President inaugurates International Research Conference on 'From Research to Impact: Towards Just and Resilient Agri-Food Systems'

Making our agri-food systems more just, inclusive and equitable is not only desirable but also crucial for the well-being of the planet and humankind: President

New Delhi, Oct. 9 (PIB)

The President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu inaugurated an International Research Conference on 'From research to impact: Towards Just and Resilient Agri-Food Systems', being hosted by CGIAR GENDER Impact Platform and the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), in New Delhi today. Speaking on the occasion, the President said that a society, irrespective of its prosperity, will cease to exist if it is devoid of justice. She added that when it comes to gender justice, agriculture, known as the oldest science, is found wanting even in the modern times. She said that Covid-19 pandemic has also brought to the fore a strong correlation between the agri-food systems and structural inequality in society. She added that as compared to men, women suffered more job loss in the pandemic years that triggered migration.

The President said that at the global level, we have seen that women have been kept outside the



agri-food systems for long. She added that they form the bulk of the lowest pyramid of the agriculture structure, but they are denied the opportunity to climb the ladder to assume the role of decision-makers. She said that across the world, they are held back and stopped by discriminatory social norms and barriers to knowledge,

ownership, assets, resources and social networks. She further said that their contribution is not recognised, their role is marginalised and their agency is denied in the whole chain of the agri-food systems and this story needs to change. She stated that in India, we have been witnessing those changes with

women getting more empowered through legislative and governmental interventions.

The President said that modern women are not "abla" but "sabla", that is, not helpless but powerful. She added that we need not only women's development but women-led development. She said that making our agri-food systems more just, inclusive and equitable is not only desirable but also crucial for the well-being of the planet and humankind.

The President said that climate change is an existential threat and we need to act now, act fast and act swiftly. She said that climate change, global warming, melting ice caps and extinction of species are disrupting the food production and the agri-food cycle is also not sustainable and eco-friendly. It is hindering climate action and causing an increase in greenhouse gases. She highlighted that our agri-food systems are stuck in a vicious cycle

Providing free & cashless services to pregnant women under Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakram in Isles

4539 beneficiaries availed benefits under the scheme during FY 2022-23 in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Oct. 9

Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakram (JSSK) is an initiative to provide completely free and cashless services to pregnant women including normal deliveries and caesarean operations and sick new born (up to 1 year after birth) in Government Health Institutions in both rural & urban areas.

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India has launched the (JSSK) on 1st June, 2011 in view of the difficulty being faced by the pregnant women and parents of sick new-born along with high out of pocket expenses incurred by them on delivery and treatment of sick-new-born. The scheme is to benefit pregnant women who access Government health facilities for their delivery. Moreover, it will motivate those who still choose to deliver at their homes to opt for institutional deliveries.

As per the data received from Directorate of Health Services, entitled benefits were extended to institutional deliveries under JSSK and altogether, 4539



beneficiaries received benefits during 2022-23 (April 2022 to March 2023) under this scheme in A&N Islands. The scheme has eliminated out of pocket expenses incurred by the pregnant women and sick new born while accessing services at Government health facilities.

The following are the free entitlements for pregnant women:

- > Free and cashless delivery
- > Free C-Section
- > Free drugs and consumables
- > Free diagnostics
- > Free diet during stay in the health institutions
- > Free provision of blood
- > Free transport from home to health institutions
- > Free transport between facilities in case of referral
- > Free drop back from Institutions to home after 48 hrs stay

The following are the free entitlements for sick new borns till 1 year after birth:

- > Free treatment
- > Free drugs and consumables
- > Free diagnostics
- > Free provision of blood
- > Exemption from user charges
- > Free Transport from Home to Health Institutions
- > Free Transport between facilities in case of referral
- > Free drop back from Institutions to home

Pontoon positioned at Yeratta Jetty to facilitate berthing of ferry services

Port Blair, Oct. 9

It was observed that the Berthing Jetty of Yeratta was tilted approximately 20 cm towards the sea and therefore it was directed that the Jetty is currently unsafe for berthing of vessels. Considering the safety of passengers and vessels, the Port Management Board (PMB) was forced to suspend the operation of vessels from Yeratta Jetty so as to prevent any



untoward incident.

To facilitate the people and ensure supply of essential commodities, daily vessels to Long Island from Nimbutala and Port Blair has been started by DSS.

Considering the difficulties being faced by the school children, patient etc., it was decided by PMB and DSS to position one pontoon at Yeratta Jetty

Parking fee to be levied on vehicles entering designated parking area at Veer Savarkar International Airport

To ensure smooth flow of vehicle and maintenance of parking space at Veer Savarkar International Airport, Port Blair, parking fee will be charged from all vehicles entering the designated parking area. Accordingly, for efficient movement of passengers, Lane 1 has been designated for Taxi Departure and Lane 2 for other than

Taxi Departure respectively, while Lane 03 has been designated for arrivals of Private Vehicles. This separation will contribute to smoother passenger transitions and reduce traffic bottlenecks. Contractual employee attached with defence agency arrested for allegedly passing sensitive information

Port Blair, Oct. 9

On the basis of a report received from Intelligence Agency, regarding suspicious anti-national activities of contractual staff engaged at jetty area, a case has been registered at PS Central Crime Station, CID under the Official Secret Act, 1923. On investigation, it was revealed that a contractual staff namely Abhishek Kumar Gupta, R/o Deoria Distt., U.P engaged by an out sourcing agency had joined NSRY during the month of March, 2023 and had shared sensitive information through WhatsApp & Instagram.

A lady, honey trapped him and persuaded him to share sensitive information pertaining to security agencies for money. Allegedly, he had accepted Rs. 20,000 approx. on different occasions for sharing sensitive information.

Further, the accused Abhishek managed to join his colleague Santu Biswas, R/o Nadia Distt., West Bengal to pass this sensitive information to him during his absence. Accused Santu Biswas had also shared sensitive information to Abhishek Kumar Gupta in lieu of money. Both the accused persons Abhishek Kumar Gupta

and Santu Biswas have been arrested and are in Police remand. Their links are being investigated to unearth the involvement of other accused persons.

General public have been requested to stay vigilant and aware. Do not accept any friend request in social media from unknown persons. Further, if any suspicious activities is noticed, then they have been requested to inform Police on telephone numbers- 112/100, 232586, 233307 and 9474257242. Wooden dingy kept for claim at Kishorinagar Dinghy Ghat

Port Blair, Oct. 9

The Police team of OP Kishorinagar, while conducting Coastal area patrolling near Loha Tikrey under PS Kalighat jurisdiction on July 28, 2023 noticed a semi submerged wooden dinghy in the creek of Mutha Nallah. The team fetched the water out from the dinghy and found that dingy was fitted with two engines, but could not find any mark of identification on the engines. Later, the measurement of the dingy was taken which was found to be of the length 14 mtrs, width - 2.75 mtrs and depth of 2.5 mtrs. Since, the dinghy was found

unattended, the team conducted search in and around the creek area and after ascertaining the fact that the dingy was unclaimed, the same was seized under the cover of seizure memo on the spot and the dinghy was towed to Kishorinagar Dinghy Ghat.

On the basis of seizure memo, a Challan was chalked out U/s 25 of Police Act, 1861 at PS Kalighat. Simultaneously, a signal was disseminated to all Station House Officers (SHOs) across the jurisdiction, requesting information regarding any lost or missing dinghy reports. Regrettably, all SHOs

have responded with nil reports, indicating no prior complaints or reports regarding the dinghy in question.

The District Police has appealed to the public that if any individual believes they have a legitimate claim to the a f o r e m e n t i o n e d property, they have been requested to come forward. This request comes with a stipulated time frame, as claims must be submitted to the Office of SP (N&M) or directly to the SHO of PS Kalighat within 14 days from the date of publication. Failure to do so will be considered a waiver of any potential claim, a press release from SP N&MA said.

teaching exercise; field visit to Swaraj Dweep (Rani Jhansi Marine National Park), Mahatma Gandhi Marine National Park, Wandoor; Baratang (Mangrove ecosystem & lime stone cave), besides hands on training on intertidal marine fauna at Burmanallah, South Andaman.

In his inaugural address, Dr. T.S. Ashok Kumar highlighted the objectives of the training programme. He said, Andaman and Nicobar Islands are rich in biodiversity resources, and 87 percent of the geographical areas is covered with tropical forests and this training programme is an opportunity to interact with fellow trainees and see the beauty of this archipelago.

Shri Kamal Datta, IFS, Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, in his address briefed about the history of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, and early settlements. He also highlighted about the marine biodiversity, and its importance.
