Vice President addresses the Inaugural Function of National Press Day

No disruptive technology can be a substitute for a well-informed, conscientious journalist: Vice President

Calls for swift action against purveyors of fake news and ethical breaches

New Delhi, Nov.16 (PIB)

The Vice President, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar today emphasised that it is the moral duty of media to "tell the truth and nothing but the truth". He said that it is the responsibility of everyone connected with the media, be it journalists or owners of newspapers and other forms of communication, to be truthful. Asserting that credibility is the biggest challenge that the media is facing today, VP said that it is surprising that this aspect is being blissfully ignored in some quarters.

Addressing the inaugural function of National Press Day at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi today, the Vice-President underlined the pivotal role of the Media in functioning of democracy. Noting that media is not a power centre or stakeholder in real politik, he said, "It is painful to see that some journalists have taken it upon themselves to change the course of democratic process, contrary to ground sentiments." He cautioned that we need to be alive to such dangers.

Reflecting on media's challenges, the Vice-President noted, "It is commerce driven. It floats narratives. It has become unfortunately stakeholder in agitation sustainability. It seeks the role



of partisan influencer in democratic process." Urging swift action, he called upon the Press Council of India to intervene promptly against those intentionally spreading fake news and compromising professional ethics.

Referring to media's responsibility as a watchdog of Government, VP said it is tasked with holding those in power accountable. VP said that the commitment to truth, and the unwavering dedication of journalists will continue to make the media a force for good in our society and "no disruptive technology can be a substitute for a well-informed, conscientious journalist."

Observing that Artificial Intelligence brings its own set of challenges and ethical questions, he said that the spread of misinformation, deep fakes, creation of echo chambers and micro targeting of information influence the democratic process, creating chaos and instability in

society.

Noting Artificial Intelligence (AI) as an integral part of our technological landscape and it as a technology, "which is here to stay", VP said that AI anchors and language models which can write media reports after collating information from multiple sources are threatening the jobs of thousands.

Highlighting the imperative of responsible and ethical journalism amidst the AI era, the Vice-President said that "It is paramount that journalists and media outlets uphold the highest standards of integrity". He also stressed that fact-checking, rigorous source verification and unwavering editorial independence are of importance in today's media landscape.

Shri Dhankhar urged everyone to move forward with "a spirit of innovation and responsibility, harnessing the potential of AI while upholding the principles of journalism that have served us well for generations". He expressed hope in unified capacity to navigate this new era, ensuring that progressive media stands unwavering as a beacon of truth and accountability within our democracy.

Rs.3.5 Lakh per annum from all sources are eligible to appear in NMMSS Examination. The students of Kendriya Vidyalayas, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas and Residential Schools run by State Government and Private unaided Schools are not eligible for scholarship under the National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS). NMMSS examinations students have to produce Mark Statements of the qualifying examinations (i.e. Mark Statement of Class -VII for NMMSS examination). To appear in the NMMSS Examination, students should produce parental Income Certificates issued from Revenue Authority not below the rank of Tehsildar concerned with their application forms. Category Certificate are also to be produced by the candidates who come under reserved categories. Application forms can be obtained from the Office of the Principal, State Institute of Education, Port Blair/Zonal Education Officers of Education Department. Application forms duly filled in all respect along with supportive documents should be submitted in the Office of the Principal, SIE/ Nodal Officer, NTSE& NMMSS on or before 30th November, 2023. Application submitted after the due date will not be entertained. Major fire incident occurred at Phoenix Bay & Dairy Farm on Diwali

Port Blair, Nov. 16
Port Blair city witnessed two major fire incidents on Nov.12, 2023. The first incident occurred at Phoenix Bay Storage Godown at 1902 hrs involving blast of Acetylene, Ferron and LPG Cylinders, which rapidly spread to the adjacent wooden structure dwelling house. 7 Fire tenders, 1 Bouser and 01 Foam Tender from Fire Station Aberdeen, Chatham, Marine, Haddo Wharf, and Garacharma were promptly rushed to the spot and pressed into service to douse the flames. Fire Brigade team, despite facing series of blasts, effectively conducted the fire fighting operation and prevented the spread of flames to adjacent residential and commercial shops. In addition, support from fire tenders rendered by INS Utkrosh, Water Tankers from Private firm M/s MSS Water Supply, TSG Emerald Hotel, Haywizz Hotel, Fire Mitras and general public significantly contributed to the fire fighting efforts. While the fire fighting operation was still underway at Pheonix Bay, another major fire call was received in the Control Room at 9.15 pm, wherein it was found that fire had engulfed the Commercial Shops at Dairy Farm junction involving Paint Shop, Flour Mill, and Old Furniture godown. Swift action was taken by the Fire Officials and 3 Fire Service Water Tenders alongwith 1 INS Utkrosh Water Tender were diverted from the Phoenix Bay fire incident spot. The blaze had got intensified due to the presence of flammable/ combustible materials in the shops. To suppress the fire, foam was applied in addition to water and the situation was brought under control by 10.30 pm. Cooling process was initiated thereafter and by midnight, the fire was completely contained. Fire in both the incidents had escalated rapidly due to the presence of flammable gases/combustible material in the shops. The Fire Brigade team in collaboration with local Police and A&N Command, managed to douse the flames and controlled the spread of fire to adjacent buildings. One residential house, one Cottage-cum-residence and few commercial shops were completely gutted and partial damage occurred at adjacent building. The assessment of damage is being done, a press release from SSP (Fire) said.
