## Disaster Management Department - safeguarding lives, minimizing damage and aiding recovery during times of crisis

### Citizens urged to cooperate and participate in disaster preparedness & awareness progs. to make A&N Islands more disaster resilient

Port Blair, Oct. 22

The Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration has been established considering the vulnerability profile of A&N Islands towards natural disaster like Earthquake, Tsunami, Cyclones, Floods etc. with a vision 'To build safer and disaster resilient Islands by developing technology driven strategy for disaster management through collective efforts of all Government Agencies and Non-Governmental Agencies'. Listing out the activities of the Directorate of Disaster Management, the Secretary (DM) threw light on Disaster Preparedness and action taken to meet any future exigencies. Excerpts of the interview are as below:

**Interviewer: When was this Department established in A&N Islands?**

**Secretary (DM):** Considering the vulnerability profile of A&N Islands and aftermath of Earthquake and Tsunami of 26<sup>th</sup> December, 2004, the Andaman and Nicobar Administration established a separate Department of Directorate of Disaster Management during 2008-09 for disaster preparedness, response, mitigation, relief & rehabilitation. The Department was entrusted with the implementation of the Disaster Management Action Plan, which includes coordination, policy-making, operations management, data collection, record keeping, information, education and communication activities, public information, preparedness, community based disaster preparedness, training to all levels of the community, establishing of adequate warning systems, apprising the situation from time to time to the Union Territory Disaster Management Authority and to the National Disaster Management Authority.

**Interviewer: Which type of disasters fall under its purview?**

**Secretary (DM):** Before we know the type of disaster, first we must understand what disaster is. Disaster, as defined in the DM Act, 2005, "disaster" means a catastrophe, mishap, calamity or grave occurrence in any area, arising from natural or manmade causes, or by accident or negligence which results in substantial loss of life or human suffering or damage to, and destruction of, property, or damage to, or degradation of, environment, and is of such a nature or magnitude as to be beyond the coping capacity of the community of the affected area. 'Disaster Management' means a continuous and integrated process of planning, organizing, coordinating and implementing measures which are necessary or expedient for-

- ◆ Prevention of danger or threat of any disaster
- ◆ Mitigation or reduction of risk of any disaster or its severity or consequences
- ◆ Capacity-building
- ◆ Preparedness to deal with any disaster
- ◆ Prompt response to any threatening disaster situation or disaster
- ◆ Assessing the severity or magnitude of effects of any disaster
- ◆ Evacuation, rescue and relief
- ◆ Rehabilitation and reconstruction

**Types of Disasters:**

As we aware that the Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to Geological and Hydro-meteorological disasters and located in one of the most seismically active parts of the world. These Islands are mostly susceptible to very high intensity of seismicity and as per the seismic zoning map of India contained in IS 1893 - 1984, these Islands are classified in Seismic Zone-V. These Islands fall in Cyclogenesis Zone and significant number of cyclones striking the east coast of India and Bangladesh are generated every year in the Andaman Sea.

**Interviewer: What are the Do's and Don'ts during different types of Disasters?**

**Secretary (DM):** The Department has prepared Do's and Don'ts for all types of hazards/disasters (Earthquake, Tsunami, Cyclone, Fire, Flood, Lightning, Monsoon preparedness etc.) which are regularly published in electronic and print media for awareness of general public. Further, the Department has also printed posters, banners, pamphlets, booklets, flyers etc. and distributed to all Departments, Schools, PRIs and community to create awareness towards their preparedness to respond any crisis/disaster.

**Interviewer: What is the role of media during disaster?**

**Secretary (DM):** Media plays a crucial role during disasters, serving as a reliable and effective communication tool. Some key roles that radio fulfills during disaster situations are as under:

- Emergency Alerts and Warnings: Media publish & broadcasts emergency alerts and warnings to the affected population. It can quickly disseminate critical information about impending disasters, evacuation orders, shelter locations, and safety instructions. Also provides real-time updates, allowing people to take necessary actions to protect themselves and their communities.
- Communication and Coordination: During disasters, other communication systems like mobile networks may become unreliable or overloaded. It enables effective communication among different response teams, allowing them to share information, request assistance, and coordinate rescue and relief operations.
- Public Information: Media publish & broadcast important information related to disaster preparedness, response, and recovery. They provide updates on weather conditions, road closures, power outages, available services, and distribution centers for food, water, and medical

supplies.

Overall, Press & Media's role during disasters encompasses alerting, informing, coordinating, and supporting the affected population and emergency response efforts. Its wide coverage, accessibility, and reliability make it a valuable medium for communication when other channels may be disrupted or unavailable.

**Interviewer: What is the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) during a disaster?**

**Secretary (DM):** Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) during a disaster can vary depending on the type and severity of the situation. General guidelines that are commonly followed:

- Activate the Emergency Response Plan (ERP): Every organization should have an ERP in place, outlining the roles, responsibilities, and communication channels during a disaster. The first step is to activate this plan and notify all relevant personnel.
- Establish Command and Control: Designate an Incident Commander or a Central Authority responsible for managing the response efforts. This person will coordinate activities, allocate resources, and make critical decisions.
- Assess the Situation: Gather information about the disaster, its impact, and the affected areas. Conduct an initial damage assessment and prioritize response efforts based on the severity of the situation.
- Ensure Safety: The safety of personnel and affected individuals is paramount. Evacuate people from immediate danger and establish

safety perimeters. Provide necessary protective equipment to responders as required.

- Activate Emergency Communication: Establish clear and effective communication channels within the organization and with external agencies, such as emergency services, Government authorities, and other relevant stakeholders. Maintain regular updates and disseminate critical information to all involved parties.

- Mobilize Resources: Identify and allocate necessary resources such as personnel, equipment, supplies, and transportation to support the response efforts. Coordinate resource requests and logistics to ensure efficient utilization.

- Conduct Search and Rescue: If necessary, initiate search and rescue operations to locate and assist individuals who may be trapped or in need of immediate help. Follow established protocols and collaborate with specialized teams if available.

- Provide Medical Assistance: Establish medical triage areas to assess and treat injured individuals. Coordinate with medical personnel and facilities to ensure proper care and transportation of patients.

- Coordinate Shelter and Relief Efforts: Set up temporary shelters for displaced individuals, ensuring basic needs such as food, water, and sanitation facilities are provided. Coordinate with relief organizations and volunteers to manage the distribution of supplies.

- Support Restoration and Recovery: Once the immediate response is underway, focus on restoring critical infrastructure, services, and normalcy. Collaborate with relevant authorities, utilities, and agencies to expedite the recovery process.

- Document and Evaluate: Maintain detailed records of activities, resources used, and lessons learned during the disaster response. Conduct debriefings and evaluations to identify areas for improvement and update the ERP accordingly.

These are general guidelines, and specific SOPs may vary depending on the organization, industry, and type of disaster. It is crucial to tailor the SOPs to the unique needs and circumstances of each situation and regularly review and update them based on lessons learned from previous incidents.

**Interviewer: Can disaster be predicted?**

**Secretary (DM):** While it is not possible to predict disasters with complete accuracy, some types of

The initiative is a step forward in community engagement, safety, and information sharing. In an era where communication and information-sharing are paramount, the A&N Police is adapting to evolving times by establishing a more direct, reliable, and private connection with the community. This innovative WhatsApp Channel, accessible through a dedicated tab called 'Updates', in Whatapp Application is set to serve as a dynamic platform for the Department to communicate with the public.

The primary objectives of the



**A&N Police WhatsApp Channel are:**

- ◆ **Direct and Private Communication:** To provide a secure and private platform for the Department to communicate important updates, alerts, and safety information directly to the public.
- ◆ **Community Safety:** To

ensure that timely and relevant information is readily available to the public, improving community safety and well-being.

- ◆ **Privacy and Security:** To uphold the privacy of users by not disclosing personal information like phone numbers and profile photos to followers.

- ◆ **Accessibility:** To store channel history for up to 30 days, allowing users to access critical updates and information even if they miss them initially.

- ◆ **Engagement and Participation:** To encourage community engagement by offering diverse content types, including text messages, photos, videos, stickers and polls.

- ◆ **Community Empowerment:** To empower the community with the

disasters can be forecasted or predicted to some extent. Here are a few examples:

- Weather-related Disasters: Meteorological agencies use advanced technologies and models to predict severe weather events such as hurricanes, tornadoes, cyclones, blizzards, and heavy rainfall. These predictions are based on historical data, satellite imagery, weather patterns, and mathematical models. While the accuracy of these predictions has improved over the years, there is still some degree of uncertainty involved.
- Geological Disasters: Certain geological events, such as earthquakes and volcanic eruptions, can be forecasted to some extent. Scientists monitor seismic activity, ground deformation, gas emissions, and other indicators to assess the likelihood of such events occurring. However, the timing and exact magnitude of these events remain challenging to predict accurately.
- Disease Outbreaks: Epidemiologists and public health agencies closely monitor disease trends and patterns to detect and predict disease outbreaks. By analyzing data on infection rates, population movements, and other factors, they can make accurate predictions about the spread of diseases such as influenza, Ebola, or COVID-19. However, predicting the exact scale and impact of an outbreak can be challenging due to various factors, including human behavior and interventions.
- Technological Disasters: Some types of technological disasters, such as chemical spills or industrial accidents, can be predicted to a certain extent by monitoring and inspecting infrastructure, implementing safety protocols, and conducting risk assessments. However, unforeseen circumstances or human errors can still lead to accidents.

It's important to note that even when predictions are made, there is always some level of uncertainty involved. Disasters can be influenced by various complex factors, and unexpected events can occur. Therefore, preparedness and response planning are crucial, even in cases where predictions or forecasts are available.

**Interviewer: As this is disaster prone zone, how should an individual prepare himself to face it?**  
**Secretary (DM):** Individuals may face a wide range of problems during a disaster, depending on the type and severity of the event like physical harm or injury, displacement, loss of relatives, trauma, communication problems, access to basic needs etc. A Disaster Management (DM) kit can be helpful during a disaster in several ways. These kits typically contain a variety of items that can help individuals to manage some of the issues they may face during a disaster. DM kit may contain first aid supplies to treat injuries, food and water to sustain individuals until help arrives, and emergency communication devices to help individuals stay in touch with loved ones or emergency services.

Additionally, DM kits may contain items such as flashlights, sleeping bag, and blankets to help individuals stay warm and safe during a disaster. These kits can provide individuals with a sense of security and preparedness, allowing them to focus on their own safety and the safety of their loved ones during a disaster. Disaster management kits can be very helpful during the times of disaster.

Disaster management kits contain essential supplies such as food, water, first-aid kits, and other items that can be difficult to access during a disaster. Having these items readily available can help individuals and families meet their immediate needs during and after a disaster.

The Directorate of Disaster Management regularly create awareness in its programme for community, schools, colleges and other organizations to prepare DM survival Kits and keep in accessible place to carry the same at the time of evacuation.

**Interviewer: How many relief shelters are there in all the three Districts and how can one reach these shelters during disaster?**  
**Secretary (DM):** As per A&N Disaster Management Plan - 2016, 175 Relief Shelters/camps have been identified which are mostly in Govt. Buildings i.e. Schools, Office Buildings etc. in different Islands of ANI which are accessible to general masses to take shelter during emergencies. This Department is in process to keep adequate relief items in all identified shelters to cater to any emergency.

**Interviewer: Can you elaborate on the mock drills being conducted in Isles and its usefulness during disaster?**  
**Secretary (DM):** Mock exercises are used world over to test the Disaster Management Plans, check response time, and assess the preparedness level and inter-departmental coordination to bring out the shortcomings. The purpose of the Mock Exercise is to check the level of Preparedness and Awareness on specific Disasters. Sound preparedness and effective response of the various stakeholders to the disaster is the key to success of the Mock Exercise. **The objectives of the Mock Exercise are as follows:-**

- To review the Disaster Management Plan
- To rehearse the emergency response plans of

various stakeholders

- Practice SOPs of the concerned functionaries
- Practice coordination among various Departments and promote public/private partnership, wherever feasible
- Identify gaps in participating organizations in manpower, equipment, materials & systems.

The Directorate of Disaster Management regularly conducts mock drills on varied types of disasters such as earthquake, tsunami, fire, cyclone, boat capsize, air accidents etc. at UT, District, Island and community level. For this year, calendar of Mock Drills has been finalized to conduct at Island, District and UT level. At present, Mock Drills conducted at Baratang, Rangat and Diglipur and remaining drills will be conducted in this financial year by the respective Islands/Sub-Division/Districts. In addition to the above, the Directorate of Disaster Management regularly conducts mock drills in Schools/ Institutions/Department as per their requisitions.

**Interviewer: Is there any early warning and communication system in place in the Islands?**  
**Secretary (DM):** Yes, there is an early warning and communication system in place in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The Government and A&N Administration, in collaboration with various agencies, has implemented several measures to enhance early warning and communication capabilities for disaster management in the region. One key system is the Tsunami Warning System, which includes a network of seismometers and tide gauges to detect seismic activity and changes in sea level. In the event of an earthquake or tsunami threat, the system quickly relays alerts to the concerned authorities and coastal communities, enabling them to take necessary precautions and initiate evacuation procedures.

Additionally, the Andaman and Nicobar Islands have established an Integrated Communication Network for Disaster Management. This network comprises various modes of communications that includes Satellite Phones, Tsunami Sirens, Electronic Display Board, E-SMS burst System, CAP SACHET (SMS system) to ensure reliable and timely dissemination of warnings and information during emergencies.

The work of supply, installation, testing & commissioning of Tsunami Early Warning Siren System in Andaman & Nicobar Islands is being carried out by BSNL, Port Blair in all GPS Observatories (35 Nos.) of INCOIS installed at various locations in A&N Islands. The Tsunami Early Warning Siren is to be set up in the model sites of Tehsil Office, Ferrargunj and DC Office, South Andaman and also setting up of Server Stations at State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC) (Server Station I), Port Blair and District EOC (Sever Station 2), South Andaman to disseminate alerts and warnings to the public for taking precautionary measures which may led to any big untoward incidents at any point of time.

These measures aim to enhance preparedness, early warning, and communication capabilities in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, enabling authorities and communities to respond effectively to potential disasters and minimize the impact on lives and infrastructure.

**Interviewer: What are the facilities available at Emergency Operation Centres (EOC)?**  
**Secretary(DM):** A&N Administration established State Emergency Operation Centre with State-of-Art Communication facilities for 24x7 functioning for monitoring, observing, analyzing, observing the website of INCOIS, NCS, IMD, USGS and European Mediterranean for receiving alerts, warnings, advisories and disseminating hazardous situation information to UTDMA, UTDMEC, DDMA and to all the Stakeholders and QRTs/Task Teams of Line Departments for response to combat natural, manmade disasters and mitigate its catastrophe affects. Facilities of SEOC & EOCs are: -

- ◆ STD/ISD/FAX with Broad Band facility
- ◆ Linked up VHF System with Police, PMB, Electricity, Forest, NDRF & DSS
- ◆ iSAT phone.
- ◆ Link up Video Conferencing with MHA and 6 EOCs
- ◆ DMS Server linked with MHA
- ◆ VOIP link with 41 Stations (DM) of 18 States of mainland
- ◆ Lease line linked with Development Communication Network (DCN) (Vidyavahini and Telemedicine)
- ◆ 10 Hotline with INCOIS, ANC and 6 EOCs
- ◆ C-DAC (Centre of Development of Advance Computing) System installed for SMS Burst
- ◆ (EDBs) Electronic Display Board for regular info of weather, tidal current, waves and other info of EQ to be installed
- ◆ Accessible through Toll Free Helpline No.1070 (District EOCs-1077)
- ◆ Operation of Bilingual PA Sys, Sirens and GPS Observatories for seismic data.
- ◆ CAP SACHET (SMS system) etc.

**Interviewer: Which are the Line Departments involved in disaster management process? Is Media part of it?**  
**Secretary (DM):** All line Departments of A&N Administration are involved in disaster management process for managing disasters in

ANI mainly Police, Fire, A&N Command, NDRF, Health, Forest, APWD, Civil Supplies, Shipping, Transport, Tourism, Civil Aviation, RD&PRIs, Tribal Welfare, Social Welfare, Education etc. Media is important part of Disaster Management by providing timely and accurate information before, during and after a disaster, issuance of early warning, public awareness and education, coordinating relief efforts, etc.

**Interviewer: Can you elaborate the role of Incident Response System during disaster?**  
**Secretary (DM):** The Incident Response System (IRS) is an effective mechanism for reducing ad-hoc measures in response. It envisages a composite team with various Sections to attend to all the possible response requirements. The IRS designates officers to perform various duties and get them trained in their respective roles. It also emphasizes the need for proper documentation of various activities for better planning, accountability and analysis. This will greatly help in reducing chaos and confusion during the response phase. Everyone will know what needs to be done, who will do it and who is in command. In line with the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), IRS guidelines and DM Act, 2005, the A&N Administration has notified Incident Response Teams at UT, District, Sub-Divisions & Island level with their pre designated roles & responsibilities to respond disaster at their level if occurred in A&N Islands. Training Workshops conducted for Incident Response Teams in coordination with NDMA & NIDM to enhance the capacities of each designated officers/officials under IRS of this UT to respond their entrusted functions at the time of eventualities/ disaster very efficiently, dedicatedly and in a well-coordinated manner.

**Interviewer: What is being done to create awareness among the common people and especially children about disaster preparedness?**  
**Secretary (DM):** Capacity building is an ongoing process that equips officials, stakeholders and the community to perform their functions in a better manner during a crisis/disaster. In the process of capacity building, we must include elements of human resource development i.e. individual training, organizational development such as improving the functioning of groups and organizations and institutional development.

To create awareness and capacity building among the common people and especially children about disaster preparedness, the Directorate of Disaster Management is regularly organizing trainings, workshops, awareness programmes, mock drills etc. for creating disaster awareness and preparedness in the institutions and community. At present, the centrally sponsored Up-scaling of Aapda Mitra Scheme is being implemented in this UT. Under this scheme, 289 Aapda Mitra volunteers of three districts have been trained to respond and support to district Administration to strengthen the disaster

preparedness in the District.

**Interviewer: What would you like to say to about your Department and its role during each disaster?**  
**Secretary (DM):** The Disaster Management Department plays a crucial role in mitigating the impact of disasters and ensuring the safety and well-being of communities. Here are some key points:

- The Department is responsible for developing disaster management plans, policies, strategies, conduct risk assessments, identify vulnerable areas, and create emergency response plans to address different types of disasters.
- The Department maintains and upgrades Early Warning Systems to detect and monitor potential disasters. These systems help in issuing timely alerts and advisories to the public, enabling them to take necessary precautions and evacuate if required.
- The Department coordinates and mobilizes resources to respond effectively. They work closely with other agencies, such as emergency services, law enforcement, healthcare providers, and the defence, to ensure a coordinated and efficient response to the situation.
- The Department conduct and manages search and rescue operations to locate and save individuals who may be trapped or in immediate danger during a disaster. This includes deploying specialized teams and equipment to carry out rescue operations.
- The Disaster Management Department promotes public awareness and educate on disaster preparedness, response, and mitigation. Conduct training programs, workshops, and awareness campaigns to empower individuals and communities to better understand and respond to potential disasters.
- Apart from responding to disasters, the Department focuses on risk reduction and mitigation measures towards minimizing the impact of future disasters through measures such as implementing building codes, promoting sustainable land use practices, and conducting awareness campaigns on climate change adaptation.
- It is important to recognize the invaluable role of the Disaster Management Department in safeguarding lives, minimizing damage, and aiding recovery during times of crisis. These efforts require collaboration with other stakeholders, including Government agencies, Non-Governmental Organizations, and community members, to ensure a comprehensive and effective response to disasters.
- In addition to above, the Secretary (DM) has requested all residents of this territory to extend their cooperation and to participate in various programmes being organized by the Directorate of Disaster Management on capacity building, awareness, training, mock drills etc. to make this vulnerable Islands more disaster resilient.
