Films a great medium of spreading soft-power, enhancement of quality of movies will make soft power more effective: President

New Delhi, Sept. 30 (PIB)

The President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu today conferred National Film Awards for the year 2020 under various categories at 68th edition of the ceremony in New Delhi. The prestigious Dada Saheb Phalke Award was also conferred on the occasion. Union Minister for Information & Broadcasting (I&B), Shri Anurag Singh Thakur, Union Minister of State for I&B, Dr. L. Murugan, Secretary, Ministry of I&B, Shri Apurva Chandra, Chairpersons of Jury and other dignitaries were present at the event.

Speaking on the occasion, the President congratulated Dadasaheb Phalke Awardee Ms Asha Parekh for her special contribution to the world of



cinema and said that this award to her is a recognition of women empowerment.

Films have the widest impact among all the art forms, the President remarked, and added that films are not just an industry but also a medium for an artistic expression of our value system. Cinema is an effective tool for nation building as well.

Smti Murmu said that as the nation celebrates 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav', feature and non-feature films related to the life stories of freedom fighters, known and unknown, will be welcomed by Indian audience. The audience desires production of such films which bolster unity in the society, accelerate the pace of development of the nation and strengthen the efforts of environmental protection.

Highlighting the recognition enjoyed by Indian music abroad, the President said it has been a great medium for spreading India's soft-power globally. She further remarked that in July

RBI hikes repo rate by 50 basis points to 5.9%, fourth hike in a row

New Delhi, Sept. 30

The Monetary Policy Committee of Reserve Bank of India today decided to increase Repo Rate by a half percent to 5.9 percent, with immediate effect. The RBI has raised the repo rate by 1.9 percent since May. Governor, Shri Shaktikanta Das said, the MPC decided by a majority of five members out of six to increase the policy repo rate. Consequently, the Standing Deposit Facility (SDF) rate stands adjusted to 5.65 percent; the Marginal Standing Facility (MSF) rate, and



the Bank Rate to 6.15 percent. The MPC also decided by a majority of 5 out of 6 members to remain focused on the withdrawal of accommodation to ensure that inflation remains within the target going forward while supporting growth.

Today, RBI has projected real GDP growth for 2022-23 at 7.0 percent. (Source: india.gov.in)

Women's T20 Asia Cup: India to take on Sri Lanka today

New Delhi, Sept. 30

India will take on Sri Lanka on the opening day of Women's T20 Asia Cup tournament at Sylhet in Bangladesh at 1 pm tomorrow (Oct. 1). Defending Champion Bangladesh will take on Thailand in the first game of the tournament. Bangladesh will be hosting women's international matches after four years. A total

of seven teams - India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Malaysia and the United Arab Emirates - will be competing for the title. The teams will play each other in a round-robin format, where each will play six games. The top four teams will reach the semifinals.

After being held as a 50-over tournament

between 2004 and 2008, the Asia Cup moved to the T20 format in 2012. The tournament was last held in Kuala Lumpur in 2018, where Bangladesh defeated India in a tight final to clinch the title in 2018. India has won two out of three T20 editions. Interestingly, when it was played in a 50-over format, India won all four titles.

- ⇒ The temporary electric/electric connection is provided to be used in Pooja Pandal only.
- ⇒ Electric circuit in the Pooja Pandal to be fully grounded.
- ⇒ No loose/ open electric lines are permitted in the Pooja Pandal.
- ⇒ No use of Power Supply is permitted outside Pooja Pandal.
- ⇒ All the wiring and earthing should be proper at all time in the Pooja Pandal for the use of temporary/electric connection provided by Electricity Department.
- ⇒ All the electric equipments electric wires used in Pooja Pandal must have ISI mark.
- ⇒ No extra load can be added other than connected load sanctioned by the Department.
- ⇒ No electric wire/ equipment is permitted inside the Pooja Pandal which can be touched by any human being and animals, while it is under charged condition. The Department will not take any responsibility if any accident happens because of this.
- ⇒ The consumer will be abide the agreement for electricity supply for Domestic, Commercial and Industrial purpose [para 4 (a) (ii)] which was signed while providing electric connection.
- ⇒ For the Visarjan of the idol, it is directed to the Pooja Pandal Committee that height of Idol along with vehicle should not be more than 18 feet, and also while moving on road, no electric lines should be touched as all electric lines are under charged condition.
- ⇒ In case of any faults/emergency related to electricity it is directed to immediately inform the nearest Electricity Site Office. (Source:Electricity Department)
