Deptt. of AH&VS initiates various measures for improving socio-economic condition of farmers in Isles

Five fully equipped Mobile Veterinary Clinics to be introduced for improving Veterinary Services response to emergency

Port Blair, Oct.29
The Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, A&N Administration focuses on improvement and expansion of animal husbandry activities and providing quality veterinary services in A&N Islands. The major activities of the Department are Veterinary Services, Animal Health Care, Disease Eradication, Cattle, Goat, Pig and Poultry development, control of diseases and Extension Training for Farmers and Veterinarians. The Secretary (AH&VS), Ms Pallavi Sarkar, IAS, has outlined the initiatives of the Department in improving the socio-economic condition of the farmers. Excerpts of the interview are as below:



Interviewer: Elaborate on the Mission, Vision & Aim of AH&VS Department?
Secretary (AH&VS): The main aim, mission, vision and objective of the AH&VS Department is to ensure availability of sufficient quantity of animal derived products such as meat, milk and eggs to the local population and also improve the socio-economic condition of the local population, especially farmers through animal husbandry activities such as rearing of poultry, pig, goat and backyard poultry. Further, the Department ensures a comprehensive health care system, be it vaccination, treatment of diseases and also to maintain a disease-free status in A&N Islands.

Interviewer: To achieve the Vision & Mission of AH&VS Department, how many

Veterinary Dispensaries, Hospitals and Polyclinics & manpower are available with the Department?
Secretary (AH&VS): The Department has 1 Veterinary Polyclinic, 9 Veterinary Hospitals, 12 Veterinary Dispensaries, 48 Veterinary Sub Dispensaries, 21 Artificial Insemination Centres, 37 Artificial Insemination Sub - Centres, 1 Animal Disease Diagnostic Laboratory, 6 Disease Investigation Laboratory, 1 No. Animal Husbandry Training Institute, 17 Mobile Veterinary Dispensaries spread over the entire Islands of this Territory. Apart from this, there are 11 Govt. Poultry Hatcheries, 9 Govt. Poultry Training-cum-Demonstration Farms, 8 Govt. Duckery-cum- Demonstration Farms, 6 Nos. Govt. Piggery Training -cum-



Veterinary Dispensaries are attached with Mobile Veterinary Dispensary. Laboratory diagnosis is an important part of health coverage. We have Animal Disease Diagnosis Laboratory at Dollygunj and Disease Investigation Laboratory in the Veterinary Hospitals which can handle routine diagnosis of blood, faecal sample and skin scrapings. The Department is in the process of strengthening the Laboratory Services so that we are capable of detecting any disease at the earliest.

Interviewer: Whether surgical operations are conducted in Hospitals and how many X-ray machines are there with the Department?
Secretary (AH&VS): All the Veterinary Hospitals functioning under AH&VS are capable of handling surgical and animal birth control operations. Department is having one X-Ray machine in the main Hospital at Junglighat and two more X-ray machines will be procured which will be installed at Veterinary Hospital Diglipur and Rangat.

Interviewer: What is being done to contain communicable diseases in birds and animals?
Secretary (AH&VS): To contain communicable diseases, we are organizing Veterinary Health Camps, carrying out disease surveillance, reporting and diagnosis & disease monitoring throughout the year and Prophylactic Vaccination Programmes are being conducted on regular basis. These Islands are free from most of the contagious diseases of animals.

Interviewer: What is the role of the State Animal Disease Emergency Committee?
Secretary (AH&VS): State Animal Disease

Cybercriminals using malicious browser extensions to hack email accounts; A&N Police issues advisory

Port Blair, Oct. 29
A new wave of cyber-attacks has been observed targeting users through malicious browser extensions. The attackers often use social engineering techniques to trick users into installing the malicious browser extension. Generally, Gmail accounts are being targeted from a malicious browser extension, spread via phishing emails, that targets Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge and other Chromium-based browsers. Once installed, this extension is able to steal contents of Gmail messages and even infect the mobile phones, especially android phones.

In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory for the safety of the citizens:

> Regularly review the installed browser extensions to identify any suspicious ones. Avoid installing any extension or other software

- sent to you in an email.
- > Only download extensions from trusted sources, such as the Chrome Web Store or Mozilla add-ons, etc.
 - > Avoid opening emails from unknown senders as well as downloading any attachments they may contain.
 - > Avoid clicking on links from suspicious emails or posts on message boards, as they could lead to compromised pages.
 - > Install antivirus apps and enable Google Play Protect on your smartphone.
 - > Keep software up to date to benefit from the latest bug fixes

Emergency Committee (SADEC) was formed as per the guidelines of the GoI and has members from all the stakeholders including Health, Forests, Police and chaired by the Chief Secretary and the Director (AH&VS) is the Member Secretary. The role of SADEC is to take decisions in emergency where highly contagious/ infectious disease is reported in the State or even when there is threat of disease. The Committee meets on a short notice to coordinate the measures to contain and prevent the disease in the State. The SADEC is instrumental to prevent disease outbreak in the UT by taking stringent measure in the wake of outbreak of bird flu in mainland. **Interviewer: Kindly elaborate on the different schemes being implemented by the Department?** **Secretary (AH&VS):** The Department is having 5 UT Plan schemes namely Animal Health Programme, Cattle Development Programme, Poultry, Piggery & Goat Development Programme, Strengthening of AH & VS and Fodder Development Programme. Through Animal Health Programme, we provide health care facilities to the livestock and poultry birds and assist farmers in keeping their livestock healthy for production of milk, meat and eggs.

The main aim of Cattle Development Programme is to upgrade the cattle population of the territory through Artificial Insemination. Chicks, ducklings, kids, piglets etc. are provided to farmers on rearing cost basis under Poultry, Piggery & Goat Development Programme. The Department carries out extension activities through electronic and print media about the activities of the Department. Besides this, progressive farmers are deputed to mainland for better exposure in the field of scientific management etc. To augment fodder production of these Islands to meet the requirement of fodder for livestock, production of fodder seeds and seedlings to meet the fodder requirement of the territory is the motive of Fodder Development Programme.

Interviewer: How successful are the schemes implemented by your Department? **Secretary (AH&VS):** As a result of our schemes & programmes, we have achieved self-sufficiency in meat, chicken and eggs. However, a new Scheme is under the process of approval and implementation for increasing egg production in these Islands. This scheme is proposed to be implemented on 50% subsidy basis in entire rural area of this UT.

Interviewer: Is there any separate Livestock Breeding Policy?

Secretary (AH&VS): The Department is following the policy of upgrading the genetic stock of the local livestock. Over a long time, due to in-breeding and isolation, our local livestock are genetically inferior. The Department carries out upgradation by cross breeding with genetically superior germplasm procured from the mainland by performing artificial insemination in cattle and buffalo using frozen semen technology.

Interviewer: What is the status of Pig and Goat rearing in these Isles?

Secretary (AH&VS): Many people are taking interest in Pig and Goat rearing especially the marginal & small farmers besides landless laborers. We are self-sufficient in both these products but there is scope to increase its production.

Interviewer: What are the future plans of the Department?

Secretary (AH&VS): The Department is preparing a scheme for providing feed and fodder on subsidy for supporting the dairy farmers. The Department will be introducing new initiatives to boost egg production in rural areas for which a new scheme is already in the process of approval and implementation. The Department will be introducing sexed semen for Artificial Insemination which will ensure 90% chances of female calf born. Efforts are being made to implement embryo transfer technology for producing high quality calf. Five fully equipped Mobile Veterinary Clinics will be introduced to improve Veterinary Services response to emergency.

Interviewer: What would you like to tell the local inhabitants of these Islands?

Secretary (AH&VS): I wish to tell the people of A&N Islands where farmers have small land holdings, that adopting livestock activities like piggery, goaterly and poultry utilizing the locally available resources would be a viable livelihood. There will a steady increase in the demand for livestock products, and local entrepreneurs should use this opportunity to take up animal husbandry activities according to their needs. The Department of AH&VS provides expert advice and technical consultation so that it increases the income of the farmer and also contributes in inclusive growth and employment generation.

Crackdown on bootleggers by N&M District Police

Diglipur, Oct. 29

In a proactive operation carried out on Oct.24, the PS Diglipur team conducted a raid in its jurisdiction, leading to the seizure of 9 Aluminium Degchi of different sizes & 1 plastic bucket containing 60 Kg of illicit Handia. The accused has been arrested and a case was registered under relevant section of law. In another raid conducted on Oct.23, the PS Kalighat team launched a jungle search operation in the Talbagan area, targeting the illegal production and distribution of illicit liquor. As a result of their swift and decisive action, a significant seizure of 400 liters of 'Lehan' was successfully destroyed.

These operations are part of the on-going efforts by North & Middle Andaman District Police to combat the illicit liquor trade in the region and ensure the safety and well-being of the community. 
