Mock Drill on Fire Safety conducted at DIET's Hostel

Search & Rescue teams searched all the rooms of Hostel and found 3 students trapped in the Hostel and were safely rescued and handed over to the Medical Response Team of the Hostel for further treatment and hospitalization. Students and other staff were moved to the identified safe area. This was followed by a debriefing session wherein the observers of the mock drill explained the findings and gaps of the drill. In his inaugural address, the chief guest highlighted the need for optimization in operation and maintenance of water supply infrastructure and higher revenue collection by replication of best practices from other States and adopting recent innovation in the field from various expert Institutes. Participants were requested to enrich themselves from experiences of resources persons. Shri H.P Unniyal, Ex CGM, Jal Sansadhan Vibhag and Member, Planning Commission, Utrakhhand, currently Advisor for the training program stressed upon the need for more and more interaction at grassroot level between different States and Institute with expertise in water supply and resources management for sustainable water supply in the UT. He also explained the importance of this type of training program being organised by empanelled KRC of NJJM, DDWS, MoJS.

During the training program, resource persons, Drinking Water and Sanitation Department of HIHT explained different aspects of Operation And Maintenance of the Water Supply Schemes, Utilisation of water Resources Infrastructure and Revenue Collection Mechanism followed in different States. Shri HP Uniyal, Advisor of Water and Sanitation (WATSON), discussed on potential of water sources of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and method for their augmentation, exploration and conservation to ensure sustainable water supply in the Island. He advised engineers to be innovative in managing water supply infrastructure with application of latest technology supported by evergrowing information technology. Fusion of technology, IT and personal dedication shall help in developing a mechanism in the UT which shall be responsive to public need as well as demand and ensure improving operational efficiency at par with some of the best States in the country despite logistic challenges. It shall reduce breakdown of water supply system and make it truly a people's movement in line with true spirit of Jal Jeevan Mission. He also expressed the need for more and more participation of Panchayat in water supply management for long term drinking water security and well being of, local communities. He informed that Panchayat has come forward in many States with much more challenging conditions and has taken up responsibilities for management of rural water supply systems as well as water resources. They have contributed a lot in grey water management and development of recycle and reuse based economy in rural area. PRIs in A&N Islands may consider to adopt some of these models.

KRC Nodal In charge, Shri Nitish Kaushik also explained about the use of various digital platform and innovative technology for monitoring drinking water supply operation, quality control, creating community awareness and public participation.

Scientist, Shri Atul Uniyal enriched the participants on integrated management of water resources under the 'Har Ghar Jal' scheme and shared the details on innovative solutions for various problems faced in other States during implementation of the Jal Jeevan Mission Scheme in the country. 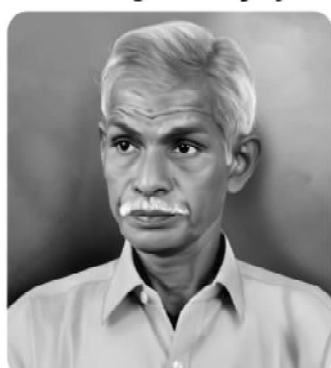
