Working session of G-20 on Food and Energy Security held in Bali, Indonesia

PM Modi calls for return to path of ceasefire and diplomacy to resolve Ukraine conflict

When G20 meets in the holy land of Buddha & Gandhi, it will all agree to convey a strong message of peace to the world: PM

Bali, Nov. 15

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has called for a return to the path of ceasefire and diplomacy to resolve the Ukraine conflict. He said, the need of the hour is to show concrete and collective resolve to ensure peace, harmony and security in the world. Shri Modi stated this while addressing the first working session of G-20 on the issue of Food and Energy Security in Bali, Indonesia today. Reminding the horrors of Second World War, the Prime Minister said, the leaders of that time made a serious effort to take the path of peace and now it's our turn.

Prime Minister said, climate change, COVID-19 pandemic, the developments in Ukraine and the global



problems associated with it have caused havoc in the world and the global supply chains are in ruins. He added that the onus of creating a new world order for the post-COVID period lies on our shoulders.

Referring to India's G-20 Presidency next year, Shri Modi expressed confidence that next year when the G20 meets in

the holy land of Buddha and Gandhi, it will all agree to convey a strong message of peace to the world. Talking about COVID-19 pandemic, the Prime Minister said India ensured food security for its 1.3 billion citizens. At the same time, food grains were also supplied to many countries in need. He said, the current shortage

of fertilizers in terms of food security is also a huge crisis. He added that today's fertilizer shortage is tomorrow's

food crisis, for which the world will not have a solution.

Prime Minister stressed on the need to build a mutual agreement to maintain the supply chain of both manure and food grains. He said, India is promoting natural farming and re-popularising nutritious and traditional foodgrains like millets for sustainable food security.

Ahead of G-20 session, Shri Modi also held brief discussions with world

Two week workshop on Bird Watching & Basic Ornithology by ZSI gets underway

Serenity and pristine beauty of these Islands attract many bird watchers: CS

Bird watching can shape an individual's personality by developing perseverance and patience

A two week workshop on Bird Watching & Basic Ornithology organized by the Zoological Survey of India, A&N Islands Regional Centre under the Accelerate Vigyan, Science & Engineering Research Board (SERB), Department of Science and Technology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Govt. of India got underway at the conference hall of the ZSI here today. The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS as the chief guest inaugurated the workshop in the presence of Dr. R.S.C. Jayaraj, IFS, Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, A&N Islands and Dr. P. Vijayachari, Director, ICMR-Regional Medical Research Centre, Port Blair.

Addressing the gathering, the Chief Secretary thanked the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India for taking the initiative in providing skill training under Accelerate Vigyan. He elucidated the most basic of bird watching definition, aside from simply watching or listening to birds, most birders go a few steps by documenting their observations,



identifying the birds, and sharing their findings with fellow bird enthusiasts. The Chief Secretary also mentioned that birding meaning is inextricably rooted in an appreciation and sense of wonder at the avian species in bird watchers and this is what everyone from novice bird watcher to expert birder has in common. He also highlighted how he expanded his species list with every trip and experience birding in different habitats. He also shared his passion for photography and remarked that landscape photography is his passion which has taught him to wake up before sunrise, and later he has shifted to Bird Photography also. He beautifully described how bird watching can shape an individual's personality by developing

perseverance and patience of the watcher. He concluded by giving remarks upon the serenity and pristine beauty of these Islands which attract many bird watchers and lauded ZSI for taking up this kind of activities.

The Chief Secretary further stated that A&N Islands are the abode of certain birds viz. Narcondum Hornbill, Megapode etc. which are absolutely endemic found only in Isles and nowhere in the World. It's a great opportunity for the participants to learn the nuances of Bird Watching during this workshop, the Chief

New Delhi, Nov. 15

University Grants Commission has asked higher education institutions to initiate necessary steps to engage professionals and industry experts as Professors of Practice in their institutes. It has written a letter to the

Vice Chancellors of Universities and Principals of Colleges across the country in this regard.



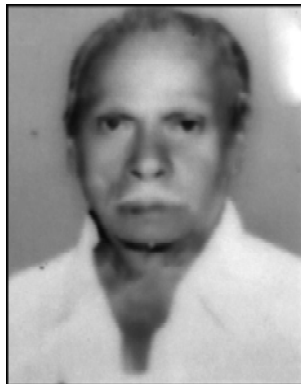
