**Release of 15<sup>th</sup> instalment to eligible farmers under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Scheme**

**Rs. 2.4164 crores released, benefiting 11027 eligible farmers of Isles**

**Rs. 44.9658 crores released to Isles farmers since its launch**

Port Blair, Nov. 17

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi released the 15<sup>th</sup> instalment of the PM Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) scheme amounting to Rs. 18000 crore for more than eight crore farmers across the country during the event organized on the occasion of Janjatiya Gaurav Diwas in Khunti District of Jharkhand. The PM-KISAN Scheme is a Central Sector Scheme introduced in February 2019 to help land-holding farmers throughout the nation with their financial needs. Under this initiative, farmers' bank account linked to their Aadhaar numbers receive direct benefit transfers of Rs. 6000/- per year, divided into three equal installments.

During the 15<sup>th</sup> instalment release, Rs. 2.4164 crores was released benefiting 11027 eligible farmers of these Islands. So far, since the launch of the PM-KISAN scheme, Rs. 44.9658 crores have been released to the farmers of A&N Islands. Since the Government of India has made eKYC, Aadhaar Seeding with Bank Account and Land Seeding mandatory for all the P M - K I S A N beneficiaries, it is requested to all the eligible PM-KISAN beneficiaries who have so far not done their e-KYC, Bank Account Seeding with Aadhaar and Land Seeding to complete the process at the earliest.

Further, it is informed to all left out eligible farmers of these Islands who have so far not registered under the PM-KISAN scheme to enroll themselves and avail the benefits under the PM-KISAN scheme.

For any query/doubt related to new registration, Land Seeding, Bank Account Seeding & e-KYC, the beneficiaries can contact the concerned Zonal Agriculture Office/Field Extension functionaries of Agriculture Department, a press release from Agriculture Department said.

Zero tolerance by Police against drugs continues; team of Narcotics Cell arrests one person with ganja at Airport

Port Blair, Nov. 17

Rigorous effort is being made by the A&N Police to weed out menace of drugs from A&N Islands. Continuing its zero tolerance against drugs, the Narcotics Cell, CID team working professionally has succeeded in seizing 5.277 kgs of ganja and arrested the accused person from VSI Airport, said the SP(CID), Shri Mohd. Irshad Haider, IPS while interacting with the scribes here today.

Giving details of the arrest and seizure of drug, the SP (CID) disclosed that acting upon the intelligence input that one person namely Ashis Majhi is arriving Port Blair from Kolkata in Spice Jet Flight with ganja, the team of Narcotics Cell, CID laid a trap and intercepted him outside the Airport Terminal. The team recovered the ganja concealed in his luggage and the accused person was arrested on the spot observing all codal formalities, the SP said adding that on interrogation, the accused informed that with the help of his friend, he purchased ganja from a person in

Kolkata by spending Rs75,000/- .

The SP CID further disclosed that a case under relevant sections of NDPS Act has been registered and the arrested person Ashis Majhi (36)yrs, S/o Late Khagen Majhi, R/o Subash Gram, 5, North and Middle Andaman, Diglipur was produced before the Hon'ble Court on Nov. 16 and obtained his police custody remand to ascertain further chain of persons and finances involved.

The SP CID informed that investigation of the case is in progress and the investigation officer and team of PS Central Crime Station are putting their sincere effort to trace and ascertain the involvement of other persons in disposal of ganja through sale/supply so that the drug nexus can be busted.
