Cabinet approves establishment of an autonomous body Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat)

Mera Yuva Bharat to focus on Youth led development and will be launched on 31st October on 'National Unity Day'

New Delhi, Oct.11 (PIB)

The Union Cabinet, chaired by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, has approved establishment of an autonomous body Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat) to serve as an overarching enabling mechanism powered by technology for youth development and youth led development and provide equitable access to youth to actualize their aspirations and build Viksit Bharat across the entire spectrum of the Government.

Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat), an autonomous body will benefit the youth in the age group of 15-29 years, in line with the definition of 'Youth' in the National Youth Policy. In case of programme components specifically meant for the adolescents, the beneficiaries will be in the age group of 10-19 years. Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat) will help in Setting the focus of the Government on Youth Led development and to make the Youth "active drivers" of development and not merely "passive recipients". The Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat) will be launched on 31st October, 2023 on National Unity Day. The primary objective of Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat) is to make it a whole of Government platform for youth development. Under the new arrangement, with access to resources & connection to opportunities, youth would become community change agents and nation builders allowing them to act as the Yuva Setu between the Government and the citizens. It seeks to harness the immense youth energy for nation building.

The establishment of Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat) would lead to:

- (A) Leadership Development in the Youth:
 - Improve the leadership skills through experiential learning by shifting from isolated physical interaction to programmatic skills.
 - Investing more in youth to make them social innovators, leaders in the communities.
 - Setting the focus of the Government on Youth Led development and to make the Youth "active drivers" of development and not merely "passive recipients".
- (B) Better alignment between youth aspirations and community needs.
- (C) Enhanced efficiency through Convergence of existing programmes.
- (D) Act as a one stop shop for young people and Ministries.
- (E) Create a centralized youth data base.
- (F) Improved two-way communication to connect youth with Government initiatives and activities of other stakeholder that engage with youth.
- (G) Ensuring accessibility by creating a physical ecosystem.

The perpetrator may also threaten to harm your friends or relatives by using

UIDAI extends facility of free document updation in Aadhaar till Dec. 14

Port Blair, Oct. 11
In order to encourage more residents to update their documents in Aadhaar, the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has allowed the residents to update their documents in Aadhaar online through my Aadhaar portal free of cost upto 14th September, 2023. Now, after receiving positive response from the residents, UIDAI has decided to extend the facility of free document update in Aadhaar for another 3 months i.e. from 15th September, 2023 to 14th December, 2023.

The UIDAI has also encouraged residents to upload Proof of Identity (PoI) and Proof of Address (PoA) documents to revalidate their demographic details, especially if Aadhaar was issued 10 years back and never got updated. This will help in improving ease of living, better service delivery and enhancing authentication success rate.

Residents of Andaman & Nicobar Islands can log in to https://myaadhaar.uidai.gov.in/ using their Aadhaar Number and update their Aadhaar Card free of cost. In case of any difficulty, may visit nearest Aadhaar Centre for document update by paying a fee of Rs. 50/-, a press release from CS&CA said.

In this regard, the Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens against online Catphishing:

- ◆ Never share any compromising images, posts, videos of yourself to anyone, no matter who they are.
- ◆ Never pick up any calls / video calls from anonymous number.
- ◆ Turn off your electronic devices and web cameras when you are not using them.
- ◆ Use two factor authentication with strong passwords and different passwords for different social media accounts.
- ◆ Enable privacy and security features in all your social media accounts.
- ◆ Do not suffer in silence, know that you are not alone, reach out and seek help from trusted family and friends.
- ◆ Avoid browsing the suspicious websites and websites which you are fully not aware.
- ◆ On social media or dating platforms, be cautious of unknown users who try to move the conversation to another interactive platform very quickly.
