54th IFFI showcasing an eclectic array of World Cinema set to begin today with a gala opening ceremony

13 World Premieres, 18 International Premieres, 62 Asian & 89 Indian Premieres to be screened

Panaji, Nov. 19 (PIB) Setting alight the shores of Goa, the 54th International Film Festival of India (IFFI) is all set to begin tomorrow at Panaji, Goa with a gala opening ceremony. Union Minister for Information and Broadcasting, Shri Anurag Thakur will inaugurate the event at Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Indoor Stadium. The Minister will felicitate the filmmakers and cast of the opening film at INOX Complex. The Minister will also inaugurate the Film Bazaar on the sidelines of IFFI 54. The Film Bazaar is South Asia's largest global film market organised by National Film Development Corporation (NFDC)

alongside IFFI every year, supporting and showcasing the South Asian content and talent in film making, production and distribution. It also facilitates the promotion of world cinema in the south Asian region. The Opening Ceremony will showcase performances by Bollywood superstars Madhuri Dixit and Shahid Kapoor. Bollywood stars Shriya Saran, Nushratt Bharucha, Pankaj Tripathi, Shantanu Moitra, Shreya Ghoshal and Sukhwinder Singh will also perform in the opening ceremony. The Festival would be graced by eminent personalities



award-winning British filmmaker Stuart Gatt. This year, IFFI has received an overwhelming response. A total of 2926 entries from 105 countries were received, which is three times more international submissions than last year. During the nine day festival, more than 270 films will be showcased at 4 venues of the festival. 13 World Premieres, 18 International Premieres, 62 Asia Premiers and 89 India Premieres will be screened during the festival. A total of 32 entries have been received in 10 languages from 15 OTT platforms for Best Web Series (OTT) Award. 15 feature

from the film industry Catherine Zeta Jones, Salman Khan, Vidya Balan, Ayushmann Khurrana, Anupam Kher, Vicky Kaushal, Siddharth Malhotra, Aditi Rao Hydari, AR Rahman, Amit Trivedi, among other celebrated actors, singers and filmmakers. The nine day film festival, showcasing an eclectic array of world cinema to the audiences worldwide, will kick-start with the international premiere of Catching Dust, by

'SVAMITVA Scheme'- enabling rural citizens to use their Property Cards for availing loans & other financial benefits

People urged to make use of the scheme

The Government of India launched a Centre Sector Scheme known as Survey of Villages Abadi and Mapping with improvised Technology in Village Areas (SVAMITVA) to bring financial stability to the citizens in rural India by enabling them to use their property as a financial asset for taking loans and other financial benefits.

Accordingly, Property Cards were issued to the eligible persons. The Administration and Revenue Department encourages people to use Property Cards as it is much easier and digital to apply for loans and financial benefits of Government of India. The eligible person may access the Property Card through <http://db.and.nic.in/>

The Revenue Department has convened a meeting with Lead Bank, SBI along with other scheduled banks and also encouraged them to use Property Cards as part of their documentary requirements for various public sector schemes to enhance the usage and popularity of Property Cards, a press release from DC (SA) said.

SIE to conduct NMMSS Exam in A&N Islands on Dec. 29

Application forms duly filled in all respect along with supportive documents should be submitted by Nov.30

Port Blair, Nov. 19 The State Institute of Education, Port Blair will be conducting the N M M S S Examination in A&N Islands on Dec. 29, 2023 under the guidance of Ministry of Education (MoE). The Selection Test/ Examination will be conducted to select students presently studying in Class VIII (Eight) for award of Scholarship under the centrally sponsored scheme National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship

Scheme (NMMSS) for the academic session 2023-2024. Students who have secured minimum 55% marks or equivalent Grade in class VII examinations (relaxable by 5% for SC/ST candidates), presently studying in Class VIII (Eighth) in Government, Govt. Aided and Local Body Schools of State/ UT and whose parental income does not exceed Rs.3.5 Lakh per annum from all sources are eligible to appear in NMMSS

Examination. The students of Kendriya Vidyalayas, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas and Residential Schools run by State Government and Private unaided Schools are not eligible for scholarship under the National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS). NMMSS examinations students have to produce Mark Statements of the qualifying examinations (i.e.

Mark Statement of Class -VII for N M M S S examination). To appear in the N M M S S Examination, students should produce parental Income Certificates issued from Revenue Authority not below the rank of Tehsildar concerned with their application forms. Category Certificate are also to be produced by the candidates who come under reserved categories.

Offences & Penalties against plying of Un-Registered Motor Vehicles as per M.V.Act/Rules

General public and motor vehicle owners advised to comply with the provisions

Port Blair, Nov. 19 The general public have been informed that plying of unregistered vehicles is a serious violations of Motor Vehicle Laws and the provisions provided in the Motor Vehicles Act 1988 are as follows: **Section 39 of MV (A) 2019:** No person shall drive any motor vehicle and no owner

of a motor vehicle shall cause or permit the vehicle to be driven in any public place or in any other place unless the vehicle is registered in accordance with the Chapter IV (M V Act) and Certificate of Registration of the vehicle has not been suspended or cancelled and the vehicle carries a registration mark

displayed in the prescribed manner. Provided that nothing in this section shall apply to a motor vehicle in possession of a dealer subject to such conditions as may be prescribed by the Central Government. **Section 192 of MV (A) 2019:** Whoever drives a motor vehicle or causes or allows a motor vehicle to be

used in contravention of the provisions of Section 39 shall be punishable for the first offense with a fine which may extend to five thousand rupees but shall not be less than two thousand rupees for a second or subsequent offense with imprisonment which may extend to

A&N Police issues advisory on fraudsters using heat signatures of fingertips on keypads to crack passwords/pins

Port Blair, Nov. 19 A new attack technique is being used by fraudsters for cracking passwords/PINs (ATMs, POS Machine, Smart doors with keypad locks, etc.) by examining heat signatures that fingertips leave on keyboards/screens while entering

passwords, such as the snapped heat combination of brighter the area appears on the Artificial Intelligence (AI). AI algorithms are used to accurately guess

the passwords as per the signatures. The brighter the area appears on the thermal image, the more recently it

Australia lifts ICC Men's Cricket World Cup defeating India by 6 wickets in Ahmedabad

Ahmedabad, Nov. 19

Australia lifted the ICC Men's Cricket World Cup defeating India by six wickets in the final at Narendra Modi Stadium in Ahmedabad today. Chasing a modest target of 241 runs, Australia completed the task in 43 overs with a gritty century knock by Travis Head, after some initial setbacks. Travis Head who scored 137 runs in 120 balls won the Man of the Match award.

Earlier, India has set a target of 241 runs for Australia. Put into



bat, India managed to post 240 runs in the stipulated 50 overs. After a fine start of the innings by Skipper Rohit Sharma, team India could not sustain the Australian pace attack and struggled to score runs. The highlight of

the Indian innings were half centuries by Virat Kohli and KL Rahul. Rahul made 66 while Virat scored 54 runs. For Australia , Mitchell Starc took three wickets while Pat Cummins, and Hazelwood took two wickets each.

would have been touched. Using such correlations PINs/passwords are being cracked.

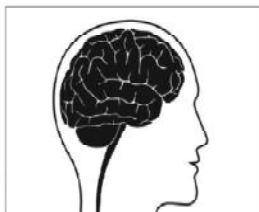
In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens:

- > Avoid using ATMs which are unguarded and not surveilled properly with video cameras.
- > Always examine the ATMs for any suspicious attachments (in ATM rooms walls or the machine). Hide the keypad area while entering the PIN.
- > Press multiple random number keys (buttons) before leaving the ATM.
- > Machine/POS Machine/Smart Locks to generate non meaningful heat signature.
- > Properly check the SMSs and emails sent by your bank regarding any transaction properly, contact your bank instantly if a suspicious transaction is spotted.

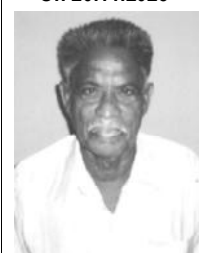
