Revenue Deptt. initiates various measures to improve public delivery system through e-District online services

'Sarkar Aapke Dwar'- bringing Government services closer to the citizen's doorstep

Port Blair, Nov.8

The Revenue Department of A&N Administration has initiated various measures to improve public delivery system, social infrastructure and social benefit schemes by introducing e-District online services and conducting 'Sarkar Aapke Dwar' with the aim to bring the Government services closer to the citizen's doorstep. The initiatives launched for ease of access to services in all the three Districts of A&N Islands are as mentioned below:
South Andaman District E-District online services: The District Administration, South Andaman has established the e-Corners at South Andaman District in the premises of Port Blair Tehsil Office, Ferrargunj Tehsil Office and at Swaraj Dweep Patwarkhana, for the implementation of online services through a Single Window

System. Through this e-corner, the citizens of the far flung villages of South Andaman District are easily accessing all online services in a transparent and speedy manner. At present, 66 e-services are provided to the general public and all certificate related public services which were earlier processed manually, has been shifted to digitalized mode. Further, a feasibility study for setting up of similar e-corners at other Islands of this district has already been carried out and very shortly, similar e-corners will be set up at all the Islands having connectivity.
Sarkar Aapke Dwar: With the aim to bring the Government services closer to citizen's doorstep, the District Administration, South Andaman is frequently organizing camps with the theme Zilla Prashasan Aapke Dwar at different villages of the district as part of this

programme. The District Administration has recently organized camps at Guptapara Gram Panchayat, Tushnabad Gram Panchayat and Wimberlygunj Gram Panchayat under Ferrargunj Tehsil and Swaraj Dweep. The residents of these villages/Islands took the opportunity to voice their concerns and many of their grievances were resolved on the spot at the camp itself. The District Administration, South Andaman will very soon organize similar camps at other villages/ Tehsil also.

> **Initiatives made by the Departments to meet the aspiration of public (present and future):** A&N Administration in the year 2019 rolled out e-Mission Mode Project

under Digital India Scheme of Government of India for delivery of various citizen centric services of different Departments through digital platform so that citizen could avail these services online on anytime-anywhere basis. Presently, N&M Andaman District Administration is delivering around 30 services via this digital service delivery platform 'e-District portal'. These services includes Income Certificate, Resident Certificate, OBC/NCL Certificate, Dependent Certificate, Family Member Certificate, Local Certificate, Senior Citizen Certificate, No Dues - Non Encumbrance Certificate, Tamil/ Telugu/Malayalam Origin Certificate, Valuation Certificate, Marriage Registration Certificate, Bar License, Society Registration, Firm Registration, License for Storing/ Selling Crackers, Permit

for Storing and Selling Fertilizers, Permit for Storing and Selling Insecticide, Money Lending License, Permit for Storing Petrol & Diesel, Permit for using Loud Speakers, Marriage Registration under Special Marriage Act and Hindu Marriage Act, Marriage Solemnization Certificate, Mortgage Permission, Economically Weaker Section Certificate, Boat Registration, Earth Cutting permission, Unemployed Certificate, Permit for Sale/Gift of Land parcel, OR Report, Unmarried Certificate etc.

36th National U-9 Chess Championship concludes
Three young chess players from Isles participated and performed well

Port Blair, Nov. 8

The 36th National U-9 (Boys and Girls) Chess Championship, 2023 which began on 2nd November, 2023 concluded successfully today at Jamshepur, Jharkhand. Around 360 players from all over India took part in the championship. Three young chess players from A & N Islands namely Shrihaan Karmakar of KV 2, Pranjal Sana and G Disha Meenakshi of KV 1 participated in the championship and performed quite well. Shrihaan Karmakar, a class IV student of KV 2 was the top scorer among the Andaman players. He played exceptionally well and scored 6.5 points from 11 rounds with six wins and a draw, including two wins and a draw against three higher rated opponents from Gujarat, Karnataka and West Bengal. Similarly, Pranjal Sana and Disha Meenakshi from KV 1 also played well. Pranjal scored 4.5 points with three wins and three draws, including two draws and one win against rated players from Telangana, Delhi and Uttarakhand, while Disha Meenakshi, playing her first Nationals, scored 3 points with three wins against players from Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra and Jharkhand, a press release from ANCA said.

by these revenue functionaries while returning applications to the citizens and formal advisories are issued to Revenue functionaries from time to time to ensure that non-mandatory documents are not sought from citizens and services are delivered to the citizens in a time bound manner.

'Sarkar Aapke Dwar': An initiative of the Revenue Department, under which, periodical Revenue Camps are being organized at Diglipur and Rangat Tehsil to dispose of various revenue matters which are otherwise being dealt at District Headquarter including cases of sub-division of land parcels, at the doorstep of the citizens. During such Camps, Video Conferencing sessions are also being facilitated for citizens who could not attend the Camp but are available online from any other District / State. Altogether 6 Camps have been conducted during the last 6 months and approximately 60 revenue cases have been disposed of in these camps. These initiatives of District Administration has attributed to faster and time bound delivery of services of Revenue Department to citizens which further boosts the confidence of the citizens on the Department.

> Initiatives made by the Departments for improvement in service delivery: The Revenue Department in collaboration with Department of Information Technology had identified 8 high volume services of the Department such as Income Certificate, OBC/NCL Certificate, Family Member Certificate, No-Dues & Non-Encumbrance Certificate, Valuation Certificate, Economically Weaker Section Certificate, Marriage Registration and Land Registration carried out business process re-engineering of existing service delivery mechanism to bring simplified process workflow and improvised delivery mechanism of such services to citizens.

Extensive discussions were held with various stakeholders such as Representatives of Panchayati Raj Institutions and Municipal Council, Andaman Chamber of Commerce & Industries and other Business/Entrepreneur Societies and proposed a minimum set of documents with simplified workflow and defined timeline for delivery of such services to the citizen. The revised workflow, mandatory documents and timeline of such services are being examined by A&N Administration in terms of its compatibility with the legal requirement of delivery of such services and shall be implemented shortly with the approval of Competent Authority.

>Initiatives made for crisis management, if any: Andaman & Nicobar Islands has seen significant improvements in Internet Connectivity since August 2020, when Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi Ji inaugurated and dedicated the Chennai-Andaman & Nicobar Islands (CANI) Submarine Cable Project to these Islands. The CANI network has been further extended up to Panchayat/ Tribal Council level through Bharat Net project of Government of India and in order to improve the mobile connectivity penetration in the Islands, various projects such as 4G saturation project and 124 BTS project are being implemented under Universal Service Obligation Fund projects of Government of India. These mobile network projects are in advanced stage of implementation and shall extend the mobile communication network of Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) to various uncovered villages of A&N Islands.

However, during excavation work for execution of project, instances of OFC cable cut was observed due to lack of coordination between the excavator agencies and BSNL and sometimes creates internet blackout in the District of N&M Andaman. In order to avoid such instances a 'Call Before You Dig (CBuD)' App has been launched by DoT and it has been advised to all the Line Departments to fill the details of their infrastructure such as Cables, pipelines etc. in this app and the excavator agencies have been also advised to raise an alert of execution of their excavation work well in advance in the app so that an alert is sent to the authorities for initiating any precautionary measures. Further, project of laying of submarine OFC between Puri (Odisha) and Diglipur Tehsil of A&N Islands is also under pipeline to provide redundancy to the CANI network and provide uninterrupted internet connectivity to these Islands, in the event of any unprecedented failure of existing network.

The 3 Tehsils of N&M Andaman District is also connected through VSAT based Development Communication Network (DCN) and Fiber Cable based State Wide Area Network (SWAN) for accessing the e-District and other online portal hosted at State Data Centre of A&N Islands. The DCN and SWAN network are also being used to conduct Video Conference meetings between O/o Deputy Commissioner and other 2 Sub-Divisions to discuss the crucial issues of the Department. The Development Communication Network (DCN) also acts as fallback network for connectivity between N&M Andaman District and other Districts of A&N Islands, in the event of failure of Fiber Cable Network.

Nicobar District
E-District online services: Despite the restraints of internet connectivity, the District Administration, Nicobar has successfully established the first e-corner at Nicobar District in the premises of DC Office, Car Nicobar on 14th August, 2023 for the implementation of Online Services through a Single Window System. Through this e-corner, the citizens of the far flung villages of Car Nicobar Islands are easily accessing all online services in a transparent and speedy manner. Since the inauguration of e-corner, all certificate related public services which were earlier processed manually, has been shifted to digitalized mode. Further, a feasibility study for setting up of similar e-corners at other Islands of this district has already been carried out and very shortly similar e-corners will be set up in all the Islands having connectivity.

Sarkar Aapke Dwar: With the aim to bring the Govt. Services closer to citizen's doorstep, the District Administration, Nicobar is frequently organizing camps with the theme 'Zilla Prashasan Aapke Dwar' at different Islands of the District. As part of this programme, the District Administration has recently organized camps at Car Nicobar Island and Nancowrie groups of Islands which includes Kamorta, Katchal, Teressa and Chowra Islands. The residents of these Islands took the opportunity to voice their concerns and many of their grievances were resolved on the spot during the camp. AND WHEREAS, conditions exist in the air during festive seasons in which pollution level is very high and the bursting of fireworks also effect the ambient air and the lungs, eyes and ears of the people and is one of the causes of pollution in the environment.

AND WHEREAS, the bursting of fire crackers/fireworks has been identified as one of the sources of air pollution and noise pollution and it may aggravate the situation and is harmful for senior citizens and small children.

AND WHEREAS, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has directed that green crackers permitted by PESO (Petroleum & Explosives Safety Organization) are to be sold under valid permission and any manufacturer, sale, purchase/possession or use of crackers (carrying barium or other banned chemicals or mislabeled) is completely prohibited.

AND WHEREAS, I have reasons to believe that circumstances exist where such use of firecrackers may seriously endanger life and property of the citizens and maintenance of peace and law & order in the jurisdiction of South Andaman District.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the Section 144 of the Criminal Procedure code, 1973 (No. 2 of 1947), I ANKIT YADAV, IAS, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, do hereby make this written order prohibiting use of fire crackers (carrying barium or other banned chemicals or mislabeled) except for green crackers permitted by **PESO (Petroleum & Explosives Safety Organization)** on religious occasions and not to use plastic carry bags while selling the fire crackers in the jurisdiction of South Andaman District. As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. This order shall be promulgated in the South Andaman District for information of the public by announcement through publicity vans and affixing of copies thereof at notice boards of the Office of the District Magistrate/ Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates as well as prominent public places and publications in the newspaper having circulation in the district. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/ Executive Magistrate and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to be vigilant in the matter.

Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action in accordance with the prohibition order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and U/s 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

AND, WHEREAS, I have reasons to believe that circumstances exist where such use of firecrackers may seriously endanger life and property of the citizens and maintenance of peace and law & order in the jurisdiction of North & Middle Andaman District.

Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/ Executive Magistrate and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to be vigilant in the matter.

Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action in accordance with the prohibition order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and U/s 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

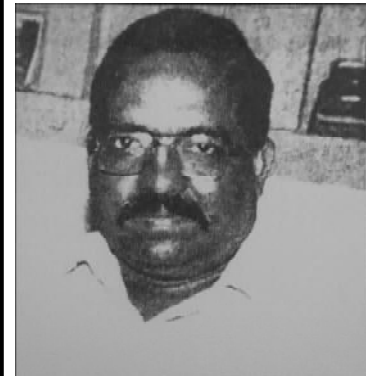
