154<sup>th</sup> Birth Anniversary here yesterday.

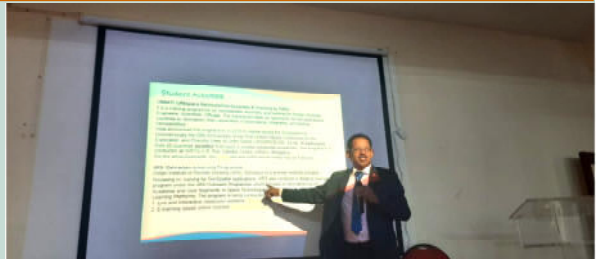

### A&N Fire Service launches 'Fire Mitra' scheme; 167 Fire Mitras identified so far

To enhance fire safety and response capabilities within the community, A&N Fire Service has initiated a Scheme named 'Fire Mitra'. It aims to harness the potential of community members in assisting the Fire Service of A&N Islands, during Fire & Emergency situations. By seeking the support of volunteers from amongst the Islanders,

Fire Service aims to create a more resilient and responsive approach to firefighting and disaster mitigation. Considering the fact that the A&N Islands fall under Seismic Zone-V, which is prone to earthquakes, a standardized training module has been designed and these volunteers have been made familiar with the basic knowledge and skills required to

respond to the immediate needs of the area, during any fire incident, disaster or emergency situation.

About 167 Fire Mitras have been identified so far and 'Fire Mitra Basic Training' has been conducted by Fire Service Officers. The training focuses on survival, search and rescue, casualty handling and assistance in firefighting operations.

Enhancement of defence capabilities specific to A&N Islands is now being given a major thrust by the Govt. of India and significant capability enhancement can be witnessed in A&N Islands in the days to come, said the Commander-in-Chief, ANC, Air Marshal Saju Balakrishnan, AVSM, VM while interacting with the scribes during a press briefing held at Awati Hall, HQ, NAVC as part of the 23<sup>rd</sup> Command Raising Day of ANC. The Command was established on October 8, 2001 as a 'Unified Command' under Commander-in-Chief, Andaman and Nicobar (CINCAN), towards building synergy and cohesion



between the Services while defending national interests in Andaman and Nicobar region.

The CINCAN while elaborating on capability enhancement stated that ports/harbor facilities across the Islands will witness further enhancement. The airfields are being expanded massively while Utkrosh has now become a full fledged Runway. The A&N Command is working

actively towards expanding Diglipur Runway upto 10,000 feet besides expansion of airfield at Campbell Bay. These measures will not only look after the security aspects but also enhance better connectivity.

The CINCAN further mentioned that apart from the security aspects of the Islands, the ANC provides assistance to Civil Administration during medical emergency, rescue of

fishing vessels in distress etc. The Command is not just for defence activities here but also to serve the Nation by helping Islanders, he said.

developing oil based herbal topical formulation as an acaricide to treat tick infestation in livestock.

Tick infestation causes physical damage to livestock, irritation, unrest, paralysis or toxicosis and transmits blood borne protozoan diseases. Chemical acaricidal application is the common method of tick control. However, these chemicals are toxic and may cause accidental poisoning especially in children, residue problem in meat and milk and environmental pollution. Development of resistance of ticks to these acaricides is always an emerging disadvantage of chemical acaricides.

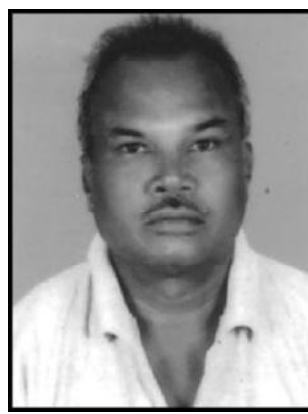

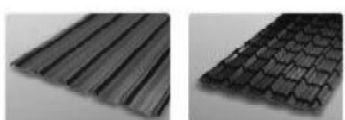
