Vasectomy Fortnight comes at an opportune moment in the history of Family Planning in India when the country has achieved replacement level fertility and now needs to focus on male participation in Family Planning. The slogan for this year is 'Swasth Maa, Swasth Bachcha, Jab Pati Ka Ho Parivaar Niyojan Mein Yogdaan Achchha' (Healthy Mother, Healthy child, when husband's contribution in Family Planning is good). The Vasectomy fortnight may be divided into two parts, Phase Mobilization



phase and Service Delivery phase. In Mobilization phase, identification, sensitization and registration of desirous couples for male contraception and in Service Delivery phase, all facilities to provide services of male sterilization and contraceptives will be distributed.

Various awareness activities will be conducted by all health institutions with the aim to enhance male participation in family planning, addressing myths involved with vasectomy and promoting male methods of
