The ace Cyclists of A & N Islands have brought laurels for the Islands with their stupendous performance in the ongoing 37th National Games-2023 hosted by Goa. The National Games began on Oct.26 and will continue till Nov.9, 2023. In the 500 mtrs Time Trial event for Men, David Beckham has clinched Gold and in the same event for Women, Celestina has bagged Silver Medal. The event was held today at Indira Gandhi Stadium Complex, New Delhi. With this performance, the cyclists of these Islands have registered their proficiency in the event.

Many more events of cycling and other athletics are yet to be played in the Games and the Island team is confident of adding more medals to the tally.

A contingent of 44 members is representing these Islands in the mega Athletic event. Athletes from these Islands are taking part in Cycling, Kayaking & Canoeing, Rowing, Sqay Martial Art and Athletic events. N&M District Police conducts raids on bootleggers & drug peddlers

Continuing its crackdown on the illicit liquor, Handia, illegal sale of IMFL & illicit drugs, the District Police of North & Middle Andaman with the help of local informers conducted regular raids and searches in jungles. During the month of October-2023, the teams of various Police Stations, headed by SHOs and Officers conducted raids & massive jungle search operation.

In these search operations, around 2600 litres of lehan, 43 litres of illicit liquor & 155 Kgs Handia was destroyed. Also, 38 Nos. cases under Excise



Regulation have been registered in which 279 Nos. IMFL bottles of different quantities have been seized and 38 persons were arrested. All the history sheeters are regularly being checked by the beat staff, making it hard for them to be involved in any illegal activity and fresh history sheet of bootleggers has opened for surveillance. Moreover, the District Police registered 3 cases and arrested 4 persons under NDPS Act and seized 440 grams of illicit ganja & 2 grams 77 Milligram of Methamphetamine from them, a press release from SP (N&M) said.
