cable will be laid from Bhuvaneshwar to A&N Islands. This will also act as a back-up for the existing CANI project. The under sea cable will land at Diglipur at first and thereafter, it will cover other Islands too in a ring, the DPR for which will be prepared by TCIL. The uncovered Islands will be covered by this project in the second phase. This will help us to cope up with the major fault if any, occurs in CANI project and saving of annual hiring charges of Rs. 315 crores for transponders. The BharatNet project of GoI to provide cable connectivity through BSNL to 70 Panchayats, 7 blocks and 4 Tribal Councils has been completed. Under this project, every Gram Panchayat has cable connection through which internet connection is being availed through FTTH by households, Primary Education Centres and PHCs. The IT Department hopes that after completion of different projects, the issue of connectivity in A&N Islands will be solved. The GoI has given timeline to BSNL to complete the 4G project by Dec. 2023. As far as A&N Islands are concerned, BSNL is having 80 towers of 2G & 3G which will be converted into 4G while 96 new towers will be erected/installed. 80 towers will cover 125 villages and 96 towers will cover 101 villages. In total, 226 uncovered villages will be covered through 4G saturation under this project and it will also improve the 2G & 3G networks.

**Interviewer:** Entire country has adopted e-governance mode. How many such initiatives have been taken up by the Administration?

**Secretary (IT):** A&N Islands too have e-governance projects. Under e-district, 96 services have been implemented under e-district and works are under progress for 20 more services, which will be saturated as per the laid down plan. These e-district

projects works in two parts. Under first part, one has to apply for services. The problem comes while delivery of services. There are some issues and at times online delivery of services are delayed. To overcome this, efforts are also on to implement a 'Citizens Charter' which has been sent to the MHA for its approval. Once it is approved, a timeline will be fixed for delivery of services under e-district. E-district services are also monitored by the Chief Secretary during the inter-departmental meetings.

**Interviewer: How far IT has been successful in enhancing employment opportunities and improving economic condition of the people living here?**

**Secretary (IT):** IT related jobs will only be possible when IT City or Software Technology Park is established in A&N Islands. An effort was made during the year 2017-18 during a meeting with NASCOM, an organization of software developers for setting up of the same. After corona, things have changed and big companies like TCS have started working in Hybrid model. However, during a meeting called by Secretary IT & Electronics, the A&N Administration requested for appointing a Consultant to suggest a feasible model for A&N Islands, considering its geographical location. Apart from this, 102 Common Service Centers has been made functional which provides employment to one or two persons in each CSC. Efforts are on to increase more CSCs in different parts of these Islands. A 16-seater accommodation was also started for startups at Industries Department for IT & IT related services. Before corona, 8 entrepreneurs started working there, but after corona they preferred to work from home. Further, with the inauguration of CANI and better internet services, entrepreneurs started working from home avoiding paying a small amount for the accommodation provided to them with all required basic facilities.

**Interviewer: What message would you like to give to unemployed youth?**

**Secretary (IT):** There are two issues being faced by Administration. First is the issue of connectivity of both phone & network in remote Islands. CANI has improved the connectivity. BharatNet project has been completed under which 1478 FTTH connections have been provided by BSNL to the rural households. Two more projects viz. 124 BTS of Reliance Jio and 4G saturation project by BSNL will be completed by the end of this year. With the completion of both these projects, the issue of connectivity will be solved. As far as the issue of employment is concerned, the IT Department requests the youth and the people in general to make productive use of internet to increase their livelihood, capacity building and learning etc. Now a days, the facility of online marketing, digital marketing are available which can be done sitting at home. For major employment in IT sector, the Administration is working towards appointing a Consultant for suggesting a hybrid model for setting up and IT City & Software Technology Park in A&N Islands, paving the way for more employment generation.

As far as the matter regarding plans to convince private IT companies, it depends upon the facilities the Administration can provide to them. To achieve this goal, the Administration has requested the Ministry to appoint Consultant to study the feasibility and to discuss with various stakeholders in mainland about their requirements. The Administration will further work on this, once the Consultant is appointed.

**Interviewer: What are the major achievements of IT Department in the last few years?**

**Secretary (IT):** The achievements of IT Department are immense in A&N Islands. All the telecom projects are monitored through IT Deptt. in A&N Islands. The funding of the projects is done by the GoI while the IT Department monitors, helps and facilitates these projects on a day today basis. The BharatNet project which started in the last two years has now been completed. 124 BTS project which started in last one and a half years is progressing well. The 4G saturation project started this year, the approval for which was provided by GoI last year will be completed by Dec. 2023. Further, under e-district many online services were put in place for the general public. Apart from this, 147 services of different Departments were digitalized, the support for which was provided by the IT Department. Both these services come under e-governance. As per the directions of the Chief Secretary, e-Office Working System has been introduced and this, has enabled all Departments to move towards paperless office and time saving. The e-office system was implemented in one-month time and it is the major achievement of IT Department which is 100 percent successful. e-Office has been implemented in all the Departments of the Islands. Regular training is imparted to the staff dealing in e-Office system. NIXI also provided training in this regard. The old files which are also known as Legacy Files are also being scanned and kept as records to be used as and when required.

**Interviewer: What are the future plans of the IT Department?**

**Secretary (IT):** The IT Department's future plan is to make all the services online. Public oriented services through online mode eliminates the scope of bribery and corruption. All the 3 Deputy Commissioners have been requested to further check the online services and if required, the redundant documents can be removed to avoid harassment to general public. Efforts are on by IT Department towards doorstep & hassle-free delivery of services to the general public with last mile connectivity.

**Interviewer: What is your advice to the Islanders, especially the unemployed youth?**

**Secretary (IT):** The Department wish to inform the unemployed youth that connectivity has been improved a lot and it will further improve by this year end. The youth should use the internet for productive purpose such as capacity building, training, learning etc. They can do online jobs sitting at home besides doing digital marketing and also attach themselves with the 'Call Centres' at mainland. Efforts are on to establish IT City or Software Technology Park and if all goes well, it will generate employment in a big way in A&N Islands.

Gram and Solid Waste Management Cluster at Madhupur. She also visited Mayabunder Block on 27<sup>th</sup> May and conducted round of meeting with PRIs and officials. The meeting was also attended by the Deputy Commissioner, N&M Andaman, Assistant Commissioner (HQ) and Block Development Officer. Detailed discussions were carried on the issues raised by the Panchayats. During the review meeting, the Block team made a detailed presentation on the ongoing activities, regarding the progress of various schemes in the area. She directed the Block and GP level officials to make frequent field visits and resolve issues of the public. She also assured to look into the various issues as raised by the PRIs, a press release from Secretary (RD/Panchayat) said.

employment generation for the people of the Islands. He also emphasized on immediate plan for implementing the second submarine OF cable connectivity to mainland i.e. from Diglipur to Puri, Odisha for having redundancy to the existing CANI connectivity, along with it, he advised to plan to include the left out Islands like Shaheed Dweep, Katchal, Teressa, Champin and Little Nicobar on the second submarine OFC link.

The Chairman TAC appreciated the efforts made by CGM, BSNL and team for elaborate plans made for improving the network availability time in rural areas, for increasing and adding on new areas under FTTH in rural areas/ Islands through BharatNet UDYAMI GoI scheme. He assured that TAC will take up the issue at appropriate level with GoI and DOT, New Delhi for any support in early completion of the 4G mobile saturation project. He emphasized on installing the new mobile towers on priority in remote Islands with no coverage at present.

Further, the MP also suggested that all BSNL Mobile Towers need to be provided with power backup facilities, so that in the event of failure of power supply by the Electricity Department, the Mobile Towers continue to provide uninterrupted internet/broadband service to the intended locations. In this regard, the Chief General Manager responded that action for procurement of batteries as backup facilities has already been initiated which are expected to be delivered in phase manner starting from June 2023 and targeted to be completed before December 2023, this will bring about an appreciable improvement in providing uninterrupted Mobile Internet services in entire A&N Islands.

Earlier, the CGM, A&N Telecom Circle, Shri G. Raja Ram Mohan, ITS in his address gave a brief of the ongoing Telecom projects, future plans of Telecommunication & ICT services being undertaken by BSNL in A&N Islands.

A presentation on BSNL's Telecom Services in Islands was delivered by Shri R. Jagadish Kumar, AGM (Consumer Mobility). Discussions were held on the BSNL 4G saturation project, new FTTH services in uncovered areas of A&N Islands. CGM stated that the mobile connectivity project of GoI's 4G saturation project' by installing 96 new mobile towers and upgradation of 80 nos. of existing mobile towers in rural areas. Further, 174 nos. of existing mobile towers will be upgraded to 4G under phase IX.2 project of BSNL which will be a boon to the Islanders and would bridge the digital divide. The CGM while addressing highly appreciated the continuous support received by BSNL A&N from A&N Administration particularly allotment of land for installation of 77 mobile towers under 4G saturation project. CGM conveyed his gratitude for all the support, guidance and advice rendered by MP in further improving the telecommunication needs of the people of A&N Islands, particularly for the remote areas. The program started with welcome address by Smt. V.P. Deepa, GM (Admin). Vote of thanks was presented by Shri V.B. 
