During this tenure, the Coast Guard further amalgamated with Andaman and Nicobar Command, aligning with the Op vision of C-in-C, ANC. The continuous impetus

by the Flag Officer towards ICG operations resulted in 85% operational availability of ICG ships and aircrafts.
