The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's Order dated 24.03.2022 had directed to fix the outer limit of the sixty days from 18.04.2022 to file the claims for compensation

in case the death occurred due to COVID-19 prior to 20.03.2022. For further deaths, ninety day's time is provided from the date of death due to COVID-19 to file the claim for compensation. However, it is clarified that, in case of extreme hardship, if any claimant could not make an application

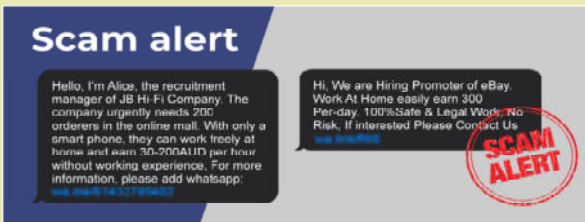

A&N Police issues advisory on 'Fraudsters sending Fake Job Offer SMSs to perpetrate Cyber Crime'

Port Blair, Nov. 3

A new trend in financial cyber fraud has been observed where fraudsters send Fake Job Offer SMSs to perpetrate Cyber Crime. Fraudsters place online advertisements claiming that they can give jobs where one can make large amount of money working from home with little time and effort. A job scam occurs when a fraudster poses as an employer or recruiter, and offers attractive employment opportunities, which require job seekers to pay some money in advance. The SMSs sent by fraudsters offer high-paying part-time jobs to siphon off victims' money and their personal information.



In this regard, the Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens:

- ♦ Avoid tempting job offers sent via text messages or emails by unknown senders.
- ♦ Scrutinize the job offering company online (use words like "scam," "fraud," or "complaint" with company name to online search & verify if similar scams are happening).
- ♦ Avoid making any payment without authenticating the employer for registration or other purposes.
- ♦ Scrutinize the SMS-Headers to confirm the authenticity of a job offer.
- ♦ Fraudsters typically show urgency in their requests. Scrutinize properly, if a request seems too urgent.

Central Crime Station busts gambling den; seizes over Rs. 1 lakh & arrests 4 persons

Keeping its commitment of zero tolerance against illegal activities, the staff of PS Central Crime Station conducted raid at Restaurant Shanthi's Kitchen, Brichgunj Chowk and arrested 4 gamblers.

On receipt of credible information on Nov.2, 2023 night regarding gambling at Shanthi's Kitchen Restaurant, Brichgunj Chowk, a team of PS CCS reached the spot and found four people playing cards in the restaurant. The team successfully caught all the Gamblers who tried to flee from the spot. All the 4 persons have been arrested and a total of



Rs.1,16,400 was recovered from them including board money of Rs. 45,700/-.

The apprehended gamblers were booked under section 5/7 of Andaman and Nicobar Gambling Regulation 1951. It was found that this gambling den was operated by A. Murugesan, S/o Shri P. Alagu, R/o Bathu Basti. The raid was conducted under the command of Shri Kumar Abhishek,

Dy.SP(CID) and under the overall supervision of Shri Rajeev Ranjan, IPS, SP(CID).
