PM addresses National Rozgar Mela

Distributes more than 51,000 Appointment Letters to newly inducted recruits in various Government Departments and Organizations

New Delhi, Oct. 28 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed the National Rozgar Mela via video conferencing today and distributed more than 51,000 Appointment Letters to newly inducted recruits in various Government Departments and Organizations. The recruits, selected from across the country will be joining the Government in various Ministries/ Departments including Ministry of Railways, Department of Posts, Ministry of Home Affairs, Department of Revenue, Department of Higher Education, Department of School Education and Literacy and Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, among others. 37 places across the country were connected with the Mela during the Prime Minister's address.

Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister noted that the journey of Razgar Melas has reached an important milestone as Rozgar Melas started in October last year providing Appointment Letters for Government jobs to lakhs of youths in various Rozgar Melas in the Center and NDA-ruled States and Union Territories. Today also, more than 50,000 youths have



been given Government jobs. The Prime Minister congratulated the appointees and their families.

The Prime Minister underlined that the Rozgar Melas organized in various States and Union Territories are signs of the Government's commitment towards the future of the youth where work is underway in mission mode. "We're not only providing employment but also maintaining a transparent system in place", Shri Modi emphasized as he noted the increased trust by the youth in the

recruitment processes. He said that the Government is making an effort to not only streamline the processes but also restructure the examination procedure. He underlined that the time taken for recruitment under the staff selection cycle has also been reduced to half. "The overall time between the notification of employment to the employment letter has been significantly reduced", Shri Modi explained. Speaking about certain examinations under SSC, Prime Minister, Shri Modi informed that the exams are now being conducted in 13 different regional languages apart from Hindi and English making it easier for those aspirants to break the language barrier.

Referring to the speed of development that is creating newer job opportunities in every sector. He mentioned Dhordo village has been awarded the best tourism village by the United Nations, and World Heritage site recognition for the Hoysala temple complex and Shanti Niketan. These developments and increased tourism will create new opportunities for the youth. Similarly, strides in the sports are also

The Health Care Facilities in Andaman & Nicobar Islands have been urged to ensure strict compliance of Biomedical Waste Management Rule, 2016. Under schedule-II of Biomedical Waste Management Rules, 2016 as amended thereof, all the Government and Private Healthcare facilities

need to ensure the implementation of Rules as well as the strict compliance with respect to the following points:

- ♦ Installation of Online Continuous Emission Monitoring System (OCEMS) by Health Care facilities having captive treatment facilities-incinerators and transmission of real time data to CPCB server.

Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana- platform for channeling social security schemes

62800 accounts opened under PMJDY in Isles

Port Blair, Oct. 28

Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) has provided a platform for channeling all the social security schemes such as Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY), Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY), Atal Pension Yojana (APY), Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY), Micro Units Development & Refinance Agency Bank (MUDRA) scheme and pushing the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) scheme of the Central Government. In A&N Islands, a total of 62800 accounts have been opened under 'Pradhan Mantri Jan-Dhan Yojana' (PMJDY) as on Sept. 2023. The scheme ensures access to financial services, namely savings and deposit accounts, remittance, credit, insurance and pension in an affordable manner to the



country's poor and marginalized section of the society.

PMJDY also provides an overdraft facility- a financial facility or instrument that enables an account holder to withdraw money from his/her bank account (savings or current), even if they do not have any account balance.

Like any other credit facility, the bank levies an interest rate when an account holder avails the overdraft facility. Overdraft facility is usually offered for the withdrawal of a limited amount of money.

The Centre's scheme allows the Jan Dhan account holders to withdraw money upto Rs. 10,000 in the form of a short-term loan. This limit was earlier Rs.5,000 which was doubled last year. The owner of a PMJDY account, who wants to avail the overdraft facility, must have been satisfactorily operating it for at least six months. Also, only one member of a particular family can avail the overdraft facility. Usually female members are favoured for this. For overdraft of upto Rs. 2,000, no guarantee is needed under PMJDY. The Government has also increased the upper age limit for overdraft from 60 to 65 years.

A&N Islands achieves remarkable milestone Secures No.1 Position, second time in a year among UTs in CCTNS Pragati Dashboard for Sept. 2023

In a remarkable feat, the Andaman and Nicobar Islands has achieved a significant milestone by securing the top position (94.78%) for the second time this year among Union Territories in the Crime and Criminal Tracking Network & Systems (CCTNS) P R A G A T I Dashboard, a system administered by the National Crime Records Bureau in

New Delhi for the month of September, 2023. The CCTNS is a flagship project of the Ministry of Home Affairs, regularly monitored by the Honorable Prime Minister of India and the Ministry of Home Affairs through the PRAGATI Dashboard on a monthly basis.

The CCTNS PRAGATI Dashboard plays a pivotal role in tracking and managing crime data on a national scale,

offering insights into the performance, commitment, progressive growth, and efficiency of States and Union Territories in implementing and managing crime prevention and detection measures. As people become more aware about the methods used by cybercriminals, they are getting creative, developing new methods for fraud. Cybercriminals are perpetrating a new scam targeting many people to get OTPs (One Time Passwords) for making fraudulent bank transactions and getting access to the victims' email addresses/ smart phones by manipulating them with Fake Delivery Parcel Scam. These scams are



often carried out by people who work closely with delivery agents or delivery agencies. When they find out that a particular person receives a lot of packages from various e-commerce companies, then they plan to target him.

In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens:

- Confirm your order history and the potential delivery dates before accepting / cancelling any package.

Fraudsters using Armed Forces Personnel details to perpetrate financial cyber Frauds

Port Blair, Oct. 28

A new trend in financial cyber fraud has been observed where fraudsters impersonate Indian Army personnel to exploit the goodwill associated with the armed forces to siphon off money from innocent victims who have advertised to put their property (House, Flat, Rooms, etc. on rent) on the popular house renting websites/apps, real estate database website or social media websites, etc.

In this regard, Andaman and



Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens:

- Always remember that entering OTP is a requirement for sending money, not for receiving it.
- If an unknown person makes contact for renting your house, flat, or rooms, etc., try to confirm his/her identity from other

available methods/sources.

- Fraudsters typically show urgency in their requests. Scrutinize, if a request seems too urgent.
- Avoid relying on conversations and identity details provided by unknown people on messaging apps, house renting platforms, etc.

creating new avenues, he said.

"Government is strengthening the traditional sectors providing employment opportunities while also promoting new sectors such as renewable energy, space, automation and defence exports", the Prime Minister said. He also touched upon opening up new avenues in the drone technology sector and gave examples of crop assessment and nutrient spraying being carried out with its help. Under the Swamitva Scheme, the Prime Minister informed that drones are being used for land mapping. He also mentioned the delivery of medicines in the Lahaul Spiti region of Himachal Pradesh by making use of drones, thereby reducing the estimated time from 2 hours to less than 20-30 minutes. Startups have also benefited a lot from drones and helped create new designs and technologies.

The Prime Minister touched upon the resurgence of Khadi which has registered a sale of more than 1.25 lakh crore compared to a mere 30 thousand crore 10 years ago. This has created many jobs in the Khadi and Village Industry sector, especially benefitting women. PM Shri Modi said that any competitive advantage of any country needs the power of youth to be fully realized. He mentioned the initiatives of skilling and education that are equipping the youth to take full advantage of the new opportunities. New National Education Policy, new medical colleges, IIT, IIM and IIIT have come up and crores of youths have been trained under PM Kaushal Vikas Yojana. PM Vishwakarma Yojana has been launched for the Vishwakarma friends. As reskilling and upskilling are the order of the day, the Prime Minister informed that PM Vishwakarma Yojana is linking the Vishwakarmas with modern technology and tools.

♦ Existing deep burials pits should be authorized as per BMW Rules, 2016 and designed in line with standards prescribed under Sr. No. 5 Schedule-II of BMW Rules, 2016.

♦ The standards for liquid waste prescribed under Biomedical Waste Management Rules 2016 and its amendments to be compiled by Health Care Facilities:

a) The limits mentioned under Schedule II of Bio-medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 are applicable to the occupiers of Health Care Facilities (bedded) which are either connected with sewerage network without terminal sewage treatment plant or not connected to public sewers: HCFs required to comply with limits under Schedule II at S.No.08 (CPCB guidelines for Management of Healthcare Waste as per BMW Rules, 2016 may be referred).

b) For discharge into public sewers with terminal facilities, the general standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) shall be applicable: HCFs required to comply with general discharge standards for public sewers.

c) HCFs having less than ten beds shall comply with the output discharge standards for liquid waste as mentioned under Schedule II at S.No.8.

d) Non-bedded occupiers shall dispose infectious liquid wastes only after treatment by disinfection as per Schedule-II (6) of the principal rules: CPCB guidelines may be referred.

All the Health Care Facilities in Andaman and Nicobar Islands have therefore been requested to ensure strict compliance of the stipulated conditions under BMW Rules, 2016. Indian para athletes create history at Hangzhou Asian Para Games; Bag 111 medals including 29 Gold

In the Asian Para Games at Hangzhou in China, Indian contingent wrapped up the event with their best-ever medal haul after clinching a record-breaking 111 Gold, 31 Silver, and 51 Bronze medals, while Tek Chand placing the country fifth in the medal count. This remarkable feat supersedes India's previous best of 72 medals, which was recorded in the 2018 Para Games in Indonesia.

Dilip Gavit kickstarted today's medal streak by helping India to reach the coveted three-figure mark. He secured Gold in the men's T-47 400m event with a time of 49.48 secs while the trio of Sanskruti, Himanshi & Vruthi secured a bronze, adding the final medal to India's glorious tally in Women's Chess B1 Category Event. Today, adding a total of 12 medals, Indian para-athletes secured an impressive haul of four Gold, two Silver,

In Men's Javelin Throw F55 event, India finished a double Podium victory. Neeraj Yadav claimed gold with a massive throw of 33.69m, setting a new Para Games Record while Tek Chand secured the bronze with an impressive throw of 30.36. In the Para Chess Men's team of B1 Category, the terrific trio of Ashwin, Darpan, and Soundarya secured a spectacular Gold. Meanwhile, India sweeps the podium in the men's Chess B1 individual event.

Darpan Irani brought home the Gold with his middle game maneuvering, Soundarya Pradhan bagged Silver while Ashwin Makwana clinched Bronze. In PR3 Mixed Double Sculls rowing event, the Indian duo Narayana and Anitha bagged Silver with the timing of 8:50.71. Pooja clinched a brilliant bronze with her amazing athletic skill and a finish time of 5:38.81, in Women's 1500m T-20.
