Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation addresses 'National Symposium on Cooperative Exports' organized by NCEL

At least 50% of export profits will go to farmers through National Cooperative Export Limited Tehsils across the country should become the voice of farmers by joining NCEL

New Delhi, Oct. 23 (PIB) Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah addressed the 'National Symposium on Cooperative Exports' organized by the National Cooperative Exports Limited (NCEL) in New Delhi today. Shri Shah also released the logo, website and brochure of NCEL and distributed membership certificates to NCEL members.

In his address, Shri Amit Shah said that today the National Cooperative Export Limited is being formally launched on the auspicious day of Mahanavami. He said that today we are crossing a very important milestone on the way to realize the vision of Sahkarita Se Samridhhi, for which the Ministry of



Cooperation was established for the first time since independence by Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi. He said that National Cooperative Export Limited (NCEL) was established after much deliberation with various objectives in mind. He said that our goals behind setting up NCEL include increasing exports, especially agricultural exports, making farmers prosperous, changing crop patterns and enabling 2 crore farmers of the country to declare their land as natural by 2027. Shri Shah said that Prime Minister, Shri Modi has taken many initiatives to promote natural farming in the country. He said that Modi ji has formed a multistate cooperative society which will sell the organic products of more than 2 crore farmers of India practicing natural farming in the global market with a good packaging, reliable branding and high-quality certificates. With this, farmers will directly get about one and a half to two times the price of their organic

products compared to what they are currently getting and this will open the way to prosperity for the farmers.

Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation said that a Biofuel Alliance has been announced by Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi. He said that India is the only country where 4 crops can be grown simultaneously and if even one of these crops can be used for biofuel, then we can meet India's biofuel needs and export it as well. Shri Shah said that another objective of setting up NCEL is to strengthen cooperatives sector in the country including rural areas and population dependent on agriculture. He said that agricultural products and products from the rural areas contribute 15 percent

Atal Pension Yojana: A boon for unorganized sector

16749 persons enrolled under the pension scheme in A&N Islands so far

Port Blair, Oct. 23

The Atal Pension Yojana (APY) is a pension scheme for the workers in the unorganized sector. As per the scheme, people can make contributions in their Atal Pension Yojana account till the age of 60 years and get a monthly pension. The APY focuses on all citizens in the unorganized sector,

who join the National Pension System (NPS) administered by the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA). As per the data provided by Lead Bank, Port Blair, altogether, 16749 persons have been enrolled under the universal social security scheme 'Atal Pension Yojana' in A&N Islands as on

Sept, 2023.

Under APY, the subscribers would receive fixed minimum pension of Rs. 1000 per month, Rs. 2000 per month, Rs. 3000 per month, Rs. 4000 per month, Rs. 5000 per month, at the age of 60 years, depending on their contributions, which itself would be based on the age of joining the APY. The minimum age of joining APY is 18

years and maximum age is 40 years. The age of exit and start of pension would be 60 years. Therefore, minimum period of contribution by any subscriber under APY would be 20 years or more. The benefit of fixed minimum pension would be guaranteed by the Government.

APY is open to all bank account holders with auto

> Installation of Online Continuous Emission Monitoring

System (OCEMS) by Health Care Facilities having captive treatment facilities-incinerators and transmission of real time data to CPCB server.

> Existing deep burials pits should be authorized as per BMW Rules, 2016

Police arrests fraudster for duping people with cheap flight tickets

The A&N Police has solved a case based on a written complaint by N. Jagadeka Varma, President of Andaman and Nicobar MUAYTHAI wherein he mentioned that he along with 15 children wanted to proceed to Chennai for National Games and made payment of Rs. 1,13,000/- for roundtrip to Mohd. Shafique in the month of February 2023, and was duped by Shafique who promised to give him tickets but neither did he give the tickets nor refunded the money. Informing about the case, the SP,



District South Andaman, Shri Kalaivanan R, IPS while interacting with the media persons in the conference hall of the SP Office here stated that the case was investigated and the accused has been arrested.

Giving details of the arrest, he said, based on the complaint, a case was registered at PS

A&N Police arrests one person involved in burglary case; stolen jewellery recovered

Port Blair, Oct. 23

The A&N Police has succeeded in solving a burglary case showing professionalism resulting in the arrest of the accused person involved in the crime, informed the SP, District South Andaman, Shri Kalaivanan R, IPS while interacting with the media persons in the conference hall of the SP Office here.

Giving details of the case and the subsequent arrest of the person involved in the crime, the SP said that a burglary was reported and a case was registered at PS Ograbraj regarding theft of gold ornaments weighing around 35.5 grams from a house at Badmash Pahad, Chouldari on 21.06.2023. He further stated that the case was entrusted to HC Bijoy Sarkar, PS Ograbraj. After collecting evidences, the suspect was zeroed but was found to be absconding. During investigation, efforts were made to trace the accused person by forming different teams. As a result of the physical and technical intelligence, the Police team was able to apprehend Sanjay Kumar Das, S/o Shri Dhiren Das, 38 yrs from Subash Gram, Diglipur.

The Police team comprising HC Bijoy Sarkar, Investigation Officer, PC Rakesh Narayan, PC Biplob Das, PC Agassi Clinton, PC M Mohammed Arif was formed under the command of the SI Devanand Pathak, SHO, PS Ograbraj, whose

efforts led to tracing out the accused, the SP added. On sustained interrogation the accused disclosed the whereabouts of the stolen gold ornaments which were deposited at various financial entities, Jewellery Shops etc. Some of the gold ornaments were recovered from a financial entity in Junglighat area and a Jewellery shop at Bhastubasti and rest of the gold ornaments were recovered from Subashgram, Madhupur with the assistance of Insp K Binoj, SHO PS Diglipur, PC Akash Ch. Bepari, PS Diglipur, PC K.P Pandey, PS Diglipur, PC Radheshyam Hawlader, PS Diglipur, LPC Anjana Paul, PS Diglipur and PC(D) Mrityunjay Das, PS Diglipur under the supervision of Shri Brij Mohan Meena, SDPO Diglipur.

All the stolen gold ornaments amounting to Rs. 2,27,500/- approximately has been recovered. Further, the case has been charge sheeted. The SP handed over all the recovered gold ornaments to the owner during the press conference. The recovery of stolen property in the case has been made due to the efforts made by the team under the overall supervision of Shri Arshdeep Singh Panwar, SDPO (Bambooflat). The SP also requested the general public, finance companies and jewellery shop owners not to accept any gold ornaments for mortgage without proper verification of bills.

groups namely "Daily E Updates, Vacancy and land Ad Groups, Local information and News, Daily to Daily News, Port Blair Local News " from his Mobile No. 9064528250 which was used by fraudster to post cheapest flight ticket rates on daily basis.

The SP stated that whenever he used to post flight fares from Chennai/ Kolkata to Port Blair or Port Blair to Chennai/ Kolkata in the range of Rs. 4500/- to Rs. 5500/-, this message got circulated in other WhatsApp group, the people of this Island used to contact him for tickets and the Fraudster took money and never gave them tickets. He only uses the above number only for Whatsapp calls and not for normal calls.

During the course of investigation, various IPDRs related to his WhatsApp Account were obtained and it was found that fraudster had been moving in different locations in mainland. In the month of October 2023, another NCRP complaint related to fake flight tickets was received involving another mobile number 9888443876 belonged to Shafique with continuous monitoring of LBS, accurate location of Mohd. Shafique was found to be at Chhehartha, Amritsar, Punjab. Upon this, a team comprising of IO SI PK Shivhare and HC Nirmal Kumar from PS Pahargaoon left for Punjab on 14/10/2023. After tracing out Mohd. Shafique on 15/10/2023, the team arrested him from Chhehartha, Amritsar. He was brought to Port Blair on 18/10/2023 on transit remand. Presently, the accused is in judicial custody in Prothrapur Jail. The SP said, if any person has been cheated by fraudster Mohd. Shafique, they can approach the nearest Police Station for legal action.

to the country's GDP while 60 percent of the total population is dependent on them. No country can strengthen its economy by ignoring 60 percent of its population and an economy which does not have a place for 60 percent of the country's population can never be successful. Shri Shah said that the Modi Government strives to increase the GDP while ensuring prosperity for these 60 percent people by providing them employment and the only way to do this is to strengthen cooperative sector. He said that National Cooperative Export Limited will also work to strengthen the entire cooperative structure in the country.

Shri Amit Shah said that NCEL is launched in the cooperative sector with 6 objectives of increasing exports, prospering the farmer, changing the crop pattern, providing global market for organic products, gaining a place for India in the global market for biofuel and strengthening the cooperative sector. With this new beginning, the cooperative will act as a link between the farmers and the global demand for milk products, Isabgol (Psyllium), cumin, ethanol and a variety of organic products. He said that till now about 1500 cooperatives have become members of NCEL and it is expected that in the coming days every tehsil will join it and become the voice of the farmers. Till now NCEL has received orders worth Rs 7,000 crore and orders worth Rs 15,000 crore are being negotiated. The Minister of Cooperation expressed confidence that in the coming days, like IFFCO, KRIBHCO and Amul, National Cooperative Export Limited will also prove to be a very big and successful cooperative venture.

Shri Shah said that National Cooperative Export Limited will provide necessary finance and information to small societies, will provide information about the intricacies involved and necessary precautions required while exporting, and will also work for the production of export friendly materials. Apart from this, NCEL will also do work like setting parameters for brand awareness, quality awareness, necessary infrastructure and standardization of the product for small farmers at a nominal fee. Shri Amit Shah said that today the profits from exports do not reach the farmers, but through National Cooperative Export Limited at least 50% of the export profits will go directly to the farmers. He said that procurement will be done from the farmer at the Minimum Support Price (MSP) and then after the balance sheet of 6 months is prepared, 50 percent of the profit in addition to the payment made as per MSP, will go directly to the bank account of the farmer.

and designed in line with standards prescribed under Sr. No. 5 Schedule-II of BMWM Rules, 2016.

> The standards for liquid waste prescribed under Biomedical Waste Management Rules 2016 and its amendments to be compiled by Health Care Facilities:

a) The limits mentioned under Schedule II of Bio-medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 are applicable to the occupiers of Health Care Facilities (bedded) which are either connected with sewerage network without terminal sewage treatment plant or not connected to public sewers:

HCFs required to comply with limits under Schedule II at S.No.08 (CPCB guidelines for Management of Healthcare Waste as per BMWM Rules, 2016 may be referred).

b) For discharge into public sewers with terminal facilities, the general standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) shall be applicable: HCFs required to comply with general discharge standards for public sewers.

c) HCFs having less than ten beds shall comply with the output discharge standards for liquid waste as mentioned under Schedule II at S.No.8.

d) Non-bedded occupiers shall dispose infectious liquid wastes only after treatment by disinfection as per Schedule-II (6) of the principal rules (CPCB guidelines may be referred).

All the Health Care Facilities in Andaman and Nicobar Islands have therefore been requested to ensure strict compliance of the stipulated conditions under BMWM Rules, 2016. PS Diglipur seizes Methamphetamine drugs under NDPS Act

Diglipur, Oct. 23

To weed out the menace of illicit Methamphetamine drugs at North & Middle Andaman District, PS Diglipur proved their mettle once again by going tough against the drug peddlers. On the basis of credible information received at PS Diglipur on Oct. 22, 2023, a raiding team led by Insp. K. Later, a suspect person was stopped by the team and a search was conducted. During search, 1 transparent polythene sachet containing crystalline powder and shiny glass like form of material was

debit facility to accounts, leading to reduction in contribution collection charges. The subscribers should keep the required balance in their savings bank accounts on the stipulated due dates to avoid any late payment penalty. Due dates for monthly contribution payment is arrived based on the deposit of first contribution amount. In case of repeated defaults for specified period, the account is liable for foreclosure and the GoI co-contributions, if any shall be forfeited. Also any false declaration about his/her eligibility for benefits under this scheme for whatsoever reason, the entire Govt. contribution shall be forfeited along with the penal interest.

For enrolment, Aadhaar would be the primary KYC document for identification of beneficiaries, spouse and nominees to avoid pension rights and entitlement related disputes in the long-term.

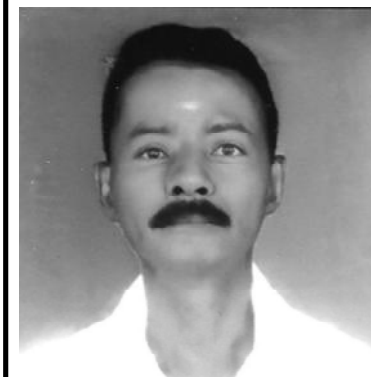

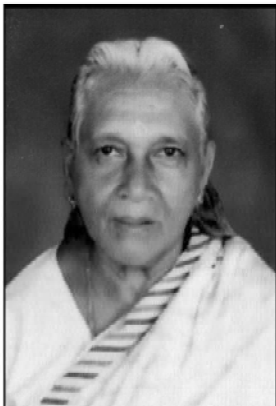
