The Government of India has envisaged and launched a campaign 'Meri Maati Mera Desh' (MMD) across the country as a finale programme of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav'. In this regard, a State Level send off programme of Amrit Kalash Yatra under 'Meri Maati Mera Desh' campaign was organized in the Auditorium of Tagore Government College of Education (TGCE), Middle Point today. Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency was the chief guest on the occasion. The Chief Secretary (I/C), Shri Nikhil Kumar, IAS, PCCF, Shri T S Ashok Kumar, IFS, Adhyaksh, ZPSA, Shri Sanjay Kumar Singh, senior Officers of A&N Administration were present on the occasion.

Addressing the gathering, the Lt. Governor said that 'Amrit Kalash Yatra' under 'Meri Maati Mera Desh' campaign is a unique initiative, in which, soil collected in 'Amrit Kalash' from every corner of the country from Villages, Blocks, Towns, Cities will be taken to New Delhi and an 'Amrit Vatika' will be built in National Capital in New Delhi with soil and plants from different parts of the country. The Lt. Governor further stated that the soil collected from these Islands has a special significance as our Islands are deeply connected with the freedom struggle of India's Independence. The Lt. Governor remarked that freedom fighters of the First War of Indian Independence- 1857 were brought to these Islands and the National Memorial Cellular Jail is the mute witness to the sufferings meted out to the freedom fighters during their imprisonment in the Cellular Jail.

The Lt. Governor stated that even after our Country got Independence in the year 1947 and to keep our hard earned independence intact, many people made

supreme sacrifices during wars. The Lt. Governor stated that to honour the sacrifices of the brave men, the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has named 21 Islands of A&N Islands in the name of the great heroes decorated with 'Param Vir Chakra'. The 'Amrit Kalash' which will be taken to New Delhi by the representatives from different blocks of A&N Islands contains soil collected from the 21 Islands too, which are named in honour of 'Param Vir Chakra' awardees.

While conveying his best wishes to the representatives who will be taking the 'Amrit Kalash' to New Delhi, the Lt. Governor urged them to convey the message about the importance of the soil from A&N Islands due to its deep association with the freedom struggle history of India's Independence. He congratulated the Departments associated with this campaign for efficiently conducting series of activities under 'Meri Maati Mera Desh' Campaign in A&N Islands.

Draft Electoral Roll published; claims & objections can be filed upto Dec. 9, 2023

A meeting was held under the chairmanship of Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands, Shri B S Jaglan, IAS, in the Mini Conference Hall of Secretariat today with all the recognized Political Parties and media persons in publication of Draft Electoral Rolls-2024.

related Officers were also present during the meeting.

Addressing the meeting, the CEO said, the role of Political Party representatives is vital in Special Summary Revision of Electoral Roll-2024. He also urged the representatives of Political Parties to appoint Booth Level Agents (BLAs) who would be associated with Booth Level Officers (BLOs) during the revision period and also help in identifying any missed out eligible voters, change in residential address of voters, updation of voter's details besides encouraging eligible citizens who is going to attain the age of eighteen years on any of the subsequent qualifying dates i.e 1st April, 2024, 1st July, 2024 & 1st October, 2024 to file for inclusion of names in the electoral rolls for purification of Electoral Roll. The Draft Electoral Roll 2024 was also shared with the Political Parties present in the meeting.

Informing about the schedule of Special Summary Revision-2024, the CEO said, Draft Electoral Roll has been published today (Oct.27,2023) and the period for filing claims and objections is from Oct. 27 to Dec. 9, 2023 while disposal of claims and objections will be done by Dec.26,2023. The checking of health parameters and obtaining the Commission's permission for final publication and updating database and printing of supplements is Jan. 1, 2024 and the final publication of Electoral Roll is on Jan.5, 2024. He further informed that as perthe Draft Electoral Roll, 2024, there are 307355 electors, out of which, 160606 are male electors, 146746 are female electors and 3 are third gender. Out of which, 1770 are young electors from the age of 18 to 19 years and 412 Polling Stations located in 346 locations.

The CEO directed to work on having healthy electoral roll as the Special Summary Revision - 2024 is very important, for parliamentary election - 2024.

The Political Parties also put forth their suggestions and their doubts were cleared during the meeting.

Further, All Fair Price Shop dealers have been requested to make wide publicity among their respective Ration Card holders and get their e-KYC done latest by 30th November, 2023. FPS dealers have been strictly directed not to deny any members of the Ration

Card holders from doing their e-KYC. Any problem related to e-KYC, if faced by any FPS dealers should be reported to the Department without any delay. Denial for e-KYC shall be viewed seriously. Bambooflat Police busted narcotics supply with seizure of 3.81 kgs ganja; two persons arrested

Adopting zero tolerance policy of A&N Police on Oct. 23, 2023, acting on credible information, the Bambooflat Police Station team headed by Shri Arshdeep Singh Panwar, SDPO, Bambooflat intercepted one person namely Zakir Hussain for carrying illicit ganja, behind village road of Surya Chakra Power House, Bambooflat and recovered 20 Grams of Illicit Ganja from his possession.

Accordingly, a case was registered at PS Bambooflat against Zakir Hussain Mondal @ Bappi, S/o Late Rajak Mondal, (29) yrs., R/o Rented House, Shore Point under NDPS Act. During interrogation, the accused revealed that he bought the ganja from one Hasanur Mondal, Mungfali Vendor, R/o Mohanpura. Upon which, the team rushed to Mohanpura and apprehended the suspected person Hasanur Mondal and on checking his house, 3.790 KGs of illicit ganja wrapped in nine different packets were found inside a trolley bag. On further checking of his house, cash of Rs. 64,975/- along with an electronic weighing machine was also found from his possession. 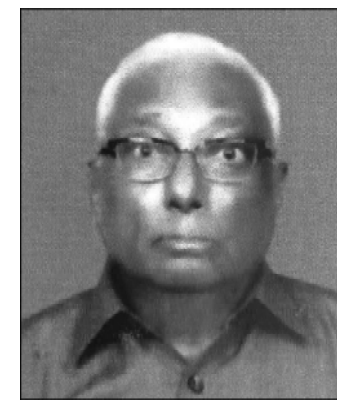

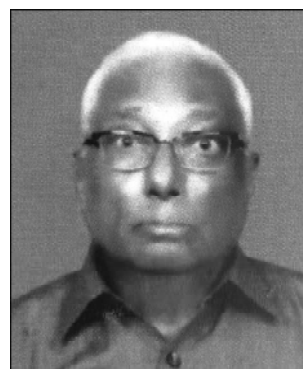
