## Agriculture Department implementing various schemes to improve agri produce in a sustainable manner in Isles

### Farmers urged to reap benefits of the schemes

Port Blair, Oct. 16

The Department of Agriculture was established in 1945 to meet the food requirement of these Islands in a systematic and scientific manner. The A&N Islands have been divided into 8 Agriculture Zones.

**Activities of Agriculture Department**

To improve production and productivity in a sustainable manner, the Department is implementing different schemes under Sub Sector- Crop Husbandry, Soil Conservation and Minor Irrigation through the UT Plan programme. Besides the Plan Scheme, the Department is also implementing the Centrally Sponsored schemes like High Value Agriculture Programme, Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), Agricultural Technology Management Agency (ATMA) and Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY). All the schemes implemented under different sub sectors provide financial assistance to the farmers, directly or in directly, in the shape of cost subsidy, transport subsidy and loan. The three Sub Sector Schemes implemented under the Sector Agriculture and allied activities viz. Crop Husbandry, Soil Conservation and Minor Irrigation are:-

**Crop Husbandry**

**Scheme No. 1: Assistance to farmers under High Yielding Programme**

Introduction of High Yielding Varieties, indiscriminate use of PP chemicals and introduction of many Crop varieties has led to resurgence of pests, substantial reduction of natural enemies thereby contributed to high population of pests and imbalance of micro ecosystem. In order to encourage farmers to undertake agriculture activities various agriculture inputs are distributed on subsidy basis by the Department.

**Scheme No. 2: Assistance to farmers for promotion of Horticulture Crop & High Value Agriculture.**

The high value agriculture programme addresses promotion of coconut based farming systems, growing of high value fruits, flowers, spices, medicinal and aromatics. To commercialize and to fetch remunerative price for horticulture produce of farmers, assistance will be provided for Post Harvest Management and value addition. Geographical situation of these Islands acts as bottlenecks in transporting highly perishable fruits and vegetables and thereby increasing post harvest losses and necessitating post harvest management. To avoid post harvest losses a chain of cold storage need to be created along with post harvest management practices like pre cooling, cold storage and refrigerated transport.

**Scheme No.3: Training and Extension Programme (IT & Demonstration)**

Under this scheme, the Department conducts demonstrations in the farmers' field/departmental farms, organizes farmers training programme of one/two days duration to disseminate the technologies. Besides, the Department also organizes exposure visit to gain knowledge and acquaint with advance package of practices. The Department also organizes Kisan Mela in Block level and State level exhibition in order to judge the achievement at different level.

Incentives are provided to the farmers to encourage them. Demonstrations are conducted in the Departmental farms/ farmers' field to extend the know-how of modern farm technology in their field.

**Soil Conservation**

The Department of Agriculture undertakes Soil Conservation Works under sub-sector Soil Conservation. Under this, two schemes are implemented viz. Soil Conservation works and Distribution of Soil Health Card and Improvement of Degraded land and drainage.

**Minor Irrigation**

This scheme covers Excavation of MI Pond, Construction of Dug well/RCC ring well, Renovation of Existing (old) pond, Purchase of Electric/Diesel Pump set and Installation of Micro Irrigation System (Drip/Sprinkler).

**High Value Agriculture Development Agency (HVADA)**

Benefits provided to the farmers by HVADA are:

- ◆ Area Expansion programme for horticultural crops like fruits (Perennial, Non-Perennial, flowers, Spices, Hybrid vegetable etc.
- ◆ Financial assistance for encouraging Protected Cultivation.
- ◆ Scheme for Pollination support through bee keeping.
- ◆ Horticulture Mechanization - farm machineries like grass cutter and sprayers are provided on subsidy.

**Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN)**

Under the Scheme, an amount of Rs.6000/- per year is transferred in three

Inaugurating the Buyers session, the Secretary (Finance) informed that the Government e-Market place (GeM) is a one stop portal, a completely paperless, cashless and system driven e-market place, launched on 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2016 to facilitate online procurement of common use Goods & Services required by various Government Departments / Organizations/ PSUs. GeM aims to enhance transparency, efficiency and speed in public procurement. It provides the tools of e-bidding, reverse e-auction and demand aggregation to facilitate the Government users achieve the best value for their money. Further, new tools are evolved from time to time by GeM. The purchases through GeM by Government users have been authorized and made mandatory by Ministry of Finance by adding a new Rule No. 149 in the General Financial Rules, 2017.

As far as this UT is concerned, presently there are 74 primary users, 726 secondary

4-monthly installments of Rs.2000/- directly into the bank accounts of the farmers. So far, Rs 42.5582 crores has been disbursed till 14<sup>th</sup> installment. Release of 15<sup>th</sup> Installment for the period August to November is expected tentatively in the last week of October and 1<sup>st</sup> week of November, 2023.

State Bio-Control Laboratory

The State Bio-Control Laboratory (SBCL) started functioning at Haddo, Port Blair, for conservation & augmentation of natural enemies already present in the farmers' fields, multiplication of bio-agents in the laboratory and subsequent release in the farmers' fields against their target pests as well as monitoring and surveillance of insect-pests, diseases, weeds and bio-agents situation on major crops are being done.

The Laboratory has produced about 1,086.3 CC egg parasitoid of Trichogramma spp. and 4140 nos. of Tricho Cards have been prepared and 960 nos. of Tricho Cards released in the farmers field.

Training to Farmers and Officials

The main objective of ATMA is capacity building of farmers through Kisan Gosthies/Campaign, Farmers Training, Demonstrations, Kisan Melas, Exposure visit of Farmers, Setting up of Farm Schools and Farmers Award. Under ATMA, Trainings, Demonstrations, Farm Schools & awareness of different stakeholder Departments like Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Fisheries, Forest, Industries are being organized to provide the latest agriculture technologies in thematic areas to increase productivity in Agri. & Allied sector.

Marketing Support to Farmers

Marketing platform for sale of farm produce through Agri-Store- Vatika: The Department of Agriculture has opened a 'Farmers Corner' in the Agri Store 'Vatika' situated besides Sagarika Emporium, Udyog Parisar at Middle Point. Farmers can sell their agricultural commodities especially value added products and spices from Farmers corner by handing over their produce to the in charge of Vatika who in turn sell the produce and deposit the revenue collected in the farmer's bank account online.

Transportation facility to farmers for transport of farm produces from Farm Gate to Market

Under RKVY Scheme -Creation of Marketing Infrastructure-Supply of Transportation Truck, Department of Agriculture is providing 50% subsidy limited to a maximum of Rs 2.5 lakhs for purchase of truck of 1.5 MT to 2.0 MT capacity truck for transportation of agriculture produce from farm to market. Individual farmers/registered SHGs/Coconut Producer Societies/ can avail the scheme. So far, 19 farmers have applied and all have been selected. 5 beneficiaries have purchased truck and submitted the bills.

Providing Minimum Support Price to Farmers Produce

Under Pradhan Mantri Annadata Aay Sanrakshan Abhiyan- (PM-AASHA), Govt. of India provides Minimum Support Price (MSP) for Fair Average Quality Copra. The MSP fixed for milling copra is Rs 10860/-per quintal for 2023 season. The quantity sanctioned for procurement from this Island is 3000 MT Copra. This scheme was discontinued in these Islands and after a gap of 1 decade implementation of copra procurement initiated.

RCS is the implementing Department for Price Support Scheme of Copra. NAFED is the Central Nodal Agency and the three State Level Supporters viz. ANCOFED, EHL and TDCS.

For procurement of copra under PSS, the farmers have to be registered in e-Samridhi portal of NAFED.

Advice to Farmers

- ♦ Farmers are requested to utilize the services of Agriculture Department in increasing the production.
- ♦ Maintenance of soil fertility by frequent application of organic manure/ farm yard manure/compost in the farm fields.
- ♦ Utilize the locally available nutrient sources rather than dependence on chemical fertilizers.
- ♦ The addition of Poultry, Dairy and Fishery for additional income generation and also need for in farm production of organic inputs like Farm Yard Manure, Vermi Compost, Poultry Manure and Pond Silts etc. for cultivation.
- ♦ Soil testing of farming area needs to be done at least once in 3 years in order to obtain the Soil Health Card with proper recommendation.
- ♦ To prevent soil erosion, farmers should abstain from unnecessary cutting of trees, shrubs and focus on planting soil binding grasses, bushes and trees.
- ♦ All the Schemes being implemented by the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, GoI are beneficial for the farming community.
- ♦ Every farmer of this Island should reap the benefit of the schemes.

Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such persons to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

**5- Power to Relax-**

Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

**6- Savings :-**

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation regarding age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

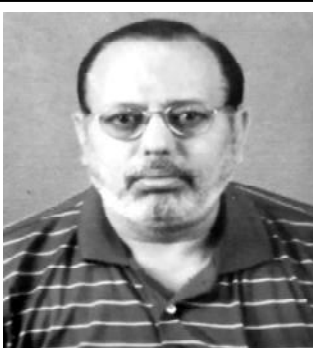
