Rangat, Nov. 25

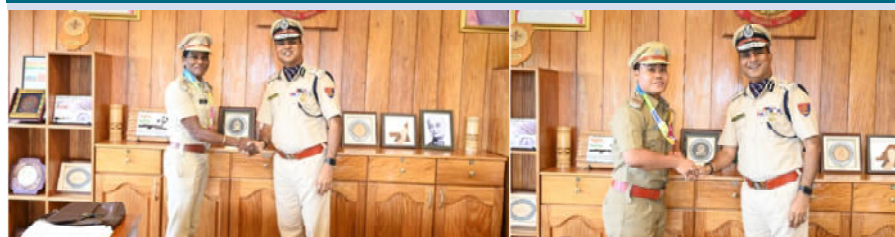

Giving details of the seizure and arrest of the accused, the SP (CID) informed that on Nov. 21, 2023, acting on a specific intelligence input received from reliable source, the Police team from PS CCS conducted raid at Japan Road, Dairy Farm and seized 4.69 grams Methamphetamine from the possession of Sathya Priyan, S/o Shri. N. Chandran (24) yrs, Pvt. Driver, R/o Dairy Farm near Japan Road and was arrested on the spot after observing all codal formalities.

The SP (CID) further said that a case under relevant sections of NDPS Act-1985 has been registered at PS CCS and during the course of investigation, it was found that the recovered drug was supplied by one I.
